

KSUT provides comprehensive news, regional information and cultural enrichment to four states in the Four Corners area of the United States, including Colorado, New Mexico, Utah and Arizona.

The Capitol Coverage Project reports from the Colorado State Capital on issues concerning Colorado and the region. This is a project of Rocky Mountain Community Radio, an association of rural Colorado public radio stations.

KSUT works with local and regional musicians, promoters and venues to educate and inform listeners about the vibrant music scene in the Four Corners. KSUT also broadcasts live in-studio sessions each month with local and touring musicians to give everyone in the Four Corners a chance to experience the local music scene.

KSUT has created a "Community Calendar," broadcast twice a day, that creates a space for local non-profits and educational organizations to share information about events and projects. KSUT has also created space for the Community Calendar on KSUT's website, where anyone can conveniently access information about upcoming events and activities.
