Children's Programming

The programs also show real life in-the-field experiences of professional and ordinary people taking care of, treating and helping various animals, as well as exhibiting good social responsibility and promoting strong personal and community values. Viewers are introduced to career opportunities focusing on the creative, technical and artistic skills of the profession. Career advice and insight is presented by leaders in their respective fields. Made in Hollywood: Teen Edition ran on WMYT Saturdays at 8:30am January 4, 2020-March 28, 2020.

"LIVE LIFE AND WIN!" – Live Life And Win! is a weekly, curriculum-blended, Education/Informational (E/I), nationally syndicated magazine series highlighting inspirational teen success stories. Segments feature a focus on arts, school, sports, community and teen entrepreneurship, while promoting social responsibility, perseverance, leadership, academic achievement and volunteerism. The goal is to encourage the teen audience (13-16) to discover and learn strategies to achieve personal dreams, explore volunteerism, build character and

uncover personal passions. Live Life and Win! ran on WMYT Saturdays at 11:00am January 4, 2020-March 28, 2020.

“ELIZABETH STANTON’S GREAT BIG WORLD” – Elizabeth Stanton’s Great Big World presents audiences with in depth and thoughtful interviews involving Elizabeth’s travel buddies and friends they meet along the way. Elizabeth and friends volunteer in areas of special need, from feeding the hungry in the slums of Kenya to helping Vietnamese children with hearing impairments by fitting them with hearing aids. M-Th 8-830am 1/1-3/31 - More than Conquerors – Pastor Robyn Gool of Victory Christian Center teaches that they are more than conquerors and can live a victorious life through the teachings of Jesus Christ.

Fr 8-830am 1/4-3/27 - It's Time to be Healed - Pastor Robyn Gool and Mrs. Marilyn Gool of Victory Christian Center provide life-changing biblical and practical information for healthy living and improved health.

Su 530-6am 1/5-3/29 - Praising Place Church of God – Praising Place is a church built on the foundation of Jesus Christ. Program Descriptions:

1/4/20 – #1008 – “Don Gibson Theater – Bob Kogut Violin Maker” – In this episode, show host Carl White visits the Don Gibson Theater in Shelby and talks to Top 40 singer-songwriter Jim Stafford, NC. Then White visits renowned violin maker Bob Kogut in his shop in Lenoir, NC to see how violins are made.

1/11/20 – #1102 – “Rosemary House – Theater of the Republic – Wilkes Quilts” – In this episode of Life in the Carolinas, show host Carl White off to Pittsboro, NC to visit the owners of the Rosemary House bed and breakfast and the Kindred Art Gallery. Then we make a stop on the Carolina theater trail to explore the Theater of the Republic in Conway, SC. And then it's off to North Wilkesboro to visit the always colorful Wilkes County Quilt Show.

1/18/20 – #609 – “The Mystery of the Brown Mountain Light” – Carl White explores the ongoing mystery surrounding the Brown Mountain Lights of Burke County, North Carolina. Carl speaks with experts, researchers and eyewitnesses, including paranormal investigator Joshua P.

Warren, Appalachian State University Professor Dr. Daniel B. Caton, photographer Charles Braswell, Jr., and retired Forestry Service Law Enforcement Officers C. W. Smith and Les Burril.

1/25/20 – #1005 – “Blackbeard – Outlander NC” – History is questioned as host Carl White goes to the Blackbeard Festival in Bath, NC and examines the legend of Edward Teach (Blackbeard). Then he ventures to the Leatherwoods Mountain Resort in Ferguson, NC for the annual Fraser's Ridge Homecoming, a celebration of the historical fiction book and TV series, Outlander - portions of which were based in the area.

2/1/20 - #901 – “Blackberry Festival – Wounded Warriors Softball” – Show host Carl White visits the North Carolina Blackberry Festival in historic Lenore and then attends a fundraiser for Hospice and Palliative Care for North Carolina. He travels to Chester to attend an annual Wounded Warrior softball game.

2/8/20 – #903 – “Lenoir – Livermush – Liberty Mountain” – In this episode, show host Carl White visits historic downtown Lenoir, NC and highlights the music, food and arts and even the city planning of the Lenoir Main Street Program and the Arts Council. Next he visits the Livermush festival in Shelby, NC, where it's all about Mush, Music and Mutts. Finally, Carl visits Colonel Hambright's homestead and talks about the play "Liberty Mountain", a retelling of the battle of King's Mountain during the Revolutionary War.

2/15/20 – #904 – “Wayne Taylor – Morgan and Wells” – Show host Carl White learns about the historic Guffy house in Shelby, NC, now known as bed and breakfast destination, Morgan & Wells. Also, he sits down with singer/songwriter/band leader Wayne Taylor to discuss his prolific music career, starting at 9 years of age.

2/22/20 – #1103 – “Horry County – Hudson Dinner Theater” – Show host Carl White hits the Carolina theater trail once again with a stop in Hudson, NC to share in the Hudson Dinner Theater experience. Then it's off to the coast in Horry County, for a history lesson or two about the Revolutionary War.

2/29/20 - #1102 – “Rosemary House – Theater of the Republic – Wilkes Quilts – In this episode of Life in the Carolinas, show host Carl White off to Pittsboro, NC to visit the owners of the Rosemary House bed and breakfast and the Kindred Art Gallery. Then we make a stop on the Carolina theater trail to explore the Theater of the Republic in Conway, SC. And then it's off to North Wilkesboro to visit the always colorful Wilkes County Quilt Show.

3/7/20 – #605 – “Bennett Classics – Chef Andrea Long – Cape Hatteras Lighthouse – In this episode show host Carl White visits Bennett Classics Car Museum in Forest City NC and then Chef Andrew Long from the Mast Farm Inn in Valle Crucis is profiled and in segment three a visit to the NC Outer Banks on Hatters Island for a tour of the Cape Hatteras Lighthouse.

3/14/20 – #803 – “Teavepaugh Apple Orchard – Tom Dooley” – In this episode show host Carl White visits the Teavepaugh Apple Orchard in the Brushy Mountains of NC to learn about this

multi-generational family business and what is involved in getting apples to market. Next Carl visits on location at Whippoorwill Academy with Charlotte Barnes to learn about the Tom Dooley Files.

3/21/20 – #613 – “The Ghosts of Gold Hill” – Show host Carl White visits the historic town Gold Hill NC where he explores the rich history of this early American Gold Mining town and according to some tales it appears that some of the past residents have decided to linger even after death.

3/28/20 – #1006 – “Bigfoot Festival – 6th and Main Restaurant” – Host Carl White visits Marion, NC for the Bigfoot Festival. Next he visits the historic 6th and Main Restaurant in North Wilksboro, NC.
