### Appendix B

### Supplemental Outreach Activities WGBY-TV, Springfield, MA December 1, 2015 - November 30, 2016

During the Reporting Period, WGBY participated in the following Supplemental Outreach Activities:

- Internships (full and part-time) for students, graduates and career-changers in the following departments:
- 1. Programming and Production Internships

The production internship is a full-time, unpaid internship that provides "hands-on", practical experience in television production. Intensive training takes place the first two weeks of the program with instruction provided by the professional WGBY staff. Interns are trained in the fundamentals of television production and equipment operation.

The programming internship is an unpaid internship, with WGBY's Programming Department. Interns experience, first-hand the operations of a local PBS broadcast facility. Programming interns act as assistants to the producers, who are responsible for producing all of WGBY's local programs. Typical assignments include project research, assisting with studio and field shoots, tape logging, operating computer teleprompter, receiving studio guests, correspondence and clerical duties.

During the Reporting Period WGBY had 6 Programming and Production interns from the following Schools:

- Springfield College
- Westfield State University
- Springfield Technical Community College (STCC)
- 2. WGBY also participated in the Workplace Investment Act Youth Program by taking on six student interns from area high schools and colleges.
- 3. Latino Youth Media Institute. This internship program through the Latino Youth Media Institute allows Latino youth to participate in a variety of media learning activities. They experience both the programming and production side of WGBY and learn about how WGBY interact within the Community. During the Reporting Period, seven students participated in this program.
- 4. Digital Ambassadors. Seven area college and high school students participate in WGBY's Digital Ambassador program working in digital media.

- WGBY has been a training center for the Human Resources Unlimited (HRU) Lighthouse program since 1992. Lighthouse is a training program for people with disabilities to learn to help them get back into the work force. Employees are trained in the Administration and Building Maintenance Departments. During this reporting period two participants continue to be employed by WGBY.
- City of Springfield Department of Elder Affairs for Mature Workers Staffing Program (Senior Aid Program). As a host Agency for the Senior Aid Program, WGBY assists in training mature individuals who are attempting to get back into the work force. They are trained in: basic computer skills, general administrative skills, telephone and receptionist skills and general maintenance and janitorial skills.
