## WGBY 2013 EEO Public File Report Appendix B SUPPLEMENTAL OUTREACH ACTIVITIES

WGBY has been a training center for the Human Resources Unlimited (HRU) Lighthouse program since 1992. Lighthouse is a training program for people with disabilities to learn to help them get back into the work force. Employees are trained in the Administration and Building Maintenance Departments. WGBY was named HRU "Employer of the Year" in September 2000.

During this reporting period **3 associates** were employed by WGBY.

City of Springfield Department of Elder Affairs for Mature Workers Staffing Program (Senior Aid Program). As a host Agency for the Senior Aid Program WGBY will assist in training mature individuals that are attempting to get back into the work force. They are trained in: basic computer skills, general administrative skills, telephone and receptionist skills and general maintenance and janitorial skills.

During this reporting period 2 participants are now working and learning at WGBY

# WGBY offers full and part-time, unpaid internships to college students, graduates and career-changers in the following departments:

### THE PRODUCTION INTERNSHIP

The production internship is a full-time, unpaid internship that provides "hands-on", practical experience in television production. Intensive training takes place the first two weeks of the program with instruction provided by the professional WGBY staff. Interns will be trained in the fundamentals of television production and equipment operation.

### THE PROGRAMMING INTERNSHIP

The programming internship is an unpaid internship, with WGBY's Programming Department. Interns experience, first-hand the operations of a local PBS broadcast facility. Programming interns act as assistants to the producers, who are responsible for producing all of WGBY's local programs. Typical assignments include project research, assisting with studio and field shoots, tape logging, operating computer teleprompter, receiving studio guests, correspondence and clerical duties.

### WGBY-TV hosted an Internship Career Fair at the Springfield Center Library.
