One of the menu option initiatives under the FCC's Outreach Prong 3 is participation in at least four job fairs or careers fairs by personnel who have substantial responsibility in the making of hiring decisions. **WBA sponsors two job/career fairs each year - one in conjunction with our annual winter conference (January) and one in conjunction with our annual summer conference (June).** Full SEU participation in each job/career fair should earn the SEU a 1/4 credit.
