One of the menu option initiatives under the FCC's Outreach Prong 3 states: "One full 'Menu Option Initiative' credit for participating in a program for station management that will teach them how to ensure Equal Employment Opportunity and prevent unlawful discrimination". The WBA will be offering this training program four times over a two year period. The seminar will be held in conjunction with the WBA Winter and Summer Conferences. This initiative began with the 2006 Winter Conference - this is a similar process as the Job/Career Fairs. If a station routinely sends management to these courses, by the end of the segment, (two year period), the SEU would claim one full menu option credit for that two year period. Please note - these four seminars will each be on different discrimination topics, so an SEU will need to have someone from management in attendance at all four sessions to get the full menu option credit."



In accordance with the WBA's Assistance Action Plan for EEO Compliance, this letter confirms that WXYM FM, WTMB FM, WBOG AM, WNFM FM, WBDL FM, WRDB AM, WNNO FM, WBKY FM, WDLS AM, WDDC FM, WPDR AM, WAUN FM, WRJN AM, WMKQ FM, WMBZ FM, WBKV AM, KQEG TV, WEZY TV, WMJQ TV were represented by Reid Magnum and you at the Job/Career Fair which was held as part of the WBA's 2018 Summer Conference on Wednesday, June 20 from 1:30 pm - 3 pm at the Hilton Milwaukee City Center in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. If you'd like a listing of those that attended the Job/Career Fair, along with their contact information, please contact me at the lbaun@wi-broadcasters.org. I will get to you the pertinent information.

One of the menu option initiatives under the FCC's Outreach Prong 3 states: The FCC allows SEUs four, one-quarter credits, totaling one full credit, for each two year segment of their stations' eight year license term if they participate in at least four job fairs or career fairs during that two-year segment. To be counted as participating in a job fair, the SEU must send personnel who have substantial responsibility in the making of the SEU's hiring decisions. The WBA sponsors two job fairs per year, one in conjunction with our Annual Winter Conference (January) and another in connection with our Annual Summer Conference (June). Full SEU participation in each job/career fair should earn the SEU a 1/4 credit for each of these job fairs. Accordingly, over a 2-year period of participating in these WBA sponsored job/career fairs, an SEU should be able to claim one full credit so long as such participation includes personnel who have substantial responsibility in hiring and the SEU maintains adequate documentation of such participation.
