ISSUE: YOUTH PROGRAMMING

01/05/12 at 19:00...Life on the Rock Encore...60 minutes...Hosts Fr. Mark Mary and Doug Barry spoke with Mike Miller of Mary's Meals. Mary's Meals feeds and educates children around the world. Mike mentioned a story in Liberia, Africa and the children involved in a civil war there. Mike said they have fed 600,000 children in over sixteen countries. Mike noted that 93 cents of every dollar donated goes to feeding the children; and just \$10 to \$15 dollars a year will feed a child. Last, Mike encouraged people to get involved.

Leo wants to get rid of the "fast food" mentality, he is worried about what young people are "digesting" in the culture.

ISSUE: FAMILY, PARENTING AND RELATIONSHIPS

01/05/12 at 13:00...Faith and Family Live...60 minutes...Host Steve Wood discussed your 2012 bucket list. Steve felt the two criteria needed for the list were 1. Be specific about what fulfills your life purpose, and 2. Not to assume you have all the time in the world. Steve said we tend to lose sight of what is truly important. Steve recommended to his listeners to live a principled and focused life.
