

WCKW ISSUES AND PROGRAMS: FIRST QUARTER 2016

ISSUE: YOUTH PROGRAMMING

2/5/16 at 7:00 pm Life on the Rock...60 Minutes Fr. Mark Mary interviews Sam Guzman who runs the Catholic Gentlemen Apostolate which is a community outreach about masculinity. They talked about the danger of people getting prideful because of all the information they can gain from the Internet, and not real knowledge. They help young people learn about needing the discipline to put all the information they get from Social Media in perspective.

2/12/16 at 7:00 pm Life on the Rock ...60 Minutes Fr. Mark interviews Fernando Limbo and Nicole Rudolph from PureHeartAmerica.org, an organization that promotes chastity among youth. This is a young adult group that goes out to help spread this message in the Boston area. They use imagery to get their point across about what the world has to offer young people in their sexuality and what effects this has on their lives. Their ministry encourages young people to have an active life of faith.

2/26/16 at 7:00 pm Life on the Rock...60 Minutes...Fr. Mark Mary interviews Susan Conroy representing a youth group in northern Maine. They interview several of the young people about their experiences of putting their faith to work in their daily lives.

3/4/16 at 7:00 pm Life on the Rock ...60 Minutes...Fr. Mark Mary and Doug interview Ryan Colby from The Becket Fund for Religious Liberty which is a public interest law firm doing a lot of work these days. They discussed the issues of marriage and how the issues surrounding that effects what the church has taught for 2000 years.

ISSUE: FAMILY, PARENTING AND RELATIONSHIPS

1/19/16 at 2:00 pm Faith and Family Radio with Steve Wood...30 minutes. This program talked about ancient wisdom for family life, in particular listening to reproof and correction, and heeding advice for finding our way in the midst of this chaotic 21st century world. People today can make moral decisions but from their own perspective, or self-determined morality. As early as 107 AD they were teaching how dangerous this is. This type of thinking can cause incredible friction in marriages today.

1/26/16 at 2:30 pm Faith and Family Radio with Steve Wood...30 minutes. This program looked at proverbs dealing with wine and alcohol abuse. Drunkenness is associated with strife, sorrow and complaining and wounds without cause. Excessive alcohol use and moral failings often go hand-in-hand. Alcoholism is one of the leading causes of troubled marriages in family life in our country and the world. About 43% of the U.S. population has been exposed to some sort of alcohol abuse. He recommended the book "Dying for a Drink".

3/22/16 at 2:30 pm Faith and Family Radio with Steve Wood...30 minutes...Training your child at a young age determines their behavior later in life is a common belief that does not always hold true. Understand that what is "generally true" doesn't always occur because we can't "program" our children.

ISSUE: HEALTH

1/18/16 at 12:00 pm...The Doctor is In...57 minutes...Dr. Ray Guarendi discussed children who had problems after getting an iPod, also attachment disorder with people who adopt, a college daughter who wants to move in with a boyfriend and a wife who wants to install security cameras in the home.

2/17/16 at 12:00 pm...The Doctor is In...57 minutes...Dr Ray Guarendi discussed second child syndrome and some of the differences in personalities of children and how they are parented. Things that worked for the first child may not work for the second.

3/2/16 at 12:00 pm...The Doctor is In...57 minutes...Dr. Ray Guarendi discussed the challenges of disciplining children; the importance of both parents on the same page and which battles to pick.

3/17/16 at 12:00 pm...The Doctor is In...Dr. Ray Guarendi discussed the difficulties that arise when planning a wedding with the bride, her mother and her mother-in-law. Their other callers offered possible solutions.

ISSUE: EDUCATIONAL

1/18/16 at 10:30 am...American Catholic History...Hosts Monsignor Michael J. Witt and Teresa Holman explore St. Louis' role in the Westward Expansion and the significance that role has played through the years. This show talked about the decade of the 1860's which began with Lincoln's election and ended with Peter Richard Kenrick, St. Louis Archbishop, holding a minority position by accepting the decision of the counsel. Only 12 parishes were founded during this period in St. Louis.

2/15/16 at 10:30 am... American Catholic History... Hosts Monsignor Michael J. Witt and Teresa Holman explore St. Louis' role in the Westward Expansion and the significance that role has played through the years. Two traumatic events happened in St. Louis: The Great Divorce where St. Louis City and County split ways, and The General Strike of 1877, the largest strike of all the unions in the city. It was the most severe strike in the history of the United States.

3/21/16 AT 10:30 am...American Catholic History...The development of the growth of the school system in different ethnic areas of St. Louis, MO was explained as it occurred in the early to mid 1800's.
