



**WAKR, WONE-FM, WQMX, WN WV
2023, 3rd Quarter Community Issues/Programs**

During 2022, a survey was conducted by the Center for Marketing and Opinion Research to assess the community needs facing Northeast Ohio and Summit County. According to the most recent information we have, the problems noted during the period fell into the following categories (presented in order of importance):

NOTE: COVID continues to be a primary health concern in the community, although the immediate threat posed by the illness has abated.

INFLATION/FUEL PRICES: During 2023, Inflation and Fuel Costs have continued as an important issue. Groceries and commuting costs are rising, creating hardships for many. Also, housing costs are a major concern. While Northeast Ohio enjoys a comparatively low cost of living, recent increases are just as painful here as they are in traditionally more expensive regions.

Regularly Scheduled Programs

In addition to the programs listed, stations also provided the following regularly scheduled news and community service programming:

WAKR News – 3:00 length local newscasts 5am-9am M-F at the top and bottom of each of each hour 5:30a-8:30a, and top of the hour following CBS News 9a-1p.

CBS News – airs on 1590 WAKR Newscasts are 6:00 in length until 9am M-F, with the exception of the World News Roundup at 8:00 a.m. M-F (10 minutes) and 1-min hourly updates throughout the day.

WAKR Ray Horner Show – 5:30 a.m. - 9:00 a.m. Monday-Friday. News, sports, weather, traffic, business and topical interviews of local, national and community interest.

America in the Morning - airs on 1590 WAKR 5a-6a M-F with topical news, sports, business and information. 54:00 length. Network program.

WONE News – 1:30 length hourly local newscasts 6a-8a weekdays. These newscasts are conversational in nature and air at 6:40am, 7:40am and 8:40am.

WQMX News – 2:30 length local newscasts 5:30a-8:30a at the top and bottom of each hour weekdays.

Weather Updates - all stations present weather updates at least every hour during live programming and break in to programming when severe weather events warrant.

Traffic Updates - All stations: regular traffic and highway construction updates at least three times each hour on WNWV, WAKR, WONE & WQMX during weekday mornings. Updates are provided weekday afternoons as needed.

Spectrum – produced by the RCRG Newsroom presenting in-depth treatment of local, regional and national issues. Some programs also include presentations of the City Club of Cleveland highlighting a wide range of programming. Aired on WAKR, WONE-FM & WNWV. More detail on this program is provided elsewhere in this report.

Forum 360 – produced by the Jewish Community Center of Akron in association with the Rubber City Radio Group, a 30-minute program airs each Monday morning at 12:30 a.m. on WAKR and Sunday at 6:30 a.m. on WONE at 5:30 p.m. on WAKR depending on sports schedules.

Center Talks – produced by the Akron Urban League and 1590 WAKR with information on agencies and programs of benefit to the Akron urban community. This program runs 30:00.

CBS Weekend Roundup - a 48:00 minute review of the week's biggest news stories. Program airs Sundays on WAKR.

CBS Face the Nation - a 58:00 program with news and debate originating in Washington, D.C. Program airs Sundays on WAKR.

RCRG Community Outreach

As part of our continued community outreach, RCRG works in partnership with various community groups to both raise funds and help operations of non-profit charitable groups and profile worthwhile community events. Among the initiatives for this quarter:

WQMX Hosted or Participated in the Following Community Events:

- **WQMX GOLD OUTING.** Monday, August 7th at Raintree Golf & Event Center. The station sponsored this charity golf outing in support of NEOPAT, the Northeast Ohio Foundation for Patriotism. NEOPAT provides support to veterans, who need it, and their families. The organization provides mental wellness and emergency services. WQMX provided opportunities for on-air discussion of the organization and supported this event with on-air promotion and social media.

- **WQMX WINE COUNTRY WEDNESDAY w/HANNAH ELLIS.** Wednesday, September 13th at the 1975 Winery. This live Country Music showcase raised money for WQMX Bosom Buddies, our ongoing fundraiser that provides free mammograms to those who cannot afford them. The event was supported with on-air promotion and social media.
- **WQMX CHARITY CONCERT w/MICHAEL RAY AND FRANK RAY.** Thursday, September 22 at The Dust Armadillo. This live country music showcase raised money for NEOPAT. The event was supported with on-air promotion and social media.
- **WQMX CLAMBAKE.** Sunday, September 24th at the Dusty Armadillo. This afternoon charitable event was in support of NEOPAT. It was supported by on-air promotion and social media.
- **WQMX Pet Rescue:** A continuing on air feature which presents adoptable pets every Thursday morning at 8:40.

WONE Hosted or Participated in the Following Community Events:

- **Pet of The Week:** The WONE Morning team interviews representatives from the Summit County Humane Society every Wednesday. Homeless pets are featured, usually one cat and one dog, as a way to get these animals adopted.
- **Rib, White & Blue Festival:** 4th of July Weekend. WONE hosted the music stage at this annual civic event to boost attendance and also raised money to support the Valor Home.
- **WONE Rock The Lock:** Each Friday evening, during the summer, WONE hosts live music in Downtown Akron. Each week features a different “Tribute Band” covering one of WONE’s core artists. The station does a fundraiser each week to support and raise awareness for Summit County’s Valor Home, an agency that provides housing for disabled veterans in the Greater Akron area.
- **WONE Online Store:** WONE operates this online merchandise store as a way to raise funds for the Summit County Valor Home.
- **WONE Public Affairs:** WONE also raises money for Valor Home whenever station personalities appear publicly. Some examples are the Dragway 42 Music Festival (featuring Ted Nugent) and the Props & Pistons Festival at Akron Fulton Airport.

WNWV Participated in the Following Community Event:

- **Cleveland Verses Foundation. July 21st.** The Foundation engages the Greater Cleveland Music Community in an effort to provide funds and publicity in order to fight human trafficking. On the 21st, the station participated in a music event which raised moneys for the project. WNWV supported the event with on-air publicity and social media.
- **107.3 Alt-CLE Online Store:** WNWV operates an online merchandise store raising money for the Summit County Valor Home.

107.3 Cares: During the period, WNWV produced a series of public service announcements in support of community agencies of interest to the 107.3 audience. Target agencies include the following:
