

WAKR, WONE-FM, WQMX, WNWV 2023, 4th Quarter Community Issues/Programs

During 2022, a survey was conducted by the Center for Marketing and Opinion Research to assess the community needs facing Northeast Ohio and Summit County. According to the most recent information we have, the problems noted during the period fell into the following categories (presented in order of importance):

NOTE: COVID continues to be a primary health concern in the community, although the immediate threat posed by the illness has abated.

INFLATION/FUEL PRICES: During 2023, Inflation and Fuel Costs have risen substantially. Groceries and commuting costs have also grown, creating hardships for many and housing costs are a major concern. While Northeast Ohio enjoys a comparatively low cost of living, recent increases are just as painful here as they are in traditionally more expensive regions.

Regularly Scheduled Programs

In addition to the programs listed, stations also provided the following regularly scheduled news and community service programming:

WAKR News – 3:00 length local newscasts 5am-9am M-F at the top and bottom of each of each hour 5:30a-8:30a, and top of the hour following CBS News 9a-1p.

CBS News – airs on 1590 WAKR Newscasts are 6:00 in length until 9am M-F, with the exception of the World News Roundup at 8:00 a.m. M-F (10 minutes) and 1-min hourly updates throughout the day.

WAKR Ray Horner Show – 5:30 a.m. - 9:00 a.m. Monday-Friday. News, sports, weather, traffic, business and topical interviews of local, national and community interest.

America in the Morning - airs on 1590 WAKR 5a-5:30 a.m., M-F with topical news, sports, business and information. 24:00 length. Network program.

WONE News – 1:30 length hourly local newscasts 6a-8a weekdays. These newscasts are conversational in nature and air at 6:40am, 7:40am and 8:40am.

WQMX News – 2:30 length local newscasts 5:30a-8:30a at the top and bottom of each hour weekdays.

Weather Updates - all stations present weather updates at least every hour during live programming and break in to programming when severe weather events warrant.

Traffic Updates - All stations: regular traffic and highway construction updates at least three times each hour on WNWV, WAKR, WONE & WQMX during weekday mornings. Updates are provided weekday afternoons as needed. On WNWV, such traffic reports focus on Cleveland & Cuyahoga County since it's City of License resides within the Cleveland market.

Spectrum – produced by the RCRG Newsroom presenting in-depth treatment of local, regional and national issues. Some programs also include presentations of the City Club of Cleveland highlighting a wide range of programming. Airs on WAKR, WONE-FM & WNWV. More detail on this program is provided elsewhere in this report.

Forum 360 – produced by the Shaw Jewish Community Center of Akron in association with the Rubber City Radio Group, a 30-minute program airs each Monday morning at 12:30 a.m. on WAKR and Sunday at 6:30 a.m. on WONE at 5:30 p.m. on WAKR depending on sports schedules.

Center Talks – produced by the Akron Urban League and 1590 WAKR with information on agencies and programs of benefit to the Akron urban community. This program runs 30:00.

CBS Weekend Roundup - a 48:00 minute review of the week's biggest news stories. Program airs Sundays on WAKR.

CBS Face the Nation - a 58:00 program with news and debate originating in Washington, D.C. Program airs Sundays on WAKR.

RCRG Community Outreach

As part of our continued community outreach, RCRG works in partnership with various community groups to both raise funds and help operations of non-profit charitable groups and profile worthwhile community events. Among the initiatives for this quarter:

WAKR Community Service:

• Salvation Army Community Medal Award. On November 2nd, WAKR was honored by the Salvation Army of Summit County for it's long time commitment to supporting the Army and it's programs in and around Akron. Specifically, WAKR's Joyce Lagios, Ray Horner and Mark Biviano (Posthumously) were presented with the Army's Community Medal Award. This is the 2nd time WAKR has been so honored. The station has partnered with the Salvation Army since the 1950s.

- WAKR Share-A-Christmas. Each year, WAKR runs a week of fundraising for the Salvation Army and its programs. The station obtains auction items which are vary hard to get, such as a ride in the Goodyear Blimp, or a visit on the field at a Cleveland Browns game.
 During 2023, WAKR has raised over \$25,000 for the Salvation Army.
- Salvation Army. Each year WQMX participates in the Salvation Army Celebrity Kettle, located at Acme Market #1. The station provides on air support for the Army and social media support as well. This year's Celebrity Kettle was on December 13th.

WQMX Hosted or Participated in the Following Community Events:

- **WQMX 5-KAY.** On October 7th, WQMX sponsored a scharity 5K fun run for listeners in support of Cleveland Clinic-Akron general Hospital and their Free mammograms program. This is part of WQMX's support of Cancer Awareness Month. There was on-air discussion of the issue along with website and social media support. \$27,230 was raised to provide free mammograms to those who can't afford them.
- WQMX Bosom Bussies. WQMX's support for Women's Health continued on October 18th, at the Akron Civic Theater. The station sponsored a charity concert, featuring Country Singers Chase Rice and Priscilla Block. As with the 5K, the concert raised money and awareness for the Free Mammogram Program at Cleveland Clinic-Akron General Hospital. \$115,192 was raised. The event was supported by on-air discussion and also online support including social media.
- **Taste of Vintage.** This is a community event, supporting the Akron Area Goodwill Industries. It is a Vintage Fashon Show, and local restaurant food tasting festival. The event took place on the night of November 2nd. WQMX provided on-air support to Goodwill, and provided emcees for the evening.
- **WQMX Tree of Lights.** Each year, WQMX erects a Christmas Tree at our studios as a fundraising vehicle for NEOPAT (The Northeast Ohio Foundation for Patriotism) who provides housing for Veterans who are in need of assistance. Light Bulbs for the tree are sold to raise funds for the program. The on campus event took place on December 2nd. There were also several off-campus support activites which are also outlined here. As always, these events are supported by on-air discussion and social media.
 - WQMX Tree of Lights Concert. This charity Concert event was staged at The Dusty Armadillo (A local music venue) on Thursday, December 9th. Country singer, Chase Matthew appeared. The sold out show raised \$6,520 for NEOPAT.
 - WQMX Donut Tuesday. Each Tuesday during the month, WQMX partnered with Jubilee Donuts in support of NEOPAT.
 - WQMX Fundraising Days. Several events were staged during the month to raise additional funds for NEOPAT. These events took place at the Bistro of Green, Palumbos, and Missing Mountain Brewing. About \$1,500 was raised.

- Salvation Army. Each year WQMX participates in the Salvation Army Celebrity Kettle, located at Acme Market #1. The station provides on air support for the Army and social media support as well. This year's Celebrity Kettle was on December 13th.
- **WQMX Pet Rescue**: A continuing on air feature which presents adoptable pets every Thursday morning at 8:40.

WONE Hosted or Participated in the Following Community Events:

- **Summit County Valor Home.** During the Period, WONE-FM staged several events in support of the Valor Home, which provides housing for needy veterans. Most of the events raise funds for the Home and others are intended to raise awareness. All are supported by on-air discussion and social media. Here are some of the events.
 - WONE Online Store. This is WONE's Branded Merch store. A portion of all sales are designated for the Valor Home.
 - Cleveland Browns Watch Party. October 1st, The station sponsored this watch party at The Galaxy, in Wadsworth as a fundraiser.
 - WONE Online Fundraising Campaign. This ran during the month of November along with on-air discussion of the activities of the Valor Home.
 - Operation Heroes. During the week of October 27th, WONE provided on-air support for this event staged at Lowes Home Center, in Green to assist local veterans.
- Walk to End Alzheimer's. WONE-FM provided on-air support to this event staged by the Alzheimer's Association. WONE's Matt Spatz participated in the Walk.
- Coats & Cans for Kids. On November 11th, WONE provided on-air support and participated in this seasonal charity event, which was staged in Fairlawn, at the offices of a local Law Firm. WONE's Matt Spatz and Amanda Casey appeared at the event.
- **Fire Safety.** During the week of October 9th, WONE aired support for a fire safety education program being staged at Lowes Home Center, in Green, Ohio.
- Achieving Dreams, Back to School. On November 11th, in partnership with Akron's
 Project GRAD, the WONE morning show hosted agency supporters in the WONE Studios
 for "Spend The Morning with Spatz & Amanda." This was a fundraising auction item in an
 event held earlier in the year by Project GRAD, which raises scholarships for Akron Publiuc
 School students to go to college.
- Wish You Were Here The Sight & Sound of Pink Floyd. During the week of November 27th, WONE promoted an up coming charity performance at the Akron Civic Theater in support of Akron Children's Hospital

• **Pet of The Week:** The WONE Morning team interviews representatives from the Summit County Humane Society every Wednesday. Homeless pets are featured, usually one cat and one dog, as a way to get these animals adopted.

WNWV Participated in the Following Community Event:

- Movember Foundation. October-November. The Foundation creates programs that improve men's health. Specifically, mental health and suicide prevention, Prostate Cancer and Testicular cancer. WNWV supported the agency as part of our Cancer Awareness Month programming with on-air publicity and social media.
