- Broadcast an average of at least 3 Hours per week of Locally Produced Programming Each Quarter – this programming must be (1) produced within the predicted Grade B contours of the station broadcasting the program or within the contiguous predicted Grade B contours of any of the stations in a commonly owned group; or (2) programming produced at the station’s main studio.
- Comply with general Broadcast Regulations including;
 - A. Children’s Programming Requirements
 - B. General Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) Policy
 - C. Public Inspection File Rules
 - D. Political Programming Rules
 - E. Station Identification Requirements
 - F. Broadcasting of Emergency Information
 - G. Compliance with the Emergency Alert System (EAS)
