Dear Ms. McCoy:

This is in reference to the request filed on June 23, 2022. HFB requests an extension of the STA granted on January 4, 2022, to continue operating using the existing KTIE tower to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 application.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, HFB stated that additional time will be needed to file the application.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.


Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and HFB may continue to operate ND on 1240 kHz with 0.7 kW (day and night) using the KTIE tower, as specified in the construction permit. HFB must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR §1.1310.

This authority expires on **January 4, 2023**.

<sup>1</sup> KEZY(AM) is licensed for ND operation on 1240 kHz with 1 kW, day and night, and BP-20210403AAC authorizes use of one of the three KTIE(AM) towers, using 0.7 kW, day and night.
