**07 05 2013 at 1900 Life on the Rock 60 minutes** Father Mark and Doug open up the showing by talking about Dougs Battle Ready camp. They show a video clip of the first Battle Ready Training Camp. Father Eric Weldon and Chase Kear discuss with Father Mark and Doug about Father Emile Kapaun, an army chaplain in the Korean War. Chase was cured miraculously through Father Kapauns intercessory prayer. They start off by discussing Father Kapauns early life up to his service as an Army chaplain.

**07 12 2013 at 1900 Life on the Rock 60 minutes** Father Mark and Doug open up the showing by talking about marriage and the importance of defending it. He also talks about spiritual battle. Recently ordained MFVAs, Father John Paul Mary and Father Paschal Mary join the Rock House and share their joy and experience at being newly ordained to serve the Church in the MFVAs mission. They discuss throughout the show about the role of the priest and the importance of that role, especially in todays modern day and age.

**07 19 2013 at 19:00 Life on the Rock 60 minutes** Father Mark and Doug open up the showing by talking about how God came to us and the importance of using the sacraments, because He is waiting for us first. Doug and Father Mark also talk about the importance of Mary and the rosary. Men cannot be afraid to pray the rosary and to also talk about music records that inspires faith and perseverance amidst tribulation. Father starts off by talking about the poor. They also discuss about how material items can form a trap. It is important to form a spirit of detachment. He talks about how he sees that in the poor people. They also talk about music and sports. **07 26 2013 at 1900 Life on the Rock 60 minutes** Father Mark and Doug Barry are broadcasting from Copacabana Beach in Rio De Janeiro, Brazil for World Youth Day. They interview two men who have the web site, [onebillionstories.com](http://onebillionstories.com) and are with producing a film in Rio, which will be shown at the closing vigil Mass in Rio. In the film the seven works of mercy will be shown by these men going into the street of Rio to serve the poor. They describe some of the works they performed for the film. Also, the interviews include some individuals from the group, World Youth Alliance. This group promotes human dignity around the world. While the headquarters for the group is in New York, the organization has five other offices in various countries around the world. They use music, art poetry, and film to accomplish their mission.

**08 09 2103 at 1900 Life on the Rock 60 minutes** Father Mark and Doug recap the 2013 World Youth Day from Rio De Janeiro, Brazil. Throughout the show, the hosts speak with youth and youth leaders regarding their thoughts and feelings of attending WYD, seeing and being blessed by Pope Francis, and what words from the Pope were most inspiring and life changing to them. The hosts and youth also discuss ways of spreading the word of Christ to others and how to be a missionary for the church.

**08 16 2013 at 1900 Life on the Rock 60 minutes** Father Mark and Doug welcome David N. Calvillo, author of *Real Men Pray the Rosary* to the program. Calvillo stresses how the rosary is not just for old ladies and funerals, but for all of us in the sense that it gives light of the scripture, in harmony with the liturgy and in the context of our daily lives. He also discusses his journey in faith and how he came to write the book and discover the power of praying the rosary.

**08 23 2013 at 1900 Life on the Rock 60 minutes** Father Mark and Doug broadcast from the Franciscan University of Steubenville Summer Youth Conference on this special edition of the program. The program kicks off with the hosts speaking with priests, speakers and youth about the love of Christ and how to show that to those around us. The theme of the conference is chosen and many guests on the program discuss what chosen means to them, and how they feel they are chosen by Christ.
