ISSUE Family, Parenting and Relationships

07 08 2013 at 1300 At Home with Jim and Joy 60 minutes Jim and Joy Pinto tackle the issues in family and parenting and the pro life movement. They welcome Sr. Dolores hart and she discusses her path to becoming a nun. She was a Hollywood actress whose first kiss was Elvis Presley. They discuss her book, *The Ear of the Heart*. She talked about how it was difficult to leave her friends when she went to the monastery.

07 05 2013 at 1200 One Body, Stewarding Gods Creation 50 minutes Andrew Niewald, who holds a business marketing degree from the Franciscan University of Steubenville, Ohio, and currently the Religious Education instructor for St. John Parish and the Executive Director of cornerstone Charitable Foundation in Beloit, gives basic instruction on Theology of the Body. He talked about the language of the body and how that ties in with knowledge of ourselves and of God. The body becomes distorted when we do not follow Gods gift of sexuality. He also talks about how purity ties in with sexuality.

07 12 2013 at 1200 One Body, Stewarding Gods Creation 40 minutes Andrew Niewald, who holds a business marketing degree from the Franciscan University of Steubenville, Ohio, and currently is the Religious Education instructor for St. Johns Parish and the Executive Director of Cornerstone Charitable Foundation in Beloit gives a basic instruction on Theology of the Body. This week Andrew talks about re steering the Catholic Church. Andrew tells how the Church has changed into being a NICE church. He argues that Jesus was not always nice. Standing up for the Truth is not always nice. He challenges the faithful to re steer the Church back to Truth and in doing so, our divorce rates will decrease and we will live healthier, happier lives.

07 07 2013 at 0530 and 1730 Crossing the Goal 30 minutes Former NFL Coach and all-pro wide receiver, Danny Abramowicz and the Crossing the Goal Team, with host Brian Patrick, lay out the game plan for facing the spiritual challenges that men face in their daily lives. The theme for this week is to love God and neighbor. The team said the devil wants to isolate us, but we need to stick together and support each other. We need to be around positive people and have a positive attitude for others. They said that God does not always give us what we want, but does give what we need.

07 19 2013 at 1200 One Body, Stewarding God's Creation 60 minutes George Toman, a Graduate Student in Psychology at Fort Hays State University, talks about the different parenting styles, what each one entails and the results of that parenting style. He then ties these styles into how God, our Heavenly Father parents.

08 02 2013 at 1200 One Body, Stewarding Gods Creation 60 minutes Kathleen Morris shares her story in overcoming alcohol and drug addiction. For 30 plus years, Kathleen struggled with drug and alcohol addiction. She went through treatment with no real luck. She tells her story of how the desire left her and her call to come back to the Catholic Church. Kathleen now is active as a mentor in Alcoholics Anonymous and involved in her parish. She gives hope to those that are struggling and to those families that live with an addict.

08 09 2013 at 1200 One Body, Stewarding Gods Creation 60 minutes Professional stay at home mothers, Allison Ochoa and Mary Schroeder talk about saintly support for parents. They talk about the struggles in parenting and how parents need to turn to others for prayer. Saints are great examples of how parents are to practice patience and selflessness. They gave several examples of saints to turn to at various stages in parenting. They also humorously incorporated their own personal experiences into the show.

08 10 2013 at 1200 Double Edged Sword 50 minutes Fr. Kevin Weber, pastor of Immaculate Heart of Mary Church, talks about the power of praying couples. He encourages people to pray before doing anything like dating. He said if we take the author of life out of the marriage relationship, the story deteriorates. Fr. Kevin gave several examples of how couples can pray together using vocal and meditative prayer. He also talked about how to approach the spouse to pray.

08 21 2013 at 1300 At Home with Jim and Joy 60 minutes Jim and Joy Pinto tackle the issues in family and parenting and the pro life movement. Today the guest on the show was Deacon Keith Fournier, editor in chief for Catholic Online. Deacon Keith is a published author, national speaker from the Diocese of Richmond, Virginia. His topic was the new missionary age of the Church in the pre Christian West. Deacon Keith says pre Christian and not post Christian as the true spirit of Christ has yet to begin. He said that all baptized people have a duty to evangelize as we now live in Jesus Christ. There was a lady who called in and wanted to begin an at home Bible study asking if this was a good idea. Deacon Keith encouraged her to do so but to work with her parish so that adequate resources could be available for those who attend. Deacon Keith, along with Jim Pinto, took calls for the remainder of the hour.

09 09 2013 at 1300 At Home with Jim and Joy 60 minutes Hosts Jim and Joy Pinto welcome Adriana Gonzalez, founder of Catholics Called to Witness to the program. Catholics Called to Witness is a faith based organization dedicated to upholding and promoting religious liberty. The show begins with the Pintos and Gonzalez discussing how the organization came about, the principles of CCW, the protection of life in all its stages, the recognition and promotion of the natural structure of the family, and the protection of the right of parents to raise and educate their children, and how to be the salt of the world. The first caller called his niece the previous evening to bear witness to Christ and stressed the importance of how every Christian is called to be a witness. The second caller gave kudos to Gonzalez's mission and ministry and stated that she would bring CCW to her parish's attention.

09 18 2013 at 1300 At Home with Jim and Joy 60 minutes Hosts Jim and Joy Pinto welcome David and Tricia Nevarez, founders of catholicingles.com to the program. Catholicingles.com is the original Catholic dating site that has matched thousands of couples since 1997. The Nevarez's discuss the site, how or when they met, via the site, and success stories from other couples. The first caller, married 43 years, asked what percentage of these couples marriages actually survive, not referring just to matches made on catholicingles.com but to all online dating sites. David said that he doesn't have that exact data but to their knowledge, only one marriage has ended. The second caller, married 35 years, called to thank the Nevarezs for their ministry.
