Quarterly List of Programming Responsive to Issues of Community Concern First Quarter 2014 April 9, 2015

In our ongoing effort to serve the public interest, WXMA-FM broadcasts programming responsive to issues of concern to Louisville and its listening public. The following is a brief description of those issues and of the station's most significant programming treatment of them:

Issues of importance this quarter included the following:

Cupid's Kids: WXMA has a strong partnership with our local children's hospital, Kosair Children's Hospital. The station continuously works to help raise money for the hospital and champion the hospital's worth in the community. To that end, WXMA sponsored Cupid's Kids, a two week program to collect valentines for patients. More than 250,000 valentines were collected.

Family Issues: The families of our community are always a strong focus of WXMA's programming. From initiatives to support children's cancer programs to the needs of families with chronically ill children, WXMA promoted a community-wide campaign to collect coats for children, informed listeners a kids' cancer awareness fundraiser and supported benefits for the Kentucky Ronald McDonald House.

The Arts: Educating both children and adults about the arts is an important priority for WXMA. From promoting local plays and concerts to major Broadway shows and the Louisville Ballet, the station conducted interviews with artist and performers from ballets and musicals and helped promote the family entertainment values of these shows.

Health: Health issues receive major emphasis on WXMA. From healthy dieting for the family to promoting fitness in the new year, we educated listeners on the benefits of running and promoted CPR classes at local hospitals. And as a station primarily targeting women, WXMA also supported events to raise breast cancer awareness.
