We are New Hampshire's public television network that serves not only our state but southern Maine as well. It has come to my attention that Time Warner is not carrying the full array of program services offered by us. Specifically, NHPTV offers three digital streams: a digital standard definition stream 11.1: "NHPTV Prime SD", a high definition stream: 11.2: "NHPTV Prime HD" and a second SD stream 11.3: "NHPTV Explore" (our distinct lifelong learning channel).

In my review of your channel carriage here is what I have found:

### Berlin, Conway, Littleton, Middleton, Plymouth, NH Systems:

Non carriage: WENH-11.3 Explore

## Keene, NH System:

Non carriage: HD Channels: WEKW-11.2 HD, WEKW-11.3 Explore

### **Cumberland and York County Systems:**

Carriage:

Basic Channels WENH-11.1

Non carriage: HD Channels: WENH-11.2 HD, WENH-11.3 Explore



Under the provisions of the NCTA agreement, I ask that you make the necessary carriage changes for our primary HD streams and carriage of "NHPTV Explore" since it is a differentiated service to those program services offered by other public television stations in the region.
