The new scanners only show the outline of a person’s body and not a detailed image. Software in the scanners highlights items in yellow that may pose a potential threat.</p>

There are 25 active Visible Intermodal Prevention and Response, or VIPER teams who oversee security at the street level. The Department of Homeland Security is hoping to add 12 more teams next year.</p>
