I, the undersigned natural person being in excess of the age of 21 years, acting as incorporator of a corporation under the Wisconsin Business Corporation Law (Chapter 180 of the Wisconsin Statutes) adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is Family Radio, Inc.

SECOND: The period of its existence is perpetual.

THIRD: The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are to engage in any lawful activity within the purposes for which corporations may be organized under the Wisconsin Business Corporation Law Chapter 180 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

FOURTH: The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is 2,500 of common stock of no par value, and each share of said stock shall be equal to every other share of said stock. Such stock shall be issued for such consideration from time to time as may be fixed by the Board of Directors.

FIFTH: The number of initial directors of the corporation shall be four (4) and hereafter the number of directors

shall be such number (not less than three) as is fixed from time to time by the By-laws.

SIXTH: The address of the Registered Office of the corporation is Family Radio, Inc., c/o WISM, Syene Road, Madison, Wisconsin and the name of its Registered Agent at such address is William R. Walker.

SEVENTH: The Board of Directors may, from time to time, distribute to its shareholders in partial liquidation, out of stated capital surplus of the corporation, a portion of its assets, in cash or in property.

EIGHTH: The corporation shall have the right to acquire for money or property shares of its own stock and to pay for the same even though at the time of such acquisition there is no earned surplus in the corporation.

NINTH: Unless otherwise determined by the board of directors no holder of stock of the corporation shall be entitled as such, as a matter of right, to purchase or subscribe for any stock of any class which the corporation may issue or sell.

TENTH: The name and address of the incorporator is San W. Orr, 4646 Frey Street, Madison, Wisconsin.

ELEVENTH: These articles may be amended at any special or regular meeting of the shareholders, provided that a statement of the nature of the proposed amendment is included in the notice of

the meeting. The proposed amendment shall be adopted upon receiving the affirmative vote of the holders of at least two-thirds of the share entitled to vote thereon. Any number of amendments may be submitted to the shareholders, and voted upon by them, at one meeting.
