Description: NEED FOR OPERATION AT REDUCED POWER

LICENSEE HEREBY REQUESTS A FURTHER SIX MONTH EXTENSION OF ITS STA TO CONTINUE OPERATING AT REDUCED POWER. THE STATION'S PRIMARY TRANSMITTER HAS BEEN SUCCESSFULLY REPAIRED AND PLACED BACK INTO SERVICE. LICENSEE UNDERSTANDS THAT IT MUST SUBMIT A METHOD MOMENTS MODELING DEMONSTRATION PRIOR TO RETURNING TO 9.9 KW DAYTIME OPERATIONS. LICENSEE HAS BEEN WORKING TO PREPARE THIS DEMONSTRATION AND WILL SUBMIT IT AS SOON AS IT IS READY, BUT ITS PLANS TO COMPLETE THE STUDY HAVE BEEN DELAYED DUE TO THE IMPACT OF HURRICANE IDA.

LICENSEE ALSO REQUESTS PRESERVATION OF THE CUBAN INTERFERENCE PROTECTION GRANTED BY STA. THE STATION WILL REDUCE POWER IF INTERFERENCE COMPLAINTS ARE RECEIVED, AND WILL TAKE WHATEVER STEPS ARE NECESSARY TO PREVENT EXPOSURE OF WORKERS AND THE PUBLIC TO RADIO FREQUENCY FIELDS IN EXCESS OF THE COMMISSION'S EXPOSURE LIMITS.
