

By this letter DISH Network L.L.C. ("DISH Network") provides notice of its intent to commence local-into-local service for ATSC digital signals that are broadcast in ATSC high-definition ("HDTV") format pursuant to 47 U.S.C. §338 and the amended rules of 47 C.F.R. §76.66, in the SALT LAKE CITY DMA on or before February 17, 2012.

This letter shall also provide notice that your station is entitled to carriage of its HDTV signal as of February 17, 2012, provided that your station elects either mandatory carriage or to negotiate a grant of retransmission consent for its HDTV signal pursuant to applicable federal laws, rules and regulations. Your station must make an election no later than thirty days from the date of receipt of this letter for its signal that originates as an HDTV signal. Failure to make such election will result in the loss of the right to demand carriage for your station's HDTV signal for the remainder of the current three-year carriage cycle.

We received KBYU's letter, postmarked September 6, 2011, electing mandatory carriage. DISH Network L.L.C. ("DISH Network") accepts your election and looks forward to continued carriage of KBYU per federal must carry regulations for the election cycle commencing January 1, 2012.

In addition, pursuant to 47 U.S.C. §338 and the amended rules of 47 C.F.R. §76.66, DISH Network looks forward to carrying KBYU's HD signal per federal must carry regulations on or before February 17, 2012, provided that you notify us of your desire to be carried in HD and you deliver a good quality HD signal to our local receive facility.
