1st Quarter 2016

January 2016

Issue: Increase youth involvement in the Community  
Action: "Radio Rebels" trial is discussed. It is decided that the commitment from local teens is strong enough to justify instituting program as a regular feature of programming, airing the first Friday of every month. Show is named Friday Teen Takeover and debuts in February 2016.

January 2016

Issue: Increase local involvement with KLZR and also enhance sense of community by instituting "Words on The Wind" program at KLZR.  
Action: "Words on The Wind" was a production of the West Custer County library that had previously aired on the radio locally. After previously agreeing to resurrect program, KLZR decides to air program 6 times per week and also produce new "Words on The Wind" spots, inviting the community to participate.

March 2016

Issue: Current lack of comprehensive plan to communicate emergency information to local residents  
Action: Emergency Broadcast Committee meets and institutes a plan to serve the Wet Mountain Valley with the broadcast of pertinent information during emergencies. Efforts begin to inform local officials of the plan and generate "emergency only" contact information for KLZR. Emergency only email address of alert@klzr.org is created. Emergency phone number is instituted that broadcasts to 5 KLZR volunteers in ensure immediate response.
