July, 2016

Issue: reporting on local issues impacting community

Action: KLZR provides updates on Junkins fire for 12 straight days, with content added at least every day and often multiple times a day.

September, 2016

Issue: Emergency Broadcast capabilities

Action: WMBC finalizes agreement with Custer County to retain use of backup power at transmitter location.

November, 2016

Issue: More programming that deals with history and personalities in the Wet Mountain Valley area.

Action: Wet Mountain Valley Dry Goods program to be aired monthly, with new programming to be added each month and aired regularly.

Issue: More programming that deals with history and personalities in the Wet Mountain Valley area.

Action: Valley Views program will be aired beginning January 2017, featuring interviews with persons of interest and influence in the area, including volunteers, officials, managers and other persons of interest.
