KNOM ISSUES/PROGRAMS LIST 2023 1st Quarter KNOM and KNOM-FM, Nome, Alaska April 10th, 2023

Since 1971, KNOM continues to produce and air local & regional issue-oriented news and local feature programming. This quarter, newscasts ranged from approx. 6 to 11-minutes at :02 after the hour five times a day Monday-Friday: 7AM, 8AM, 9AM, Noon, & 5PM.

The station routinely covers local city and tribal meetings and issues, such as the Nome Common Council, the Nome School Board and Kawerak's events/programs. Other issues this quarter included Port of Nome deep draft port project updates, search and rescue efforts, coverage of the annual Iditarod sled dog race, the Iron Dog snowmachine race, impacts of sea ice and winter storm season along with other weather and climate change, subsistence resource challenges in villages, and seasonal hunting/fishing regulations.
