October 2, 2023 - Traffic

TXDOT has plans to expand Ralph Fair Road, also known as 3351 from I-10 to 46 The Kendall County Commissioners Court has shown their support of these plans, which could include additional lanes, as well as bike lanes and pedestrian paths. Kendall County is the 5th fastest growing county not in Texas...but in the country, and TXDOT is trying to be proactive before it gets overly congested.

October 4, 2023 – Historical Conservation

The Texas Historical Commission is unveiling a new Texas historical marker for the post-Civil War Wren Cemetery dedicated to African Americans. Before the civil war several southerners migrated to the Hill Country bringing with them plantation practices and slaves before Kendall County even existed. On Saturday October 28th at 10am, the marker will be unveiled, and a tour led by Texas Archeology Steward and regional historian John Benedict. The Wren Cemetery is up Esser Road as 474 hits Spring Creek Road just 7 minutes from River Road

October 5, 2023 – Flooding

City Council's expansion of the 100 year floodplain which affects about 250 more Boerne Businesses and homes. With this comes new guidelines on new construction in the zones and another thing you can count on is flood insurance going up if you're in the new floodplain map. During the City Council meeting it was brought up that the two worst flooding events in Boerne happened in 1978 and 1997...both considered 50 year storm events. The new federal guidelines are shooting to be adopted in early 2024.





October 30, 2023 - Student Safety

This past week, Officer Christopher Dingman from Boerne PD was invited to be a lecturer and speaker at the National Student Safety and Security Conference in Houston. The purpose of the event is to encourage safe practices in our schools, and to educate on ways to prevent crises from occurring. Officer Dingman, who has been a commissioned officer since 2020, taught a Civilian Response to Active Shooter Events course, which was inspired by the Act, Deny, Defend strategy. Again, Boerne leading the way not just in Texas but nationally.

November 1, 2023 - Water Conservation

Tonight, The Hill Country Alliance is co-hosting a Kendall County Water Talk along with Cow Creek Groundwater Conservation District, Groundwater Management Area 9, and the Texas Water Development Board. Natalie Ballew with Texas Water will cover Groundwater 101, Aquifers in Kendall County, Roles in Groundwater Management, and Groundwater Planning. The event starts at 6:00 tonight at the Herff Farm.

November 3, 2023 - Literacy

Another book vending machine has made its way to Boerne ISD, this time at Fabra Elementary. The machine was bought by the Fabra Elementary PTO and was purchased with the money from last year's Read-A-Thon. Now kids will be able to get a new book each time they receive a token from a teacher, as well as pick out which book they want most. The machine will continually be restocked by Boerne Reads, keeping kids motivated and reading.

November 3, 2023 - Boerne Blood Drives

There are a couple of Blood Drives coming up with the next one at the Free Roam Brewing company on Saturday November 11 - and how's this for fun - if you donate a pint, you get a pint on tap from the Free Roam. Just make sure you're not driving all lightheaded. And later on, November 28th Boerne Radio is proud to support the blood drive out at Tapatio Springs. November 14, 2023 - Trades Education

The Boerne Education Foundation funded 93 Teacher Innovation grants this past week, totaling \$196,386 across Boerne ISD schools. Most of these grants will fund innovative teaching tools that will dynamically impact students and teach them important life skills. The most generous grant awarded was \$20,000 given to the JROTC Instructor Col. Micheal Colvard. It will be used to purchase an Aviation Flight Simulator Trainer and CyberPatriot Innovation Competition Stations.

November 22, 2023 – Hunger

The Christian Men of Boerne representing dozens of different churches all unite for this special day that started at 6 o'clock this morning heating up the oil in deep fryers and building trash can smokers on the Kendall County Fair Grounds preparing more than 400 turkeys with Hill Country Family Services leading the distribution of all the fixings, bread and pie for families in need.





November 30, 2023 - Mental Health

The Kendall County Health Advisory Coalition met yesterday morning to discuss their initiative to tackle Behavioral Mental Health issues within our community. Some of the highlights: Kendall County Sheriff Al Auxier spoke on becoming Sheriff and realizing that the jail served as a "mental health facility", which did not have the proper resources to help those in crisis. Superintendent of Comfort ISD Dr. Yvonne Munoz spoke on the necessity of meeting students' health and safety needs, as well as providing access to counseling services, such as substance abuse treatment and grief counseling. Bryce Boddie, the Hill Country Family Services Director, agreed with Superintendent Dr. Price and Judge Shane Stolarcyzk about the importance of teamwork between all of the organizations in attendance, and spoke on being leaders within the Hill Country.
