### July 20, 2023 - Water Conservation

The Cow Creek Ground Water Conservation District announced that we are under a drought emergency - it's officially Stage 4 Drought Restrictions. The average water level has declined 5.82 feet since the last day of June. Wells are at record lows, and the flow of the Guadalupe River in Comfort and Spring Branch no longer flows. So what does Stage 4 mean? No lawn or turf grass watering is allowed with groundwater at any time. Filling ponds, lakes, tanks, and fountains are prohibited. If you own a pool, 80% of it must be covered to prevent surface evaporation, so get to blowing up those floaties. And if you'd like to see the full list, go to the district website CCGCD.org.
