Preemption Announcements
Sunday, October 19, 2014

To: General Manager / Program Director / Sales Manager / Promotion Manager / News Director / Marketing Director / TV Traffic Operations

As you know, the FCC has permitted our broadcast stations to count as "core" otherwise core children's programs that they preempt for live carriage of Network sports provided that the children's program is rescheduled for a substitute time slot with appropriate notifications of the schedule change made both on air and to program guides. The on-air notification must announce the alternate date and time when the preempted show will air and can utilize video graphics, with or without an audio complement. You may choose to make these preemption announcements during the legally required top-of-the-hour four-second station call letter/community of license identification.

Based on the contemplated live network feeds of children's "core" education programs and live Network sports preemptions surrounding FOX's live coverage of sports, I recommend that you make the following preemptions announcements due to FOX's live coverage of the Detroit Lions at Atlanta Falcons that will be broadcast on Sunday, 10/26/14 (modified as needed to reflect local scheduling differences):

Sunday, October 19, 2014:

Mountain Time Zone

- At the end of Jack Hanna's into the Wild (7:00AM): "Jack Hanna's into the Wild will air next Saturday, October 25th 12:00PM."

- At the end of Wild About Animals (7:30AM)" "Wild About Animals will air next Saturday, October 25th at 11:00AM."

Please note that when I supply these weekly rundowns of pre-emption announcements, the contents reflect the live Network feeds for each time zone. If your station moves a pre-empted program to a time other than the Network time, or otherwise revises the live Network schedule of children's educational programs, the preemption announcements must be tailored to be consistent with your station's schedule. Also, please note that this is an advisory and that your station should consult your FCC legal counsel on this and other items regarding the children's "core" educational programs.

Saturday, October 25, 2014 & Sunday, October 26, 2014

To: General Manager / Program Director / Sales Manager / Promotion Manager / News Director / Marketing Director / TV Traffic Operations

As you know, the FCC has permitted our broadcast stations to count as "core" otherwise core children's programs that they preempt for live carriage of Network sports provided that the children's program is rescheduled for a substitute time slot with appropriate notifications of the schedule change made both on air and to program guides. The on-air notification must announce the alternate date and time when the preempted show will air and can utilize video graphics, with or without an audio complement. You may choose to make these preemption announcements during the legally required top-of-the-hour four-second station call letter/community of license identification.

Based on the contemplated live network feeds of children's "core" education programs and live Network sports preemptions surrounding FOX's live coverage of sports, I recommend that you make the following preemption announcements surrounding FOX's live coverage of the Detroit Lions at Atlanta Falcons game that will be broadcast on Sunday, 10/26/14 (modified as needed to reflect local scheduling differences):

Saturday, October 25, 2014:
Mountain Time Zone

- At the end of Wild About Animals (11:00AM): "Wild About Animals will return next Sunday, November 2nd at 7:30AM."
- At the end of Jack Hanna's into the Wild (12:00PM): "Jack Hanna's Into the Wild will return next Sunday, November 2nd at 7:00AM."

Sunday, October 26, 2014:
Mountain Time Zone

- At 7:00AM during the FOX NFL Sunday Special: "Jack Hanna's Into the Wild will return next Sunday, November 2nd at 7:00AM."
- At 7:30AM during the Detroit Lions at Atlanta Falcons Game: "Wild About Animals will return next Sunday, November 2nd at 7:30AM."

Please note that when I supply these weekly rundowns of pre-emption announcements, the contents reflect the live Network feeds for each time zone. If your station moves a pre-empted program to a time other than the Network time, or otherwise revises the live Network schedule of children's educational programs, the preemption announcements must be tailored to be consistent with your station's schedule. Also, please note that this is an advisory and that your station should consult your FCC legal counsel on this and other items regarding the children's "core" educational programs.
