DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE RECENT ANNOUNCEMENT THAT EFFORTS ARE NOW UNDERWAY TO FINALLY BUILD A FISHER HOUSE. FISHER HOUSES SERVE THE SAME TYPE OF PURPOSE AS A RONALD MCDONALD HOUSE DOES....THAT IS TO PROVIDE A SPACE FOR FAMILIES OF VETERANS WHO ARE GETTING CARE AT THE V-A MEDICAL CENTER DOWNTOWN. THE ROOMS ARE FREE OF CHARGE TO FAMILIES OF VETS....SO THEY CAN BE NEAR THEIR LOVED ONES WHO ARE GETTING MEDICAL TREATMENT.

A FISHER HOUSE IN CHARLESTON HAS BEEN A LONG TIME COMING...SINCE THEY CAN ONLY BE BUILT ON GOVERNMENT PROPERTY. THERE WASN'T ANY DOWNTOWN THAT COULD BE HOME TO A FISHER HOUSE. BUT LAND ENDED UP BEING DONATED FOR A FISHER HOUSE. FUNDRAISING EFFORTS ARE NOW UNDERWAY TO FINALLY BUILD A FISHER HOUSE ON WENTWORTH STREET. 3.5 MILLION DOLLARS IS NEEDED TO BUY THE LAND. THE PURCHASED LAND WILL BE DONATED TO THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT...MEETING THE REQUIREMENTS OF A FISHER HOUSE.

THE AMBITIOUS TARGET IS TO START BUILDING THE FISHER HOUSE BY 2016. ONCE BUILT....IT WILL BE ABLE TO HOUSE 16 FAMILIES...FREE OF CHARGE....WHILE RETIRED LOVED ONES ARE GETTING THE MEDICAL CARE THEY DESERVE.

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON YET ANOTHER SERVICE THE LOCAL UNITED WAY OFFERS TO THE PUBLIC. THAT IS.....FREE TAX PREPERATION. AND ITS NOT JUST FOR THE DESTITUTE. YOU INCOME TO BE UP TO 90-THOUSAND DOLLARS...AND YOU CAN GET THIS FREE HELP.

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON CONTINUED INFORMATION ON EYESIGHT....HOW TO PRESERVE IT....AND HOW TO RECOGNIZE THE PROBLEMS THAT EVOLVE TO AGING EYES.

SOUTH CAROLINA RANKS TOO HIGH IN SOME STATS THAT AFFECT LIVES. OUR STROKE RATE IS AMONG THE HIGHEST IN THE COUNTRY. SEGMENTS OF OUR POPULATION ALSO HAVE HIGH RATES OF DIABETES....HIGH BLOOD PRESSURE.....AND OTHER ILLS THAT ALMOST ALWAYS HAVE AN EFFECT ON VISION.

THE RATES OF ILLNESS STRESS THAT REGULAR EYE EXAMS ARE A MUST IN ORDER TO STOP SURPRISE MEDICAL NEWS AND GET TREATMENT EARLY.

CURABLE PROBLEMS INCLUDE CATARACTS....THAT CAUSE A BLURRING OF THE LENSE. ZOLMAN SAYS ITS ALMOST A SURE THING THAT MOST OF US WITH DEAL WITH THIS PROBLEM. CATARACTS DON'T JUST AFFECT THE AGED....BUT YOUNG PEOPLE CAN ALSO HAVE THEM. YOUR EYE PROFESSIONAL CAN HELP YOU KEEP TABS ON THEIR DEVELOPMENT SO THAT TREATMENT CAN BE TIMELY.

GENERALLY GOOD LIFESTYLE CHANGES CAN HELP KEEP THESE PROBLEMS IN CHECK.

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON HOW BERKELEY ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE PLANS TO MARK ITS 75 YEARS PROVIDING POWER TO ITS MEMBERS. THE UTILITY PRIDES ITSELF ON NOT BEING LIKE OTHER UTILITIES. IT DOES NOT HAVE CUSTOMERS OR CLIENTS. IT HAS MEMBERS....FOLKS WHO HAVE A STAKE IN THE COMPANY....AND ITS RATES. THAT'S THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN A REGULAR UTILITY AND A COOPERATIVE.

B-E-C WANTS ITS MEMBERS TO KNOW THAT IT IS NOT JUST PROVIDING POWER....BUT IT WORKS TO BE A PART OF THE COMMUNITY....ESPECIALLY THE RURAL COMMUNITY. IT DOES THIS THRU SPECIAL PROGRAMS THAT WORK TO EDUCATE MEMBERS....ON HOW TO SAVE MONEY ON USAGE....AND SAFETY.

UTILITIES LIKE BERKELEY ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE WORK TO KEEP POWER AS AFFORDABLE AS POSSIBLE....BUT THE FUTURE IS A BIT UNCERTAIN UNDER NEW EPA RULES THAT ARE TO TAKE EFFECT. DISCUSSION CENTERED ON ALL WOMEN PAYING MORE ATTENTION
TO THEIR HEARTS. THE RATE OF WOMEN GETTING HEART DISEASE
IS SAID TO BE SOARING. THE RATE OF STROKE IS ALSO A
CONCERN...ESPECIALLY IN SOUTH CAROLINA....WHERE OUR STROKE
RATE IS HIGHER THAN MOST OF THE NATION.

GOOD LIFESTYLE HABITS ARE KEY....AND REGULAR DOCTOR
APPOINTMENTS. BUT SOMETIMES YOU CAN DO ALL THE RIGHT
THINGS AND STILL HAVE A CARDIAC EVENT.

MS WILLIAMS IS IN HER LATE 40S....AND EXPERIENCED A STROKE.
HER STORY STARTED ONE NIGHT WHEN SHE COULD NOT SLEEP. SHE
STARTED PAYING ATTENTION TO HER BREATHING...AND REALIZED
SOMETHING WAS WRONG. HER HUSBAND DROVE HER TO THE
ER...WHERE DOCTORS TOLD HER SHE WAS EXPERIENCING A STROKE.
SHE COULD HARDLY BELIEVE IT! THE GREAT NEWS IS THAT SHE
WAS AWARE...AND SOUGHT MEDICAL CARE BEFORE ANY DAMAGE
COULD HAPPEN. SHE SURVIVED....AND HER MESSAGE IS THAT ALL
CAN HAVE THE SAME RESULTS. BUT TOO MANY IGNORE THE
WARNING SIGNS.

GO RED FOR WOMEN MONTH IS MEANT TO TELL WOMEN THEY MUST
BE ALERT TO PROBLEMS....AND IF THERE ARE ANY QUESTIONS SEEK

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON MONEY EDUCATION FOR ALL....BUT ESPECIALLY FOR YOUNG PEOPLE. JOHNSON SAYS KIDS ARE TAUGHT ABOUT A LOT OF THINGS....BUT NOT ABOUT HOW TO RESPONSIBLY HANDLE MONEY.

MONEY CAN CONTROL YOU....AND YOU CAN CONTROL MONEY. THE LATTER IS SMARTER AND SAVE A LOT OF TIME WORRYING ABOUT DEBT AND HAVING THE FUNDS NECESSARY TO PAY BILLS.

THE MONEY ROCKS SEMINAR HAPPENS THIS WEEKEND AT CHARLESTON SOUTHERN UNIVERSITY. LAST YEAR IT ATTRACTED A COUPLE OF THOUSAND YOUNG PEOPLE...AND EVEN SOME ADULTS WHO CAN'T CONTROL THEIR MONEY.

JOHNSON SAYS IT ALL STARTS WITH KNOWING HOW TO BUDGET. THE OTHER SIDE OF MONEY MANAGEMENT IS HOW TO SAVE. SAVING IS SOMETHING MANY...YOUNG AND OLD....DON'S ATTEMPT UNTIL LATE IN LIFE.

ANOTHER PITFALL FOR YOUNG PEOPLE IS HOW TO USE CREDIT. PLASTIC IS NICE....BUT AT THE END OF THE MONTH YOU WILL GET A BILL...COMPLETE WITH INTEREST THAT CAN MAKE LIFE A STRUGGLE.

JOHNSON SAYS STUDENTS SHOULD BE REQUIRED TO TAKE A MONEY MANAGEMENT CLASS BEFORE GETTING OUT OF SCHOOL

THE CONCERT HAPPENS MARCH 19TH. THE BAND IS THE SIERRA
LEONNE REFUGEE ALL STARS. FRAZIER SAYS THESE BAND
MEMBERS ARE FROM THE AFRICAN AREAS HIT HARD BY EBOLA.
THEY LOVE IT IN AMERICA...BUT THEY WANT TO GO HOME. THEY
ARE RAISING MONEY FOR THOSE TRYING TO COMBAT AIDS IN
AFRICA. DOCTORS WITHOUT BORDERS IS WORKING IN HOT SPOT
EBOLA AREAS OF AFRICA.

FRAZIER SAYS HE HAS VISITED THE WESTERN AREAS OF AFRICA
SEVERAL TIMES. HE ENJOYED HIS VISITS AND MEETING THE PEOPLE
AND LEARNING ABOUT THEIR HERITAGE. HE SAYS HE WANTS TO GO
BACK BUT THAT THE EBOLA VIRUS IS MAKING IT IMPOSSIBLE TO
FREELY ENJOY THAT PART OF THE WORLD.

THE SIERRA LEONNE REFUGEE ALL STARS BAND IS WORKING TO GET
THE WORD OUT ABOUT DOCTORS WITHOUT BORDERS.

EBOLA WILL CONTINUE TO RAVAGE THOSE AREAS OF AFRICA
