

KQAL Post-Filing Announcement

On March 22, 2013 KQAL was granted a license by the Federal Communications Commission to serve the public interest as a public trustee until April 1, 2021.

Our license will expire on April 1, 2021. We have filed an application for license renewal with the FCC.
