1) KSEY broadcast the regular monthly meetings of Seymour City Council for the benefit of the shut-ins and elderly in our community. The Meetings are the 3rd thursday of every month. Meeting were broadcast at 7pm on the following dates. 04/22, 05/20 and 06/24. We feel this is a valuable public service to the shut-in and elderly who can not attend City Council Meetings. The City Council meetings are broadcast on KSEY AM and FM.

2) Little rain in June created the potential of wilfire. And KSEY FM and still were broadcasting outdoor fire safety announcements in conjunction with the Baylor County Commissioners Court. In June 2010 we broadcast 24 fire psa announcement per day.

3) KSEY broadcast the daily Meals On Wheels menus and other related Meals

On Wheels news. The menus are aired monday thu friday at 6:45am, 7:45am.

8:45am, 9:45am, 10:45am and 11:45am. We feel this is a valuable services to

meals-on-wheels clients. Our broadcasts give them enough time to make other lunch arrangements if they don't want or, for health reasons, can't eat planned menu.

4) KSEY's EAS encoder-decoder has a telephone interface. The City of Seymour has access to the system to immediately broadcast local emergencies. The System is tested by the Seymour Police Department the first Wednesday of every month. The city has 24/7 access to our EAS system and can using the system to determined by Police Chef Tommy Duncan.

We also broadcast a series of announcements urging citizens to buy EAS radios. We stock EAS radios at KSEY and sell to citizens at cost.

05) Agriculture and farm related issues are important to all citizens in Baylor county and most surrounding counties. We broadcast several farm and agri related shows every day, Monday thru Friday. We do a farm show from 5:00 am till 5:30 am on both KSEY AM/FM. Other Farm shows are broadcast on KSEY FM from 7:00 till 7:30am and 12:15 till 1:00pm.

06) To give journalism students at Seymour High School an opportunity to get on air experience. KSEY donates 15 minutes a week for students to produce a high school oriented radio show called Panther Territory. We air the show every Thursday at 8:15am and 5:20pm on KSEY FM and 9:05pm on KSEY AM. A total of 18 shows were broadcast from 4/01/2010 to 5/27/2010.

07) After talking with members of the Ministerial Alliance, we have determined that hunger is a problem in our community because of the slow economy. We have the Food Bank a major on air campaign. We began broadcasting 2 PSAs an hour everyday, Monday thru Friday from 5am till 7pm urging people to make donations to the Seymour Food Bank.

08) Every year KSEY FM AM in conjunction with Loving Insurance in Seymour give away scholarship money to students at Seymour High School seeking a career in Radio/TV, the Arts or business. This quarter we issued 3 \$200.00 scholarships.
