Randi explained that JAFCO is short for Jewish Adoption and Family Care Options and spoke of the many programs and lives that JAFCO is able to help including ,The JAFCO Children's Village which provides an actual home to over 100 children each year, and is the only center of its kind in the Jewish community in the nation. Randi also highlighted The JAFCO Northeast Communities which provides highly individualized, intensive support to families experiencing overwhelming challenges such as dealing with mental health issues, addiction, complex divorce and custody challenges. Randi lastly said Jafco was established 27 years ago by Ron Simon who saw a need for Jewish children to receive support and care and they provide these many services for 615 children and over 500 families.

Molly and David sat down with us and told us that the organization began as Horses and the Handicapped of South Palm Beach County in 1982, the organization and its stewards have remained vigilant to the ever-changing special needs community and societal changes. Equine-Assisted Therapies of South Florida offer four different programs and has grown to serve more than 135 children and adults with special needs annually through four programs, including: Therapeutic Riding, Hippotherapy, Equine-Facilitated Learning and Equine-Facilitated Psychotherapy. The equine programs are executed with the aid of 11 specially trained therapy horses and assisted by more than 300 volunteers, donating more than 10,000 hours of their time and talents.

Allie told us in her interview City House began with a few families who were providing temporary shelter for children through a program called Safe Families which helps divert children from being placed in the child welfare system while the mothers seek to reestablish themselves so that once again they may care for their own children. Over time, she stated it became clear to the organizers that if more emphasis could be placed on the family unit rather than just the children, these single mothers in need would have better opportunities to develop healthy lifestyles enabling them to provide sustainable, loving and proper care to their children. So, the program changed its model and then City House was established in 2014 to provide long-term, transformational assistance to both mothers and their children. Allie finished her interview in the conclusion saying the change in City House of Delray Beach from a focus on children and then mothers to a focus on the family as one has made all the difference in the success of children's and mothers lives that City house has helps over the years
