Re: Extension of Due Date for Consummation Ownership Reports

To Whom It May Concern:

Fox Television Stations, Inc. ("FTS") consummated its purchase of WMYT-TV/20624, Rock Hill, South Carolina (File No. BALCDT-20130128AMX) and WJZY/73152, Belmont, North Carolina (File No. BALCDT-201303128AMW) on April 17, 2013.

FTS hereby requests an extension of time, until November 1, 2013, to file its post-consummation ownership reports. Given that FTS' biennial ownership reports already are due November 1, 2013 (reflecting information current as of October 1, 2013), FTS requests that the Commission treat the biennial reports as also satisfying the requirement to file post-consummation reports. News Corporation, the ultimate parent of FTS, has proposed to separate its businesses into two independent companies on or before July 1, 2013. The entity currently known as News Corporation will be renamed 21st Century Fox, Inc., and several of the current officers and directors of News Corporation will not remain with 21st Century Fox following the separation. The post-consummation ownership reports would be inaccurate and out-of-date shortly after submission if FTS were required to file them on the current due date.

As a result of the short time between the proposed separation transaction and the date that FTS' biennial ownership reports are due, FTS submits that there is good cause for an extension to file the post-consummation ownership reports and to have the biennial ownership reports additionally serve as the post-consummation ownership report. Complete ownership reports for FTS and all its attributable parties will be filed as part of the biennial ownership reports.
