Local Pastor Speaks Out Against Gun Violence

SUNRISE, FL (May 2023) — In the aftermath of the recent mass shooting in Allen, TX, that left nine people dead and several others injured, well-known Florida pastor Dr. Henry Fernandez is calling for more protection from legislators regarding gun laws.

“Unfortunately, it appears mass shootings are quickly becoming the norm for the American people,” Fernandez said in a statement released this week. “Nearly every week, we hear news accounts of deadly shootings that have occurred either on school campuses, at shopping malls, in neighborhoods—even in our churches.

“As a spiritual leader, I am not here to turn up the heat on the subject. Nor are my comments intended to sound political in any way. I do, however, firmly believe the legislators who represent our communities, our states, and this nation must do more to protect those they serve. While many of them, and their families, are protected from such violent attacks—some who, in fact, are provided police protection—the majority of the population remains unsafe. Our legislators must understand that Americans are dying every day as victims of gun violence.”

The shooting in Allen this past weekend is reportedly the 17th mass killing in the nation this year. The incident occurred when a lone gunman opened fire last weekend on a group of shoppers at an outlet mall, killing at least eight people before himself being shot and killed by police.

“While we, as the Church, continue to pray for the safety of our people, I urge every American to take a serious look at the laws that govern our nation, as well as our communities, regarding gun control, and examine the policies our elected officials have chosen to endorse,” Fernandez said in his statement. “If we become educated to the laws and policies that our legislature is putting in place, and the possible negative effects they can have on us as individuals, our communities, and our country, then we can better be prepared to vote for individuals who are committed to protecting the interests and the lives of the people they serve.”

“Our hearts go out to the families the victims of the Allen, TX shootings, as well as all those who have become victimized as a result of senseless gun violence.”

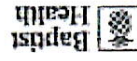

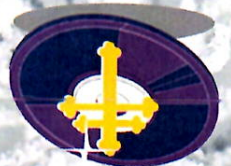

Emergency Alert System (EAS) Participant,

On November 23, 2022, the Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA) issued an [Advisory](#) on security vulnerabilities in DASDEC EAS encoder/decoder devices sold by Digital Alert Systems (formerly Monroe Electronics). CISA warns that DASDEC software prior to version 4.1 contains a cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerability that allows remote attackers to run code on the devices. CISA also warns that all DASDEC software contains an XSS vulnerability via the Host Header that can be used by remote attackers after login.

The Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau (PSHSB or Bureau) of the Federal Communications Commission advises all EAS Participants that use DASDEC devices to immediately take the following steps recommended by CISA to protect their systems from cyberattacks:

- Patch their DASDEC equipment to the latest version.
- Minimize network exposure for all control system devices and/or systems, and ensure they are not accessible from the Internet.
- Locate control system networks and remote devices behind firewalls and isolate them from business networks.
- When remote access is required, use secure methods, such as Virtual Private Networks (VPNs), recognizing VPNs may have vulnerabilities and should be updated to the most current version available. Also recognize VPN is only as secure as its connected devices.

The Bureau also urges EAS Participants to take additional steps to improve their cyber hygiene as described in its August 5, 2022 [Public Notice](#).

Under the FCC's rules, EAS Participants are responsible for ensuring that EAS equipment is installed so that the monitoring and transmitting functions are available during the times the stations and systems are in operation. Failure to receive or transmit EAS messages during national tests or actual emergencies because of an equipment failure may subject the EAS Participant to enforcement.
