Broadcasting 24 hours a day, seven days a week, KCHO and KFPR provide Northern California with more than 100 hours of news and information every week. We cover a full range of issues of concern to our local audiences.

The news staff determined the following issues of local concern in conversations with a number of residents from our broadcast area.

- Arts & Culture
- Agriculture & Environment
- Justice, Law, & Public Safety
- Politics/Public Policy
- Public Health
- Science

Responsive Programs: Our locally produced programs cover topics **including Arts & Culture, Agriculture & Environment, Public Health, Justice, Law, & Public Safety, Public Health and Science.**

- **Blue Dot**, a 60-minute program, broadcasts Fridays at 10 to 11 a.m. and rebroadcast Sundays 4 to 5 p.m. It explores science and nature at the micro, local, regional, state, national, global, and cosmic levels by doing in-depth interviews with leading experts in their topics. (Agriculture & Environment, Science)
- **Cultivating Place**, a 60-minute program, broadcasts Thursdays at 10 to 11 a.m. and rebroadcast Sundays 9 to 10 a.m. It features interviews with horticulturalists, botanists, and all other types of gardeners and plant people. It's based on the belief that horticulture is a foundational element of our cultural literacy — on par with art, music, architecture, history, geography, social studies and literature, and that gardens and gardening provide a unique bridge to our larger environments — culturally and botanically. (Arts & Culture, Agriculture & Environment, Science)
- **Nancy's Bookshelf**, a 60-minute program, broadcasts Wednesdays from 10 to 11 a.m. and rebroadcast Sundays 7 to 8 p.m. Each week host Nancy Wiegman talks to local, regional and national writers across all literary genres about their latest projects. (Arts & Culture)

The syndicated news, information, and entertainment programs we air from sources including NPR, APM and PRX, cover issues including **Arts & Culture, Agriculture & Environment, Justice, Law, & Public Safety, Politics/Public Policy, Public Health, and Science.**

- **NPR's Morning Edition** broadcasts weekdays from 5 a.m. to 9 a.m. A typical show includes news, both newscasts and in-depth reports; features on science, arts, business, sports, and politics; interviews with and profiles of people in the news; commentaries; and human interest features. (Arts & Culture, Agriculture & Environment, Justice, Law, & Public Safety, Politics/Public Policy, Public Health, and Science)
- **NPR's All Things Considered** broadcasts Monday through Friday from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. and 4 to 5 p.m. Saturday and Sunday. A typical show combines news, analysis, commentary, interviews, and special features on a range of topics, including those above. (Arts & Culture, Justice, Agriculture & Environment, Law and Public Safety, Politics/Public Policy, Public Health and Science)
- **NPR's Weekend Edition** broadcasts Saturdays from 6 to 10 a.m. and Sundays from 7 to 10 a.m. A typical show combines news, analysis, commentary, interviews, and special features on a wide range of topics, including those above. (Arts & Culture, Agriculture & Environment, Justice, Law, & Public Safety, Politics/Public Policy, Public Health, and Science)

- **NPR's Fresh Air** broadcasts Monday through Friday from 9 to 10 a.m. and 7 to 8 p.m. The show primarily includes interviews with prominent figures in various fields, including: arts and entertainment, culture, journalism, and world news. Shorter segments follow the main segment and carry reviews of various cultural and entertainment diversions on a rotating basis. (Arts & Culture)
- **APM's Marketplace Morning Report** broadcasts Monday through Friday at 7:45 a.m. during Morning Edition. Business, finance, and market reporting.
- **APM's Marketplace** broadcasts Monday through Friday at 3:30 p.m. Business, finance, and market reporting.
- **NPR's Latino USA** broadcasts Tuesday from 10 to 11 a.m. examining news, features, arts and cultural stories in the national Hispanic diaspora, including Justice, Law, & Public Safety and Politics/Public Policy, Arts and Culture.
- **PRX's Reveal** broadcasts Monday from 10 to 11 a.m. with long-form investigative journalism, including Justice, Law, & Public Safety and Politics/Public Policy.
- **BBC World News** broadcasts midnight to 6 a.m. Monday to Sunday, bringing an international perspective to a local audience, including Justice, Law, & Public Safety, Politics/Public Policy, Public Health, Science, and Arts and Culture.
- **WNYC's Science Friday** broadcasts Friday from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. features news, analysis, commentary, and interviews on a wide range of scientific topics, including Politics/Public Policy.
- **KQED's The California Report** broadcasts Monday through Friday at 8:45 a.m. during Morning Edition. California regional news.
- **KQED's City Arts and Lectures** presents events with leading figures in the world of art & ideas, with outstanding figures in literature, criticism, science, and the performing arts and offering the most diverse perspectives about ideas and values.
- **WBUR's Here and Now** broadcasts Monday to Thursday, 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. A typical show includes news, both newscasts and in-depth reports; features on science, arts, business, sports, and politics; interviews with and profiles of people in the news; commentaries; and human-interest features. (Arts & Culture, Agriculture & Environment, Justice, Law, & Public Safety, Politics/Public Policy, Public Health, and Science)

NSPR airs local newscasts and weather reports within Morning Edition and All Things Considered. (Justice, Law, & Public Safety, Politics/Public Policy, Public Health, Science)
