KLAC provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- **Animal Welfare:** Rescuing animals who are suffering on the streets & in shelters. Main goal is to educate people on the importance of companion animals in our society.
- **Blue Diamond Inaugural Gala:** The LA Dodgers will be having their Blue Diamond Inaugural Gala ten days after opening day, which is this Monday. - **Domestic Violence :** Providing victims of domestic violence a comprehensive centralized base of support that is culturally responsive, and ensures their transition from immediate crisis to stability and self-sufficiency.
- **Education:** Estimated more than 15 million children don't have the resources they need to succeed in school, teachers spend more than \$1 billion a year stocking their own classrooms due to a lack of funding in schools.
- **Empowerment:** Multi-sport event for Youth, Adults and Military with physical disabilities in Los Angeles @ UCLA's Drake Stadium June 19-20, 2015 to see Track & Field and Wheelchair Basketball Games.
- **Environmental:** Our annual KIDS OCEAN DAY Adopt-A-Beach Clean-Up field trip connects KIDS to the beaches and oceans and contributes to their appreciation of our shared resources. This experience actually gets children's feet and hands in the sand. One of the basic concepts of Environmental Education is to get children outside and in touch with nature. The 22nd annual KIDS OCEAN DAY Adopt-A-Beach Clean-Up is planned for May 14, 2015.
