

On the first full weekend in December each year, more than 15,000 people come to the small town of Northfield, Minnesota, 40 miles south of Minneapolis and St. Paul, to experience traditional Scandinavian meals, atmosphere and fellowship — and to enjoy the St. Olaf Christmas Festival. For many thousands more, the annual broadcast of the festival on radio stations across the U.S. has become a part of their Christmas observance.

The festival features splendid music of the season, performed by the St. Olaf Choir, the Chapel Choir, the Manitou Singers, the Cantorei, the Viking Chorus and the St. Olaf Orchestra, separately and as a massed ensemble. In all, more than 500 student musicians take part.

The student musical groups at St. Olaf are widely recognized as among the best in the nation, and critics and reviewers around the globe have hailed this inspiring holiday event for its superb presentation of the season's most sacred music. The St. Olaf Christmas Festival was inaugurated in 1912 as a musical celebration of the birth of Christ and has been staged annually ever since, making it the longest continuously running event of its kind.

And On Earth Peace is the theme of this special celebration, held in December 2015. Artistic Director of the Festival is Dr. Anton Armstrong, conductor of the St. Olaf Choir. Pastor Bruce Benson is host for this abridged radio broadcast. It is a production of the *Sing For Joy* radio program from St. Olaf College.

Sing For Joy is a weekly, half-hour radio program featuring sacred music from around the world, and commentary from Pastor Bruce Benson. *Sing For Joy* is offered free to all stations wishing to broadcast the program. 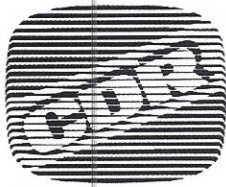

Coming to you soon...local news and voices, for free and unrestricted use...Monday, January 2nd.

We are starting an independent multiplatform news service in Nebraska that provides audio cuts, audio wraps, scripts, photos, graphics, sometimes video, and print and online versions of statewide stories that are important to your listeners, viewers and readers. This service is funded by grants, gifts and contributions from foundations, nonprofit organizations and individual donors that want to support more local coverage on a host of social, community and environmental issues. Our purpose is to provide content that is useful to you and covers issues that affect your audience.

Again, this content is free to all media outlets. Our contributors explicitly understand all editorial control rests with **Nebraska News Connection (NNC)** and we will pursue stories based on our independent producer's judgment.

NNC will offer print versions and podcasts suitable for the Web, as well as broadcast copy, long and short wraps and recorded actualities of newsmakers, experts, activists and the public talking about Nebraska issues. You can access all content via our Web page or by calling a toll-free number if you prefer old-school.

Our broadcast scripts and print/internet stories are "rip-and-read" ready, but your news people may edit and use our material as they see fit, possibly in conjunction with other wire copy. Attribution is very welcome, but not required. An optional short reporter's wrap will be available with each story, as well as the longer form podcast, and individualized signoffs are available for broadcasters upon request.

We will start modestly. You can anticipate a couple stories a week. The amount will change over time, depending on the success of our fundraising. You are welcome to post, print or broadcast all content.

We'll be sending more info next week with detailed information on accessing the sound, images and copy on the password protected website. In the meantime, if you have any questions, give us a call or send an e-mail. In addition, we'll reach out once we're up and running to say hello and get your feedback. Again, expect to see no-fee content available Monday, Jan. 2.

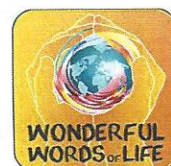
