The City manager discussed the closing of Trinity Manufacturing, as well as the down-sizing of Wind Clean Corporation. The City Manager said the loss of jobs, as well as the loss of electricity revenues to the City of Coleman were significant. The loss of revenue to the city utilities was estimated to be more than \$500,000.00 annually.

Curtis Garrett was a guest on the Morning Show to update our area agriculture producers of several important dates and deadlines that are approaching through the Farm Service Agency program. Of note were the DCP and ACRE programs, which were highlighted in detail during the interview segment. Garrett also encouraged agriculture producers to consider running as a candidate for the County Committee Board, as those elections are approaching in the weeks ahead.
