Days before the inauguration of the new Congress, and with the halt and closure of the government that had commenced on December 22 nd , negotiations for an agreement were futile. Trump reassured everyone that he would maintain the government shutdown until means necessary.
President of Mexico, Andres Manuel Lopez Obrador on thefts and corruption in Mexico	01/07/2019	07:03	3 min	The president of Mexico, Andres Manuel Lopez Obrador (AMLO) warned the thieves and gangs committing theft in Mexico, that they would not defeat the law under his watch. Supporting AMLO is the governor of Baja California, Francisco Kiko Vega. AMLO questioned the thefts which occurred over the course of two days in where 100,000 pipes that carry gas fuels were robbed. AMLO stated that when he became president, he was informed by the government that they had to deduct \$10,000 from the assessed budget since the presidency of Vicente Fox.
Twenty dead bodies found in Veracruz	01/10/2019	07:10	4 min	A total of 20 dead bodies were found in a ranch in the town of Miguel Aleman in the state of Veracruz by the Mexican Secretary of National Defense, 17 bodies were completely burned and the other 3 were mildly burned. The bodies were scattered near a pipeline of Mexican petroleum company PEMEX.
President Donald Trump FBI Investigation	01/15/2019	7:25	3 min	President Donald Trump stated that he never worked with Russia after the investigation done by the FBI. Before leaving to New Orleans, Trump called the FBI agents "corrupt police men" and "shameless scoundrels."

Gas duct explosion in Hidalgo, Mexico	01/19/2019	07:02	4 min	A building caught on fire after an explosion on Friday night in Hidalgo Mexico. There are reports of 21 dead and 71 injured. This occurred in the town of San Primitivo after there was a leak in one of the underground gas ducts caused by illegal activity by residents of the same town.
Interim president Juan Guaidó	01/24/2019	10:05	3 min	Hundreds of thousands of people from Venezuela rallied in the streets in support of interim president Juan Guaidó. Fourteen countries including the US have shown their support and approval of Guaidó to take presidency over Venezuela. Mexico and Uruguay want to mediate the situation and come to a peaceful solution. Nicolas Maduro expelled the US diplomats but Mike Pompeo disregarded his command as an illegitimate legal authority.
Newly elected President of El Salvador Nayib Bukele	02/05/2019	10:05	3 min	This past weekend Nayib Bukele became the youngest President that El Salvador has ever had. The 37 year old entrepreneur and politician targeted the millennials during his campaign. His slogans included phrases that appealed to the younger crowd and was very active on social media.
Military aid for Venezuela	02/14/2019	07:24	4 min	The US Congress announced that they would not provide military support to Venezuela after certain remarks made by President Trump according to the head chief of the Foreign Affairs Committee of the House of Representatives. "The remarks that President Trump announced worries me because he is still saying that military aid is an option. I want to make it clear to everyone that Military Aid from the US should not be an option."

The families of the bodies that have not been identified are urging authorities to speed up the process.
President of Venezuela Nicolas Maduro denies humanitarian aid	02/22/2019	10:13	4 min	The Vice President of Brazil, Hamilton Mourao, stated that if military aid was provided by the US to Venezuela, not only is it rhetorical but also useless. "It's too early to provide help and it would be useless for the US to provide military aid to Venezuela. The problems going on in Venezuela should be solved by the country itself." Nicolas Maduro announced the closure of the border between Brazil and Venezuela yesterday. Two days after the humanitarian help from Brazil, Colombia and Curazao.
Democratic political party orders Donald Trump to be investigated	03/04/2019	10:15	3 min	The Democratic political party has ordered Donald Trump to be investigated. The President of Commissions of the House of Representatives states that President Donald Trump is clearly guilty and has asked for documents from 60 different people that are close to Trump to be observed. Jerrold Nader stated that his committee wants to revise the documents between the Justice Department under Trump's son supervision and the finance director, Allen Weisselberg, from The Trump Organization. The ex-chief of the White House office, John Kelly, and the former lawyer of the presidency, Don McGahn, are also probable suspects.

Guaido responded by saying that the sole person behind the massive blackout is Nicolas Maduro.
Major similarities between two different Boing Max 8 airplane accidents	03/18/2019	07:40	3 min	Authorities have found many similarities between two different Boing Max 8 airplane accidents. The Ethiopian government confirmed that the accident of one of airplanes of the Ethiopian airline that killed 157 people on March 10 th is similar to the engine failures of the Lion Air accident that occurred in Indonesia this past October. Both airplanes were Boing 373 Max 8 and they both took off earlier than their designated times. After observing both recordings of both planes, they noticed multiple similarities between flight 302 from Ethiopian Airlines and flight 610 of Lion Air.
