- 10. Economic Development/Economy:** Includes need to attract business and industry to the region and create a better-skilled labor pool for potential and existing employers and how the current economy is affecting the quality of life.
- 11. Crime/Violence/Gang Activity:** Concerns about crime, substance abuse and the economic strain caused by rising crime.
