**Description:** On World Suicide Prevention Week, California voted for assisted suicide. Janet Parshall was joined by Wesley Smith, Senior Fellow in human rights and bioethics at the Discovery Institute described what happened through this "deadly" vote. Wesley stated that in Oregon, where assisted suicide is legal, there are very few doctors, in a group known as "Compassionate Choices", who will perform this procedure. He is concerned that medical doctors will be forced to do this procedure and explained how coercion has been felt in many medical practices in Quebec, who find this procedure to be morally objectionable. He said that there must be continual effort to convince people that this is not the way to go, not good public policy, and not good personal decisions. This issue is not limited to the terminally ill. Wesley Smith is afraid that, due to budget restrictions, it would lead more people to be forced to choose euthanasia.
