1/3	Globalism: Are We Beyond the Point of Return?	Jim Schneider/ Gary Kay	Although we're in a new year, the pursuit of a global agenda hasn't changed. In fact, it's as though it's accelerating toward completing this agenda moves forward. Are we beyond the point of return? Joining Jim to look at that question was Gary Kah. Gary is the founder and director of Hope for the World. He is the author of <i>the World Update</i> , an author, and former Europe & Middle East Trade Specialist for the Indiana State Government. Gary believes the one-world order crowd is at a point where if they linger too long, more people will die and things will work against them. Keep in mind their goal is to gain complete control over the economy and resources of the world in order to install a centralized and heavily regulated, totalitarian system similar to the one we see in China. One item driving their acceleration is the fact that conservatives under-performed in the recent election. So are people waking up or are we beyond the point of return? He indicated that in the last 6-9 months a great awakening is coming around. Related to that is the factor of God's judgment. In a recent article he wrote, "Even at this time it looks as though the Lord is allowing things to play out and run their course and that, in itself, is a warning. Some Christians believe our nation is too special to judge due to our efforts to get out the Gospel as well as Israel. Gary explained that God's promise to Abraham concerning Sodom was situational and therefore conditional. We can't take biblical events out of context and apply them across the entire scope of history. He stressed the need for Spirit discernment as we've seen great empires fall, in spite of the fact that many believers lived in them. As the conversation moved on, Jim noted how we're appalled by the totalitarian situation in China, yet we're headed in the same direction. Politically he sees that we've become very much like them. He cited the latest evidence showing how the Biden administration may be steering America down that same road concerning a central bank digital currency and an international pandemic treaty.

The Vatican announced that at least 25-30,000 would come on Monday, but by the end of the evening, Fox News reported that only 10,000 came through St. Peter's Basilica. Tomorrow will be the funeral mass, presided over by Pope Francis. Why are so many people fascinated by the pope and the Catholic religion itself? Returning to <i>Crosstalk</i> with other related issues was Mike Gendron. Mike is founder and director of Proclaiming the Gospel Ministries. He is a Roman Catholic for over 3 decades and was taught to rely upon the authority of the church above all else. He has read the Scriptures and was amazed to find that what he read in Scripture contradicted the teachings and traditions of the church. He has been a part of for so long. He trusted Jesus as his Savior and now the Bible has become his sole authority. Mike is the author of the books, <i>Preparing for Eternity</i> and <i>Contending for the Gospel</i> and has preached with warnings concerning false teachings vs. the truth of the Scriptures. According to Mike, Catholics will say that Pope Benedict was the 265 th leader of their religion and the first in over 100 years. That's interesting when you consider that Germany is a nation that was at the center of 16 th Century Catholicism. Pope Benedict was ultra conservative and considered to be the doctrinal guru of the Roman Catholic religion. When elected pope in 1994, he co-authored the Catechism of the Catholic Church which has become the doctrinal

			<p>church ever since. His view of the Bible was consistent with historical Roman Catholicism. This meant the word of God but he also said the word of God is bigger than the Bible. In other words, the Bible is supplemented by the Catechism of the Catholic Church. There are always changing weather patterns. No meat eating, no gasoline powered cars, no private property, etc. because they have to make sure it's all done properly in order to protect the planet.</p> <p>Is the media being paid to promote global climate change? What's behind the Global Education Initiative? Who is engaged in this battle at the local level? Tom answered these and other questions while listeners joined in. It went well.</p>
1/6	News Roundup & Comment	Jim Schneider	<p>Here's a sample of stories from the early portion of this week's program:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -In 2022, abortion was the leading cause of death around the world. -The Biden administration just gave it's OK for the U.S. Postal Service to ignore state abortion bans and deliver abortion pills through the mail in all 50 states. -Walgreens and CVS will sell abortion drugs. -The South Carolina Supreme Court narrowly decided that the state's ban on most abortions after six weeks is constitutional. -The Minnesota House Finance and Policy committee approved the Protect Reproductive Options Act, which would turn into state law a fundamental right to abort any baby until birth. -Nebraska Governor Jim Pillen wants the legislature to pass an abortion ban. -The Idaho Supreme Court upheld the state's near total abortion ban marking the latest legal success for the state as the federal right to abortion was dismantled last year. -The 50th annual March for Life will take place on January 20th in Washington, D.C. -Former President Trump claims that the GOP's underwhelming mid-term showing wasn't his fault. He blames it on the abortion issue, especially by those that insisted on no exceptions. -6 months after the Supreme Court overturned Roe v. Wade and several months after the leak of the DoJ records, prompted a wave of pro-abortion violence across America, the FBI has yet to arrest a single person for the violence at churches and pregnancy centers. -Vice President Kamala Harris took to Twitter and said she'll fight for more abortions in 2023. -Hungary took another action to support mothers and save unborn babies from abortion, enacting a new law that exempts mothers under 30 and mothers with at least 4 children from paying income tax on their lives. -The 13th ballot fell short for Kevin McCarthy for the position of Speaker of the House. Jim provided a commentary on Matt Gaetz. -Senator Mitch McConnell became the longest serving party leader in Senate history on Tuesday. -Metal detectors, first installed in the House chamber after the January 6th protest, were removed Tuesday after the House regained control of the lower chamber.

Jim pioneered a safe and repeatable medical model in the pregnancy center movement, helping hundreds of centers nationwide become effective at reaching more women and saving more babies from abortion. He's written extensively on reproductive leadership, and pro-life strategy.</p> <p>As many listeners may recall, there was an illegal leak of the full Supreme Court draft overturning Roe v. Wade last year. This leak sparked a pro-abortion crime wave that targeted pro-life organizations, pregnancy centers, and with arson via fire-bombs, extreme vandalism, death threats and more.</p> <p>The first fire-bombing of a pro-life organization occurred on May 8th in Madison, Wisconsin. A group called "Revenge" took responsibility. They communicated a 30 day ultimatum that pro-life pregnancy centers would be more of the same would happen.</p> <p>30 days later, CompassCare Pregnancy Services in Buffalo was attacked with multiple Molotov cocktails and arson. In addition, they entered into a lawsuit (suburb of Buffalo) Police Department in order to get their video surveillance back. Now they're pressuring the window to file a civil suit against the perpetrators is closing.</p> <p>In the meantime, other kinds of "attacks" have taken place as well. For example, Pastor Harden explained a coordinated effort to censor pro-life pregnancy centers on internet search engines so that women can't find them. CompassCare. Returning to Crosstalk to report on this development was Alex Newman. Alex is an award-winning international journalist, author, researcher, educator and consultant. He is senior editor for The New American. He is also author of <i>Educators</i> and <i>Deep State: The Invisible Government Behind the Scenes</i>. He's also founder of Liberty University. So who's been attending the World Economic Forum summit? While U.S. President Joe Biden and Chinese President Xi Jinping are not in attendance, there are still over 50 heads of state present, leaders of all the major international organizations, as well as CEO's from major corporations, and many more.</p> <p>Since many in attendance are from America, what can we expect? Here's a sample of the news items from this week's broadcast.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -President Joe Biden issued a proclamation today praising the Supreme Court's 1973 Roe v. Wade decision. -An investigation by the U.S. Supreme Court has failed to identify the culprit who leaked a draft court opinion that would overturn Roe v. Wade. -The FBI expanded their reward for those who provide information leading to the identification, arrest and prosecution of persons involved in at least 78 attacks on pro-life organizations since the leak of the Dobbs decision. -The newly minted Minnesota legislature has signaled its priorities by their very first order of business. The legislature has so-called right to unrestricted abortion up to birth in that state. -Hundreds of thousands of people are in Washington, D.C., today for the 50th annual March for Life. -UK authorities have fined a father and military veteran for praying for his deceased son, and doing so in a public place. -New York City Mayor Eric Adams announced that a city-run clinic in the Bronx will begin to offer free abortion services to women, with plans to expand the program to 3 more clinics by the end of the year. -New data released by the Chinese National Bureau of Statistics shows more deaths than births in 2022. -A top leader of the U.N. has urged politicians to make unpopular decisions that may benefit their people. -The CEO of Moderna said he wants to have an mRNA technology factory on every continent. -When pressured by journalists, Pfizer's CEO refused to answer a question about his vaccine and COVID-19. He provided audio of the attempted exchange. -Jim presented an audio cut of former Vice President Al Gore admitting the Inflation Reduction Act isn't what it's marketed as but instead it's a global climate change act. -Republican Congresswoman Maria Salazar said at the World Economic Forum that we need to give discretion to states to deal with the million illegals living in the United States. -Senator Joe Manchin of West Virginia has a problem with our open press. -President Biden's "garage-gate" scandal keeps growing as on Saturday even more classified documents were found at his Delaware home.

1/23	Patient Rights at Stake	Jim Schneider/ Karen Mueller	<p>Back on December 13th, the guest on this Crosstalk was interviewed about a critical case before the Wisconsin Supreme Court dealing with patient rights. The case is Allen Gahl v. Aurora Healthcare, Inc. Questions in this case remain. What authority does a medical power of attorney hold? What are patient rights if a patient refuses a standard of care that the patient or his representative requests?</p> <p>Returning to Crosstalk to discuss this case was Karen Mueller. Karen is the founder & general counsel for Justice and Liberty. She's the lead attorney in this case representing Allen Gahl. Allen Gahl is the nephew of, and medical power of attorney for, John Zingsheim. John became the focus of the case in 2021. He was admitted to Aurora Summit Hospital in Waukesha County where he was diagnosed with COVID-19. He was to be given Ivermectin, so Allen began requesting that from the hospital, however, they refused. In a two day conference hearing with lawyers, a judge decided that John had a right to get Ivermectin as an outside doctor that the family found that could be credentialed, enter the hospital, and administer the Ivermectin. Before the order could be fulfilled, the appellate court intervened and stayed the order on the granting of a writ of habeas corpus. Oral arguments in this case were presented before the Wisconsin Supreme Court a week ago. These arguments were about what treatment is best for COVID-19. Instead, Karen argues that this case is about the health care power of attorney rights that the legislature had given to Wisconsin citizens.</p>
1/24	Covid...Shots... Sudden Deaths... What's Going On?	Jim Schneider/ Dr. Elizabeth Lee Vliet	<p>Athletes from youth to college age have collapsed or died suddenly. A surfer standing on his board sud water for no apparent reason. A middle school teacher collapses in front of her class and dies. An airliner pilot becomes incapacitated shortly after takeoff and later dies. A news executive, a kindergarten student, and an American Idol contestant... all die suddenly.</p> <p>What's going on here? Is there any connection to COVID-19 or the shots? How long can we expect this to last? To help provide answers, Crosstalk welcomed back Dr. Elizabeth Lee Vliet. Dr. Vliet is the president and CEO of the Health Foundation, a non-profit public charity. Since February 2020, she's been part of the team of front-line doctors who got COVID early at home. With Dr. Peter McCullough, she is a co-author/editor of the <i>Guide to COVID Emergency Preparedness: Stay Out of Hospital and Save Your Life</i>. Dr. Vliet is a 2014 Ellis Island Medal of Honor recipient for her leadership in international educational efforts in health, wellness, and endocrine aging in men and women. She is a past president of the Association of American Physicians and Surgeons. She received her M.D. degree and internship in Internal Medicine at the Virginia Medical School and completed special training at Johns Hopkins. She is speaking today as an expert on COVID-19, not as a spokesperson for any healthcare system, pharmaceutical company, insurance plans or political party.</p> <p>Dr. Vliet believes the sudden deaths have a direct link primarily to the COVID shots. She noted that this phenomenon was known 20 years ago but they went ahead with them anyway. Interestingly, she also pointed out that the safety of shots, good, safe, manufacturing processes have basically been thrown out the window. When reviewing this Crosstalk you'll hear Dr. Vliet go into detail as she explains how the SARS-CoV-2 virus was found to be more lethal in the bio-weapons laboratory and to increase the inflammatory as well as the blood clotting. 1/26	Warning! Minnesota Fast Tracks Abortion Legislation	Jim Schneider/ Moses Bratrud	<p>As many of you know, the Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization decision that the Supreme Court issued on June 24th has taken abortion back to the states. Many already had laws on the books protecting human life in the state of Minnesota. Other states, without such protections, have taken this opportunity to advance legislation to protect human life. There have been states that have put pre-born children in the cross-hairs of their scope. Such is the case with the state of Minnesota. Appearing on Crosstalk to bring listeners the details was Moses Bratrud. Moses is director of communications for the Minnesota Family Council.</p> <p>The legislature in Minnesota had just been sworn in on January 3rd when a very destructive piece of legislation was introduced the next day in the Senate. Senate File 1 (SF-1) is known as the Protect Reproductive Options Act (PRO Act). This bill would put in Minnesota statute the right to abortion right up to the moment of birth.</p> <p>Going back to November 22nd, Democrats won a narrow election victory in Minnesota; 6 seats in the House and 1 seat in the Senate. This gives them a "trifecta" where with control of the governor's office, they have control of state government for the first time since 2014. So as you can see, they're wasting no time in exercising their so-called right to abortion.</p> <p>In the 1995 Doe v. Gomez decision, the Minnesota Supreme Court said that there is a right to abortion throughout the first trimester. However, the PRO Act, when combined with other Minnesota statutes and court cases, would allow abortion until the third trimester. So again, this would allow abortion until the moment of birth.</p> <p>The legislation passed 69-65 in the Minnesota House so there was one Democrat who decided to oppose the PRO Act. The Senate will convene tomorrow and this legislation is on the docket beginning at 10:30am where the PRO Act will have the abortion majority.</p> <p>Then there's companion legislation HF-91/SF-70. While these pieces of legislation have not been referred to the floor, it is noted how this would affect minors, their ability to get an abortion, and the possibility that it might cover up the PRO Act. It would cancel protections for viable pre-born babies as well as babies born alive during a botched abortion.</p>

1/27	News Roundup & Comment	Jim Schneider	<p>Here's a selection of news stories that Jim brought to the attention of listeners to wrap up the week:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Today is International Holocaust Remembrance Day, the anniversary of the liberation by Soviet troops of Berkenau concentration camps. -Nearly one-quarter of Dutch adult millennials and youth of Generation "Z" believe that the holocaust numbers of those who were killed by the Nazis was inflated. -The United Arab Emirates is rapidly becoming a friend of Israel and to the Jews thanks to the Abraham Accords. -Wisconsin Senator Ron Johnson and Iowa Senator Chuck Grassley have demanded that the National Archives release information about its involvement, knowledge, and role in the discovery of classified documents at various locations. -Senator Tom Cotton, a member of the Senate Intelligence Committee, said he and other Republicans will block Biden's nominees until the administration shares with Congress the classified documents seized at the Executive Order in his Washington office, and former President Trump's Mar-a-Lago estate. -Former Vice President Mike Pence notified the National Archives last Wednesday that a small batch of classified documents were found at his residence in Indiana. -The National Archives is formally requesting former presidents and vice presidents to recheck their personal files for classified documents or other presidential records. -The Biden think tank at the University of Pennsylvania, where the president stashed classified documents, it also hosted events in partnership with organizations that promoted closer engagement with China. -Authorities charged a former special agent in charge of the FBI's Counter Intelligence Division in New York with interpreting with breaking sanctions to work for a Russian oligarch. -A President Biden nominee for U.S. District Judge for the Eastern District of Washington said she did not answer questions about constitutional law when quizzed in a confirmation hearing on Wednesday. -House Speaker Kevin McCarthy has selected two of the 20 Republican holdouts who delayed his election to the House Rules Committee. -McCarthy officially rejected Adam Schiff and Eric Swalwell for seats on the House Intelligence Committee. Minority Leader Hakeem Jeffries nominated them last Saturday. Jim provided audio from McCarthy on the floor. -Adam Schiff announced he will run for the U.S. Senate. -Some Republicans are calling to abolish the IRS. -Nancy and Paul Pelosi sold up to 3 million dollars in shares of Google in recent weeks, just before the company launched its anti-trust probe of the tech giant.
1/30	Bibles Needed!	Jim Schneider/ Jason Woolford	<p>This past Christmas, many of you received a Bible for Christmas. What will you do with your old one? There's a ministry that collects used Bibles and distributes them to people around the world who are praying for someone might send them a Bible because they lack the resources to purchase a new one?</p> <p>To discuss how you can meet this critical need, Jim welcomed back Jason Woolford. Jason is the president of Mission Cry.</p> <p>The average home has over 7 Bibles sitting unused so Jason encourages people from around the U.S. to donate their Bibles. Once sent, they go through a sorting process, they get packaged, boxed, put on pallets, and then in throughout distribution points these materials are given away absolutely free. Mission Cry has sent over 1 million worth of free used Bibles and Christian books to over 178 nations around the world.</p> <p>Their missionary in China reported that Apple and Android Bible apps have been removed there for their lack of a phone. According to this missionary, this means the printed form of the Word of God is more necessary than ever. Jason explained that the containers are the 20 foot units that you see on large ships. They are filled with Bibles. Last year, Mission Cry sent English Bibles to 24 different nations and the need for Bibles is greater than the number of Bibles on hand.</p> <p>Donated Bibles will get into the hands of those attending seminaries and Bible colleges, prisons, orphanages, and evangelists, and missionaries who are native to that particular country.</p>

Additionally, her efforts led to a national law requiring parent consent for research using newborns, a campaign exposing HIPAA as a data-sharing rule, an online nationwide directory of direct-pay-practice, and the Freedom and the Patient Toolbox designed to help patients understand their options in coercive situations and make their own over their treatment decisions.</p> <p>Yesterday the White House reported that President Joe Biden intends to end the COVID-19 national health emergency. This won't happen today, nor will it happen retroactive to September 18th of 2022 when he declared the emergency. TV program that the pandemic is over. Instead, he will end the emergencies over 3 months from now or later. When?</p> <p>Twila noted that since the Republicans are now in charge of the House, they are clamoring for the end of the emergency declarations, so she believes Biden wants to claim to be the one who ended it rather than letting the Republicans. Could this be due to some legislative activity? For instance, there's HR-382—The Pandemic is Over Act. The Freedom for Healthcare Workers Act. This latter piece of legislation removes the vaccine mandate for federal workers around the nation. As Twila explained, the Biden administration has been clinging to the mandate that requires as a condition of participation in Medicare and federal programs, all healthcare providers and workers have to get vaccinated. They will be terminated unless they meet an exemption. This act would completely eliminate the mandate and let hospitals be more fully staffed, and not threaten healthcare workers with having to take an exemption. Next is HR-139—The Stopping Home Office Works Unproductive Problems Act of 2023, otherwise known as the Stop Home Office Act of 2023. Twila commented that so many government workers are now at home and there's the general lack of productivity going on as well as wasted space and energy in government buildings. So this bill would allow the expansion of telework practices and policies so it's really about calling such individuals back to work at government agencies.</p> <p>Another factor is House Joint Resolution 7 which basically says that the national emergency declared by the President is terminated.</p> <p>Another factor that may be pushing President Biden to end the pandemic on May 11th involves a new security law that includes including the government stopping COVID treatments, shots, etc. Then again, some things Congress must do to have access to telehealth. Then there's about 15-17 million people who were allowed to enroll in Medicare who were not because they should have been paying for coverage on their own.</p> <p>So as President Biden attempts to wind down the pandemic, there are a lot of details to work through. Jim will discuss much of it on this edition of Crosstalk.</p>

All of this shows we've moved away from the teachings of God's Word and have adopted concepts, false ideas and patterns that are in contradiction to the truth of the Word of God. The result of this is that Americans have 'flipped the coin'. Today, while people might make exceptions for serial murderers, many believe that virtually everyone that dies goes to heaven. That includes the ungodly who have lived lives in contradiction to what the Word of God says. Gary brought out many solid, Bible-based facts that point assuredly to the existence of hell. In fact, Jesus said in Matthew 7:13-14 that the narrow road that leads to destruction and most people go that way. Narrow is the road that leads to eternal life and hell. -Hell is mentioned 32 times in the Old Testament and 22 times in the New Testament. -There's the teaching of Jesus in Luke 16 regarding the story of the rich man and poor Lazarus. -Jesus spent more time teaching about hell than he did about any other subject with the exception of sin. <p>So why would a loving God send people to hell or even create hell in the first place? Questions like these are addressed with some interesting challenges presented from Crosstalk listeners.</p>
2/22	WHO Pandemic Treaty Warning...Again!	Jim Schneider/ Mat Staver	<p>Nearly a year ago, Crosstalk conducted several interviews with multiple guests about a very dangerous and concerning international Organization (WHO) pandemic treaty that would require the U.S. to surrender its sovereignty to this organization. President Biden had offered various amendments to the WHO's International Health Regulations, but unfortunately, the treaty was signed and warned listeners that this was only a pause in their efforts. This program is our way of letting you know that the treaty is still in effect and the WHO is meeting right now, discussing more radical amendments.</p> <p>Returning to Crosstalk to bring the latest details on the WHO's efforts was Mat Staver. Mat is the founder of Liberty Counsel. Mat is a constitutional attorney with three landmark cases before the U.S. Supreme Court. He is the host of the radio broadcasts <i>Faith & Freedom</i> and <i>Freedom's Call</i>.</p> <p>President Biden is supporting amendments to what's called the International Health Regulations. George Barna is the one who signed the U.S. on to this in 2005. He used the fact that we were a member of the WHO as leverage to get the U.S. to sign this international health agreement and he bypassed Congress to do so. The amendments at that time were not binding. The new amendments being proposed, which President Biden wants to sign and again bypass Congress, would change the WHO from a recommendation agency to a binding legal entity over all member nations.</p> <p>This would allow the WHO the ability to use mandatory global authority to regulate everything that falls within the realm of public health, even if it only has the potential to do so. This means that under this scenario, the WHO would impact many aspects of your life from healthcare, to food, and even your faith as they seek to push an agenda of equality (not the same as equality) and inclusion.</p> <p>In essence, as Mat communicated, the WHO would actually be a type of one-world/centralized government. It would be the director of the organization. Find out more about how and why they intend to do this as he reads the treaty documents.</p>
2/23	Christian Resistance	Jim Schneider/	<p>Resistance takes many forms such as that from the political realm when people resist policies or legislation. We can also see resistance within crime when individuals resist arrest. However, from a biblical Christianity there's another type of resistance we need to address. In this case it's a kind of resistance to resist the world while following Christ.</p>

		James Spencer	<p>Joining Jim to look at this issue was James Spencer. James is the president of D.L. Moody Center, an organization inspired by the life and ministry of Dwight Moody. He's author of the book: <i>Christian Resistance: Defy the World and Follow Christ</i>.</p> <p>The challenge for Christians is this: How do we go about navigating the expectations and social conventions as those things attempt to shape and form us into something other than Christ? At some point we need to stand up for things because our goal is to be conformed to the image of Christ.</p> <p>To begin, James defined the term, "resistance." At one time he was a personal trainer so he used to work with resistance in the form of weights. He explained how those weights are the pressure that you push or pull against of resistance because as you resist, your muscles break down and eventually become stronger.</p> <p>The other kind of resistance he was thinking of as he wrote his book was that of a dam. On one side you have turbulent water that is sitting against a huge concrete wall. Because the water is turbulent you can be forced back there's no great pressure when in fact that concrete wall provides a great deal of resistance to keep the water from getting through. He noted that this is a great way to think of Christian resistance. It isn't that we're trying to fight back against something. Instead, our resistance helps keep a clear separation and a strong boundary for ourselves so that things don't get into our lives and others stay in their proper place.</p> <p>What about the times when we resist against God and give into Satan's devices? Why is it so natural to do that when we should be doing just the opposite?</p> <p>James explained that most of the time when we resist, we follow the pattern from Genesis 3 where what happened between the serpent and Eve is him convincing her that God is not sovereign, wise and benevolent. He's saying that God is holding her and Adam back, that the world around them may appear to be ordered, but it's not the way that would exist if humans were in charge. So Eve was being taught to question God's ways and ignore His commands. Our resistance comes about in the same way because we don't always experience God nor trust Him and His ways. So if we don't trust Him, there's no reason for us to obey Him and follow after His ways.</p> <p>As this program continued, James looked at other factors that are part of the resistance equation such as</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Distractions—Those things that can cause us to make Jesus a background issue. • Knowing the Scriptures and how that plays out in terms of resistance. • Resistance and the "me" factor.

That's almost 3 weeks since the derailment. –President Biden has no plans to visit East Palestine, Ohio, in the near future. –The U.S. EPA is ordering the Norfolk-Southern to handle and pay for all necessary cleanup surrounding the derailment. –About 31 train cars carrying coal derailed in central Nebraska early Tuesday triggering a hazmat response. –President Biden made a surprise trip to Kyiv, Ukraine, Monday to show support for the war-torn nation. –One year after the Ukraine invasion, Russia has yet to realize any of its strategic goals and escalation strategy, as NATO deploys more troops to the eastern border. –The Department of Defense has announced another 2 billion dollars in defense spending for Ukraine. –On the one year anniversary of Russia's attack on Ukraine, the U.S. is hammering Russia with a new round of economic sanctions designed to undermine their ability to continue to wage war. –6 nations sided with Russia during a U.N General assembly resolution yesterday in which 141 countries voted in favor of a declaration in Ukraine and for Russia to withdraw its forces. Belarus, North Korea, Syria, Eritrea, Mali, and Nicaragua were the only nations opposing the declaration. –President Zelensky has warned China in a newspaper interview against supporting Russia in its war in Ukraine, saying doing so would bring on world war. –U.S. Secretary of State Antony Blinken warned China against providing military equipment to Russia. –Russian President Vladimir Putin discussed new levels of cooperation with China's top foreign affairs official. –A Chinese fighter jet suddenly began shadowing a U.S. patrol plane over the South China Sea today. –The People's Republic of China has called for a cease-fire between Russia and Ukraine, releasing a 12-point declaration on the one-year anniversary of the invasion.

			<p>Numerous recent news examples fit this framework as they simply defy, not merely common sense, but when viewed from a biblical perspective. Here are some examples:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -The Arizona legislature is considering a piece of legislation known as Senate Bill 1700. This would give parents an opportunity to review books and materials used in the schools for 120 days before they are available to students. This concerns books/materials that are lewd or so-called "gender fluidity, gender pronouns, or that groom children into normalizing pedophilia. A common sense question is: is this right? A group known as "Equality Arizona" described the legislation as "unconstitutional," "viciously targeting LGBTQ". -A high school teacher in Washington state suggested that schools should hide information about children's parents because kids, "are not safe in this nation from their Christo-fascist parents..." -In a new report, America's largest teachers union is encouraging educators to bargain for their health care, including abortion. -In a clear example of abortion tourism, an abortion business in New York is offering a new program for out-of-state life states. The "Out of Town" program brings women from their home state to the abortion facility in New York. -At a pro-abortion rally in Minnesota, a United Church of Christ pastor said if you don't support abortion, you're small. -Spain has a new animal welfare law that decriminalizes relations with animals because "zoophiles" are a crime on the trans flag. -A Memphis drag queen is threatening violence if Governor Bill Lee of Tennessee signs a bill that would ban attending drag performances. -A barrage of bills are working their way through the Illinois legislature. One bill would punish parents for sending verbal or visual messages intended to cause emotional distress to their children. 3/1	UN Pushing New Age Spirituality on Schoolchildren	Jim Schneider/ Alex Newman	<p>Children are under attack on many fronts, being indoctrinated sometimes in subtle ways, yet at other times overt. This takes place through broadcast media, social media, the educational system, libraries, and even in the home. In Matthew 18:6, Jesus gave a stern warning about the corruption of children. In spite of that, there remain children with a clandestine agenda. One such organization that's part of this is the United Nations.</p> <p>Returning to Crosstalk to provide proof was Alex Newman. Alex is an award-winning international free-lance researcher, educator and consultant. He's senior editor for The New American. He is founder of Liberty Sentinels.</p> <p>According to Alex, the U.N. has had an agenda to seize control over education from the time they set up the United Nations Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) in the aftermath of WWII. Julian Huxley was the first director of UNESCO. Along with UNESCO came the U.N. Universal Declaration of Human Rights. This is a document that states that children must go to school and that all education, "...shall further the activities of the United Nations." Moving forward a few decades we see the establishment of the U.N. World Core Curriculum. In the foreword to the manual, the writer acknowledges that the principles on which his curriculum is based come from Alice Bailey.</p> <p>Bailey was a New Age occultist and theosophist who was a disciple of Russian mystic Helena Blavatsky and the Lucifer Publishing Company. Djwahal Khul was actually not a teacher nor a Tibetan. He was actually a channeler. Bailey claimed to be channeling, referring to him as an ascended master. Both Bailey and her spiritualist colleagues were forthright concerning what they wanted to do. This included creating a one-world government/brain trust which was ultimately the tool John Dewey outlined to bring about this "New Age".</p> <p>Moving to today, UNESCO is involved in consolidating control over education throughout the world. The Mahatma Gandhi Institute of Education for Peace and Sustainable Development (a UNESCO agency) is focused on the fact that they're using social/emotional learning, neuroscience, and other pedagogies for the education of children into a radical set of political and religious beliefs.</p> <p>There is a long history of this kind of activity, but how is this affecting American classrooms today and what is the future? It's now a regular occurrence to hear about those in their teens or 20s who have had myocarditis or going into cardiac arrest. Others are questioning the use of mRNA vaccines, even as the CDC has issued a health alert on their safety. There's also great concern that the CDC is adding COVID-19 shots to the vaccine schedule for children and adults.</p> <p>To sort things out regarding this issue, Crosstalk welcomed back Barbara Loe Fisher. Barbara is the president of the Vaccine Information Center (NVIC), a non-profit charity she co-founded with parents of DPT vaccine in 1982. NVIC is a national, grassroots movement, and public information campaign to institute vaccine safety and informed consent protections in the public health system. She has researched, analyzed, and publicly addressed issues involving the science, policy, law, ethics, and politics of vaccination to become one of the world's leading consumer advocacy experts on the subject.</p> <p>Jim indicated that the first COVID-19 shot was given on December 14th of 2020. The narrative given to the public was that all is well and that the vaccines are safe. President Biden told America that if you get the shot, you're protected from COVID. We know now that isn't the case.</p> <p>So what have we learned since that first shot was given? As you may recall, the mRNA vaccines from Pfizer and Moderna rolled out in 2020 under what's called an Emergency Use Authorization (EUA). According to Barbara, the vaccines were officially licensed for young children so these vaccines are still under an EUA for them.</p> <p>When the vaccines began to be used, the Vaccine Adverse Event Reporting System (VAERS) began to receive reports that were very reactive and now we know that it is the most reactive vaccine ever put on the market. In fact, the VAERS data showed that the majority of people who received an mRNA vaccine were showing significant reactions.</p> <p>Barbara reported that just this week, the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) of the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) added the vaccines to the recommended childhood vaccine schedule. This effectively contaminated the nearby region.</p> <p>–Union leaders met with federal officials in Washington discussing railroad safety.</p> <p>–The Washington Post reviewed every possible regulatory change that was made under the Trump administration and found that none of them contributed to the Ohio train derailment as was alleged by Pete Buttigieg.</p> <p>–Contaminated soil and water from the Ohio derailment were being taken to areas in Michigan and Texas, not knowing about it.</p> <p>–A train, including two tankers carrying propane, derailed Tuesday near Sarasota, Florida, causing a scene that required hazmat crews to the scene.</p> <p>–The death toll has risen to 43 and a railroad worker was arrested Wednesday after a fiery, head-on collision with a truck in Northern Greece.</p> <p>–The former White House physician for president’s Obama and Trump has a warning for the U.S. regarding declining mental health.</p> <p>–China has accused the U.S. of deliberately destabilizing the tense security balance in Taiwan.</p> <p>–The Secretary of the Army warns that there could be and would be an attack by China’s military on the Korean Peninsula if a major war breaks out.</p> <p>–China approved 168 coal fired power plants in 2022.</p>
3/6	College of the Ozarks v. Biden	Jim Schneider/ Julie Blake	<p>When it comes to the LGBTQ+ agenda and its promotion, at the beginning we were told to simply tolerate it and be told to show acceptance. After that we were told we must celebrate it. Now we are being forced to participate in it. She is admitted to practice in multiple states, the Supreme Court of Missouri, the district and appellate courts.</p> <p>Julie explained that shortly after inauguration day in early 2021, President Biden issued a directive through the Department of Housing and Urban Development that redefined the term “sex” in the Federal Fair Housing Act. This directive required colleges and schools, including religious ones, to open their dormitories, shared shower spaces, and even locker rooms to members of the opposite sex. Alliance Defending Freedom (ADF) is representing College of the Ozarks in this case and they’re asking the Supreme Court to put an end to this overreach by government.</p> <p>So what took place up to this point at the lower court level? The lower courts communicated that while the government skipped all the normal procedures, and even though ADF pointed out how illegal the federal government’s actions in this case, they said that no school could sue until the government was coming after them by imposing fines, and damages. Only then could the school go to court and declare that what’s being done is unlawful. So what’s the deal? 3/20	The Banking Crisis: What's Going On?	Jim Schneider/ Alex Newman	<p>The collapse of Silicon Valley Bank is said to be the second largest bank collapse in U.S. history. Thousands of people are waiting to withdraw from their accounts. It looked like a run on the bank until President Biden, Treasury Secretary Janet Yellen and National Economic Council Director Lael Brainard stepped in to avert a crisis similar to that of 2008.</p> <p>Alex Newman returned to Crosstalk to bring his analysis to this issue. Alex is an award-winning international journalist, author, researcher, educator and consultant. He is senior editor for <i>The New American</i>. He is also author of <i>Educators and Deep State: The Invisible Government Behind the Scenes</i>. He is founder of Liberty Sentinels.</p> <p>What brought the collapse about? The approximate cause is that they were sitting on a very large number of bonds when interest rates rise, long-term U.S. treasury bonds decline in value. In other words, the bank was sitting on losses on the bonds. He contends that what we're seeing now is exactly what America saw in the run-up to the Great Depression. The first update concerned the charging of a Wisconsin Mother's Day fire-bombing of the office of Wisconsin Family Action in Madison, Wisconsin. The second update concerned a shooting this past Monday at The Covenant School, a private Christian school in Nashville, Tennessee, where 10 adults were killed.</p> <p>Bruce DeLange is a representative with Fellowship Tract League whose goal is to make the Great Commission a reality. Bruce is a former pastor and evangelist.</p> <p>Fellowship Tract League has been around since 1978. It began when Pastor Wash Pennington went to Myrtle, Mississippi, and came back "fired up" about printing gospel tracts. He presented the idea to the Lord and received a 100% support.</p> <p>It took about 6-8 years to produce 100 million tracts but now they average over 100 million each year. The world population stands at about 5.2 billion. Tracts are printed in many languages (between 85 and 90). They receive about 100 million tracts and they're shipped throughout America and around the world. All tracts are free as the Lord provides.</p> <p>This edition of Crosstalk looks at how effective tracts are, the excuses as to why some people won't pass the gospel, and how you can begin to reach others for Christ through tracts available in a free sample pack!</p>
3/30	Erwin Lutzer Rally – "We Will Not Bow"	Dalton Windsor	<p>Dr. Erwin Lutzer spoke at the Waukesha Expo for the VCY America Rally on March 18th, 2023. His topic was <i>Not Bow</i>.</p> <p>Dr. Lutzer is Pastor Emeritus of The Moody Church where he served as the senior pastor for 36 years. He has written radio programs <i>Running to Win</i> and <i>Songs in the Night</i>. He is a speaker and an award-winning author on topics of faith. His titles include <i>The Cross in the Shadow of the Crescent</i>, <i>Life Changing Bible Verses You Should Know</i>, <i>Silenced</i>, <i>No Reason to Hide</i> and <i>The Power of a Clear Conscience</i>.</p> <p>Dr. Lutzer began by mentioning Aleksandr Solzhenitsyn who told an interesting story. Solzhenitsyn said that he was given by someone who extolled the virtues and the greatness of Stalin. When he finished, everyone started to clap. Solzhenitsyn described how this went on for several minutes. Under such circumstances, who's going to stop first? After 11 minutes of non-stop clapping, the director of a paper factory stopped his clapping and sat down. Then everyone else then stopped as well and sat down.</p> <p>That same night the director of the paper factory was arrested and sent to prison for 10 years. During his trial he told never to be the first one to stop clapping.</p> <p>Dr. Lutzer said, "How does freedom die? Solzhenitsyn would say with thunderous applause; everybody else follows the system."</p> <p>Dr. Lutzer then asked if America is being "sovietized"? Victor Davis Hanson asked that question and he said that the Soviet Union it wasn't merit that enabled people to climb the ladder. Instead, it was loud enthusiasm for the system. Today, if you want to teach at a university, you'll be asked if you're willing to "sign-on" to the diversity and inclusion people via multiple pronouns and are you "on-board" with the LGBTQ community. In other words, to be a part of the competency, but loud enthusiasm for the orthodoxies of the day.</p> <p>However, as Dr. Lutzer noted, what we're seeing is not new. He pointed to Daniel 3, and as you'll hear in the next portion of this chapter that contains one of the most profound statements of faith in all of the Bible concerning the sovereignty of God.</p> <p>Will you stand up and clap or will you sit down? In other words, do you fear God more than you fear the world? Do you have an ideology of the world; an ideology that trumps biology, science and common sense? Have your faith but</p>

3/31	Covid Shot Changing Human Genome?	Jim Schneider/ Dr. Peter McCullough	<p>It was December 7th, 2022, when Senator Ron Johnson hosted a symposium called, <i>COVID-19 Vaccines: How They Work, and Possible Causes of Injuries</i>. Those that participated in that round-table discussion included scientists, public health officials, and medical professionals who discussed the background of the coronavirus, functionality of the vaccine, the impact of the pandemic response, early treatment drugs, adverse reactions, vaccine injuries, and plans for future research. One of the participants at that symposium was Dr. Peter McCullough, a man considered to be among the top experts on COVID-19. Dr. McCullough is an internist, cardiologist, and epidemiologist managing the cardiovascular complications of the viral infection and the injuries developing after the COVID-19 vaccine. Since the outset of the pandemic, he has been a leading voice in the medical response to the COVID-19 disaster and published <i>Pathophysiological Basis and Rational Treatment of SARS-CoV-2 (COVID-19) Infection</i>. This was the first synthesis of sequenced multi-drug regimens for COVID-19 patients infected with COVID-19 in the American Journal of Medicine. He has nearly 700 scientific publications and numerous peer-reviewed publications on the infection and has commented extensively on the medical and public health aspects of the COVID-19 crisis. He's testified before numerous legislative bodies and is the Chief Medical Advisor for the American Heart Association.</p> <p>This was an information-packed broadcast that opened with Dr. McCullough noting that the current COVID-19 vaccines are not sufficiently safe and effective. He believes they should be pulled from the market. In fact, it's now been established that COVID-19 vaccines cause heart damage in large numbers of individuals who take them, neurological damage, and other complications. In other words, the vaccines have exceeded all boundaries of safety.</p> <p>Dr. McCullough went on to discuss other aspects of this topic as well including how the vaccines appear to be altering the human genome, blood clotting, whether there are any transfusion related complications, vaccine induced immune reactions, and how a person can get the shot out of their body, his recommendations for early COVID intervention, and much more.</p>
