Alternatives are also being mocked by the media.</p> <p>Appearing on Crosstalk to present his views on this issue was Dr. Vladimir Zelenko. Dr. Zelenko is a board certified pediatrician and a physician with over 20 years of experience. He is published in top peer reviewed journals with world renowned scientists. The rally CEO of Answers in Genesis, the highly acclaimed Creation Museum and the world-class Ark Encounter Ken explained how America was greatly impacted by the Bible. They're sounding the alarm as they expose matters of egregious hospital abuses, neglect of basic medications to COVID patients.</p> <p>Addressing this issue was Dr. Elizabeth Lee Vliet. Dr. Vliet is the president and CEO of Truth for Health, a profit public charity. Since February 2020, she has been part of the team of front-line physicians treating patients at home. With Dr. Peter McCullough, she is a co-author/editor of the <i>Guide to COVID Early Treatment: Open Hospital and Save Your Life</i>. Dr. Vliet is a 2014 Ellis Island Medal of Honor recipient for her national and international educational efforts in health, wellness, and endocrine aging in men and women. She is a past director of the American Physicians and Surgeons. She received her M.D. degree and internship in Internal Medicine at Johns Hopkins Medical School and completed special training at Johns Hopkins. She appeared on Crosstalk as an independent spokesperson for any healthcare system, pharmaceutical company, insurance plan or political party. She is an advocate.</p> <p>Dr. Vliet began by commenting on Ali Schultz who was a power of attorney for her father-in-law at Mayo Clinic. Her father had been admitted for COVID and ended up as a medical prisoner without access to his family. She was also power of attorney for her mother-in-law at Banner Health Systems in Phoenix. She was harassed by law enforcement and removed from the Banner campus.</p> <p>Her mother-in-law passed away because she wasn't able to obtain treatment. Ali was finally successful in getting his law released from Mayo and save his life by getting him the effective treatment at home that he had been denied. This is one example showing how people are in some instances being isolated for prolonged period of time by state laws as well as against CDC guidelines for infectious quarantine.</p> <p>Ali legally recorded the hospital administrator at Banner Health Systems talking about the fact that all the administrators/executives met together 2-3 times per week to plan the COVID care. They were basically allowed regardless of the laws regulating health care power of attorney access to a patient. They were not in coordination to restrict fluids and other elements that aren't part of the COVID protocol that the federal government implemented under the CARES Act in 2020.</p> <p>Dr. Vliet then mentioned Ezekiel Emanuel who once wrote about the attenuation (rationing) of health care. The "curve" fell off to minimal care at about age 50. Joining the conference related to the conference was Alex Newman. Alex is an award-winning international freelance journalist, author, educator and consultant. He is senior editor for The New American and contributes to other publications. He has authored or co-authored several books such as <i>Crimes of the Educators</i> and <i>Deep State: The Invisible Government</i>. He’s founder of Liberty Sentinel.</p> <p>The program began with discussion concerning President Biden’s nominee for the Office of the Comptroller of the Currency, Saule Omarova is a Cornell Law School Professor. She wrote a thesis titled, “Karl Marx’s Economic and Political Theory of Revolution” while studying at Moscow State University. She’s advocated for the idea of not allowing banks to have bank accounts.</p> <p>After presenting the first of two audio clips from Omarova, Alex commented that the idea to use the central bank to control our accounts is what central banking does in the modern era. It could take the form of taking money out of our accounts or directly or stealing the value of our money by printing new money and spending it on goods and services. He went on to note how this gives insight into the Biden administration as this is the kind of thinking you would expect from a Marxist revolutionary or Soviet agent trying to undermine the U.S. economy.</p> <p>But what does this have to do with climate? Her radical views also have implications for oil, coal and gas. In a clip she openly admits she wants such industries to go bankrupt if we hope to tackle climate change.</p> <p>Alex believes this would make the West dependent upon dictatorships that are allied with Putin. So this is not about destroying the U.S. which is just what you’d expect a Soviet operative to do if put into a position of power. Globalist billionaires, Hollywood celebrities and big-time politicians typically show up at events such as COP26. The result? Alex noted that the British government said that the CO2 emissions associated with this latest summit were what they were from the one in Madrid.</p> <p>Could such blatant hypocrisy be a sign that the attendees don’t really believe what they’re telling the public about climate? Can the nomination of Omarova be stopped? What are Prince Charles and former President Obama’s views on climate? Is CO2 essential or not? Where does China stand in all of this? Bodie is a speaker, author and researcher at Answers in Genesis and a member of the National Review Board. He’s been involved with many books and DVD’s and is a regular speaker in the Creation Series. He’s the author, co-author or editor of numerous books including being co-editor of a book discussing the current broadcast, <i>The Gender &amp; Marriage War</i>.</p> <p>When did this war begin? Bodie noted that it began with sin but he suggested that moving ahead to the 19th century when, “...the modern gender and marriage war really started to take place.”</p> <p>He went on to describe how in the late 1700’s/early 1800’s a big shift was taking place in the West. When it came to these subjects, people began rejecting God’s Word. One of those was creation. People began to embrace man-made things like long ages for the earth as well as the attacks from higher criticism that began to unfold.</p> <p>Eventually we had the Scopes Trial in 1925 and before long the Bible and prayer began to be removed from schools. You consult with spiritual leaders, health care professionals, trusted consultants, and still have more questions than answers. And what happens when it seems the bottom falls out from your life. To watch the guest on this edition of Crosstalk knows, despite the trials, the challenges, and the heartaches, God is still in the picture. Shelly Hamilton has been a vital part in the ministry of her husband—Ron Hamilton, whose alias is <i>Patch the Pirate</i>—she chose, along with her husband, to “rejoice in the Lord” through the loss of his eye to cancer. The tragedy through was transformed into a lifelong blessing of music and ministry to children, families, churches, and the globe.</p> <p>Shelly continues to trust in God following the tragic death of their son Jonathan and the many trials they have faced. Their family, now including Ron's early-onset dementia that has so changed their lives. For decades, Shelly has been an administrative producer of the Majesty Music products including the Patch the Pirate Adventure Series, the <i>Rejoice Hymns</i>, and numerous other works. Ron served as a local church music minister for over two decades and served beside him as church pianist, special music coordinator, and administrative music librarian. She continues to serve the local church music ministry as a congregational pianist and accompanist. She is author of the book, <i>Always, Only Good: A Journey of Faith Through Mental Illness</i>.</p> <p>After the death of their son Jonathan (May 12, 2013), it was very difficult for Shelly to relive the mental illness that he dealt with for 15 years. It was at the age of 18 that he began taking an antibiotic for acne which triggered his mental illness. Eventually he was diagnosed with schizophrenia.</p> <p>Through this period Shelly was burdened for those who would contact her and say that they went through a similar experience with their child, spouse, parents or someone they loved or knew. So the year after Jonathan died she began writing a book chapter. Then in March of 2020, when they were in COVID lock-down, she was determined to finish the book despite the tear stains on her computer from having to recall past events.</p> <p>Overall, her motivation was her deep love for Jonathan, what he went through, and that hope runs deeper through difficult circumstances. She also cited a desire to remove the stigma of mental illness by letting people know that you can come alongside, encouraging onlookers to be more supportive, encouraging those with mental illness to keep taking their medications, bring them hope, as well as offering hope to those who are caregivers.</p>
11/18	The Covid Shot: Children, Expectant Women, Etc	Jim Schneider/ Dr. Elizabeth Lee Vliet	<p>In the latest COVID related news, we not only have OSHA finally relenting and pulling back the mandates for schools across the nation, young children are rolling up their sleeves following the example of Sesame Street and getting the vaccines.</p> <p>Many still wonder about the COVID vaccines. Are they safe and effective as we've been told? What are the risks? What about expectant women or women who one day want to have children?</p> <p>Returning to Crosstalk to discuss these questions was Dr. Elizabeth Lee Vliet. Dr. Vliet is the president of the American Health Foundation, a non-profit public charity. Since February 2020, she's been part of the team of front-line doctors who got COVID early at home. With Dr. Peter McCullough, she is a co-author/editor of the <i>Guide to COVID Early at Home</i> and <i>Stay Out of Hospital and Save Your Life</i>. Dr. Vliet is a 2014 Ellis Island Medal of Honor recipient for her leadership in international educational efforts in health, wellness, and endocrine aging in men and women. She is a past president of the Association of American Physicians and Surgeons. She received her M.D. degree and internship in Internal Medicine at Virginia Medical School and completed special training at Johns Hopkins. She spoke on this edition of Crosstalk as an independent physician, not as a spokesperson for any healthcare system, pharmaceutical company, insurance company, or political party. She is a patient advocate.</p> <p>Jim opened the discussion by noting that Robert F. Kennedy Jr. recently claimed in a Tucker Carlson interview that 19 vaccines are deadlier than all vaccines combined over the past 30 years.</p> <p>Dr. Vliet wasted no time in stating that he totally agrees from looking at the data from VAERS, the CDC's Vaccine Adverse Event Reporting System. It shows that if you look at all adverse events and deaths from all vaccines, we've dramatically reduced the number of deaths with the COVID vaccines in the first 6 months compared to 31 years with all others.</p> <p>As the nationwide push to get people vaccinated continues, children ages 5 and up are now included. Are there any risks if they fail to get vaccinated? She believes they are not at risk of hospitalization or death from COVID if they have an underlying medical condition such as morbid obesity, diabetes, cystic fibrosis, other lung diseases, etc. Children (high risk children) do better with early treatment and such options are available for them.</p> <p>According to Dr. Vliet, the normal vaccine development process would take from 2-5 years, perhaps 7, with the potential for adverse effects during that time before being offered for use by the public. She noted that we only had a limited amount of trial information before the different manufacturers rolled out the shots worldwide, while at the same time we were seeing adverse effects “fell off a cliff.”</p> <p>She put this in perspective when she communicated that the Swine Flu vaccine program was shut down a few years ago. It was a time when families took a break from time and lined the downtown route for the city’s annual Christmas parade. Children were enthusiastically tossed to them, while others were sipping coffee or hot chocolate during the windy, brisk afternoon.</p> <p>Jim provided audio from Waukesha Mayor Shawn Reilly who spoke to the media last evening along with the Waukesha Police Department, Daniel Thompson. Thompson reported that at 4:39pm, a red SUV drove barricades and into the parade route resulting in 5 deaths and more than 40 people who suffered injuries.</p> <p>Dan Reehoff, pastor of Dayspring Baptist Church in Pewaukee, Wisconsin, was an eye witness to this tragedy of his family and church there as well. During the first quarter hour he presented listeners with his account. Later he described how he and his wife were able to help both on the scene and at Waukesha Memorial Hospital sharing Gospel literature with individuals in the emergency room waiting area.</p> <p>During the second half hour, discussion moved to the issue of the brevity of life, how God views sin, His problem, and listeners capped off the broadcast with their comments.</p>

For example you have the federal Title VII laws for employees that protects them from where they can provide an exemption request to their employer. Jackson Women's Health Organization</i>.</p> <p>Appearing with Jim to present his evaluation of the case was Mat Staver. Mat is founder &amp; chairman of the American Liberty Union, is a constitutional attorney with over 230 published legal opinions, has authored 8 scholarly law review papers, and has written 10 books. He's filed numerous briefs and argued in many federal and state courts. He has also argued two times before the U.S. Supreme Court.</p> <p>The issue presented in this case is whether it would be upheld contrary to all court precedent going back to 1857. This is because Mississippi passed a law that bans abortions beginning at 15 weeks. This is prior to what is known as <i>viability</i> which is the baby's ability to live outside the womb. The controversy is over this viability. The viability is indicated as considered about 22-24 weeks depending upon the circumstances.</p> <p>Mat then proceeded to review some legal history beginning with <i>Roe</i> and the trimester system that came out of that. During the first trimester the state has no interest in regulating abortion. During the second trimester the state can regulate abortion such as physician licensing or where abortions take place. During the third trimester, when you get to the 28 week viability period, the state can put even more restrictions on abortion, but even then, they can't completely ban it.</p>

			<p>In 1992 we had Planned Parenthood v. Casey. The discussion at the time was that it would overrule Roe technology had made Roe's trimester system obsolete, as now children could be born into the second trimester, the central core of Roe, the trimester system, had to go.</p> <p>Eventually it was a 5-4 decision to overturn Roe. Chief Justice Rehnquist was writing the opinion, but Scalia pressured and lobbied Kennedy. 30 days after the opinion was in the process of being written, he flipped sides. Eventually it was a decision to uphold abortion but to also throw out the trimester system and replace it with a viability marker concerning a child's ability to live outside the womb on its own.</p> <p>It's this viability issue that's been part of the court precedence since that time.</p> <p>Moving up to 2018 we have Mississippi that passed its law banning abortion long before viability (15 weeks). The courts followed the Supreme Court precedent and struck this law down as did the court of appeals. However, judges on the court of appeals lamented to the Supreme Court that they were following this only because they had to adhere to what SCOTUS is doing, but they didn't like it and felt it ought to be reconsidered and overturned. Mat believes the Supreme Court could have simply ignored the case because of precedence from their own precedents, why take a case that follows their own precedence unless they want to re-examine that precedence and that's what's brought us to the oral arguments that took place yesterday.</p> <p>Mat has much more to say concerning this case and abortion in general, while listeners bring their own questions to the discussion.</p>

Under the statute, an organization like Wisconsin Family Action \$250 per year in expenditures (such as on advertising advocating for or against a federal candidate), must contributions, including the identities of the contributors names, etc. to the F.E.C. He has testified before the U.S. Senate and in several state legislative bodies, is the Chief Medical Advisor for the Truth for Health Foundation. He is considered among the world's experts on COVID-19.</p> <p>A majority of Americans have taken the vaccine so right from the start, Dr. McCullough debunked the idea that the pandemic of the unvaccinated. Additional proof comes in the form of Omicron because now we have more cases of COVID-19 than there was at any time before the vaccines came out.</p> <p>Dr. McCullough admits the vaccines are a medicinal attempt to try and induce immunity.
