She described a drop of 8-11% in the range of live births in the first quarter of Germany, Norway and several U.S. states. This means the COVID shots are resulting in the prevention infertility.  Then there's the death rate for millennials (those ages 18-44). There were 61,000 deaths in 9 months of came out. That's compared to 58,000 deaths in the 10 years of the Vietnam War in the same age group Jim also noted some interesting statistics from Dr. Joseph Mercola. In looking at data from the Internat Committee, he showed that there were 1,101 sudden deaths in athletes under the age of 35 between 196 average annual rate of 29 deaths across all sports.
