10/2	COVID Shot Concerns Continue to Escalate	Jim Schneider/ Dr. Elizabeth Lee Vliet	<p>Dr. Elizabeth Lee Vliet is president and CEO of Truth for Health Foundation. Since February 2020, she has led a team of frontline physicians treating COVID early at home. With Dr. Peter McCullough, she is a co-author of <i>COVID Early Treatment: Options to Stay Out of Hospital and Save Your Life</i>. She's a past director of the American Physicians and Surgeons. She received her M.D. degree and internship in Internal Medicine from Johns Hopkins Medical School and completed special training at Johns Hopkins. She appeared on Crosstalk as an independent advocate as a spokesperson for any healthcare system, pharmaceutical company, insurance plans or political party.</p> <p>Currently there's a lot of messaging going out from the White House and others promoting a new COVID booster. Do you know about the FDA approval process concerning this new booster? Was it only tested on mice? Dr. Vliet responded by going back to review some history. She noted that none of the COVID shots are fully approved. All of them are in use under the emergency authorization clause and therefore don't require full compliance with the good manufacturing practices or full disclosure of modifications and changes. She believes the FDA is playing a deceptive word game when they are announcing the new shot as "approved" but not do its full approval process, hence, the shots are not fully approved. What they did is approve the presentation of the new booster, they didn't approve the shot itself. In fact, no masks or test kits were ever FDA approved and the semantics game to deceive people.</p> <p>The booster is a revision of past boosters but all of the COVID shots are still operating and given licenses under the use authorization legislation which leaves good manufacturing practices, waves the disclosures and waives the consent process that the public should be given.</p> <p>Why is this still the case with every shot still under the EUA after about 3 years? Dr. Vliet noted that they have been covered up. Those that have been trying to communicate this get censored, shut down and accused of spreading misinformation. She believes it's all about deceiving people into getting boosters that with each one you are causing damage from the inflammation of the spike proteins and the lipid nanoparticle toxicity. The result has been the turning off of tumor-suppressor genes which are our natural defense against cancer, damage to the brain, the reproductive organs, thyroid and adrenal glands, pancreas and the GI tract.</p> <p>Dr. Vliet had much more to share so become informed by reviewing this important edition of Crosstalk.</p>
10/3	The Life & Legacy of William Tyndale	Jim Schneider/ Dr. David Brown	<p>We have it pretty easy in America as it pertains to religious liberty. We can go to Bible teaching church, listen to Christian radio, watch Christian television, hand out Gospel tracts, and even view the Bible on our smartphones in any language, and enjoy it without fear of being arrested by the secret police.</p> <p>Some of you may not be aware but there's a critical figure in church history who died so we can have the freedom of person is William Tyndale.</p> <p>Returning to Crosstalk to tell the fascinating history behind this man was Dr. David Brown. Dr. Brown is a member of the Baptist Church of Oak Creek, Wisconsin. He holds a Master's Degree in Theology and PhD in History from the University of the English Bible. He's the president of the King James Bible Research Council. He is also the president of the Communication Consortium, a research organization that produces a large variety of materials warning of the dangers in our culture. Pastor Brown is an author of <i>The Indestructible Book: Examining the History of the Bible</i>.</p> <p>Dr. Brown described William Tyndale as, "...the man that God used to help break the vice-grip/grasp of the Roman Catholic Church on the people because Rome only wanted them to have a Bible in Latin and didn't even want them to have the Bible in Latin." God, however, raised up Tyndale and in 1526 he brought us the first English New Testament.</p> <p>Tyndale was born in 1494 from a wealthy family near North Nibley, Gloucestershire. He was ordained as a Catholic priest, then from 1517-1521 he attended Cambridge which was a "hotbed" for the Greek New Testament and the teachings of Martin Luther. Tyndale was saved there as he began reading the Greek and the Latin Bible which created a desire within him to see others be able to read God's word.</p> <p>Dr. Brown described an encounter Tyndale had with another Roman Catholic priest, who in frustration of Tyndale's work quoting the Bible, said, "We were better to be without God's law than the Pope's." Tyndale responded, "If God spare my life, ere many years past, I will cause that a boy that driveth the plow shall know more of the Scripture than thou dost!"</p> <p>In 1522, Tyndale took the work of Erasmus and meticulously translated his Greek text into English. He was arrested, tortured and a warrant was issued for his arrest. You'll hear how Tyndale was betrayed by a man named John Lee who pretended to be his friend. Phillips set up a supper meeting where soldiers were prepared to grab Tyndale. Tyndale was arrested and put in prison for 500 days. However, he never moved from the idea that faith was the only way to God. On October 6, 1536, he was burned to ashes, but before that his last words were, "Lord, open the King of England's eyes." Dr. Brown brings much more detail, and you can hear it all, on this historical look back at the life of William Tyndale.</p>
10/4	Gender Dysphoria? Biological Integrity Initiative	Jim Schneider/ Dr. Jill Simons	<p>The numbers of children dealing with gender dysphoria is off the charts. The result? A recent report out of the University of Toronto over one-third of children on puberty blockers were experiencing worsened mental health. LifeSiteNews has released some disturbing new data from the Canadian Institute for Health showing hundreds of minor girls from Canada who had their gender removed in the past 5 years under the guise of treatment for gender confusion. The Washington Free Beacon has reported that Planned Parenthood is helping teenagers transition after nothing more than a 30 minute consult, doling out hormones like estrogen and testosterone, including to special needs children.</p> <p>In response, the American College of Pediatricians has launched a new biological integrity initiative with the goal of protecting the dangers of transgender procedures on children.</p> <p>With more on this issue, Jim welcomed Dr. Jill Simons. Dr. Simons is executive director of the American College of Pediatricians. She is a Board-Certified Pediatrician and is in private practice in Minneapolis, Minnesota. She is a staff member of Children's Minnesota and Mercy Hospital. She served as Chairman of Pediatrics for Mercy Hospital from 2005-2008 and helped establish the hospital's NICU and pediatric trauma programs and was featured in Mpls. St. Paul Magazine in 2010. She is also Fellow of the American Academy of Pediatrics and has been a member of the Section on Developmental and Behavioral Pediatrics as well as the section on Bioethics. Dr. Simons is also a member of the American Academy of Sleep Medicine.</p> <p>What is gender dysphoria? Dr. Simons noted this is a "catch all" phrase that refers to a person that is uncomfortable with the sex that they are. She believes social media is contributing to this problem, but the underlying problem is not gender dysphoria is mental health. Specifically, this can include anxiety, depression, poor self-esteem, and even suicidal thoughts, from autism. In short, they're looking for answers as to why they feel the way they do and want to find a way to feel better.</p> <p>Included in such a discussion are the various medical interventions that are often utilized. One of them is the use of puberty blockers. These are drugs used to treat medical conditions where puberty begins early (precocious puberty). However, these blockers are being used to block the normal onset of puberty in order to keep the child in an immature state. Dr. Simons is that there are dangers to using these medications on the skeletal and muscle structures but Dr. Simons</p>

			<p>don't know all the effects that will take place when puberty is put on hold for long periods of time. Also, drugs before entering puberty and then placed on opposite sex hormones in high doses, they will never have children. They'll be infertile.</p> <p>Speaking of cross sex hormones, these can result in osteoporosis, diabetes, cancer, there's a risk for heart disease and other effects.</p> <p>Dr. Simons sees even earlier interventions such as dressing as the opposite sex and/or adopting a different gender pronouns as harmful. She believes they set the child on a "conveyor belt" that is hard to leave. It sets the child on a path where eventually that's not enough which leads to puberty blockers, cross sex hormones and eventually surgery. Shahram exposes the threat of Sharia in America. He has served as a pastor, a police officer and a former candidate for Governor of the State. Jim read a quote from President Isaac Herzog of Israel that appeared in Israel National News. The president said the Hamas attack doesn't represent Islam and that this isn't a war of Jews against Muslims, it's a war between the people of light, and the people of darkness, between good and evil. Shahram commented that this is a delusional statement. He followed this up by asking what you'd say if you were on the path of Islam over the past 1,400 year? One example is Shahram's birth nation of Iran that fell to Islam in 651 AD. Has not been loving in Iran, or about freedom or tolerance regarding women or religious minorities. Islam is nothing but totalitarian, abusive and murderous. Shahram believes the statement from President Herzog is a political one that seeks to placate; that perhaps the Biden administration since we know Israel is delaying the ground invasion of Gaza. This pressure is due to the many pro-Hamas individuals serving within the Biden administration. Critical to this discussion is Hamas and their history. Hamas was started by the Muslim Brotherhood. It was formed in 1928 and eventually they supported the Nazi cause of Jewish extermination. They've been active since the late 1950's. In 1987 they formed a group called the Islamic Association of Palestine. That group became the Hamas and eventually labeled by the U.S. State Department as a terrorist organization in 1993. In 1994, the Muslim Brotherhood formed the Council on American/Islamic Relations (CAIR) which is the funding arm of Hamas. They describe themselves as the largest Muslim civil rights advocacy organization. So when you hear the name "CAIR" come up in news reports, it's Hamas in America. The Hamas charter, which was written in 1988, declares they are an Islamic organization. Shahram gave a copy of the charter, a quote which Hamas supports via multiple verses from the Qur'an and the Hadith: "Israel will exist, and will continue to exist, until Islam abolishes it as it abolished that which was before it." Shahram also communicated that the reason we know CAIR is Hamas is because in 2007, the federal government established a charity in Texas called the Holy Land Foundation Charity. At least 12 million dollars was being funneled to these Islamic charities. CAIR is one of the organizations that was listed as an unindicted co-conspirator in the 9/11 attacks and that designation remains with them to this day due to their support of Hamas. He was charged with "Free Palestine" and "Kill Jews." -Several Jewish students were attacked and injured by a pro-Palestinian mob at Tulane University. -Maine Governor Janet Mills said yesterday that 18 people are dead and 13 were injured after a gunman opened fire on a church evening in multiple locations in the town of Lewiston, Maine. Police have a warrant out for the arrest of the gunman. -Former President Donald Trump bolted out of a New York courtroom after the presiding judge, a demagogue, announced a verdict for a directed verdict despite the fact that the testimony of the state's star witness fell apart. -A judge in Colorado has refused to dismiss a lawsuit aimed at blocking former President Donald Trump from appearing on the state's 2024 presidential ballot over claims he engaged in "insurrection" in the aftermath of the 2020 election. -The FBI received information about possible criminal activity involving the Biden family from over 40 sources over an extended period of time, but most avenues of investigation were thwarted, Senator Chuck Grassley revealed in a letter to Attorney General Merrick Garland. -House Intelligence Committee Chair Mike Turner said that President Joe Biden needed to be treated as a criminal over President Trump over his alleged mishandling of classified government documents. -Louisiana has become the most recent state to adopt a ban on "Zuckerbucks." That's the injection of political money into the election administration. -Marjorie Taylor Green blasted the recent plea deal reached by Representative Jamaal Bowman over his alleged involvement during votes for a resolution on U.S. government spending. -The U.N. is pushing for interlocking technologies including global digital I.D., global health records, global financial currencies and social credit scores, enabling using digital tracking technologies and interlocking data bases to create a centralized authority, such as the United Nations, could regulate each person's life down to the most intimate details.

Jews are also being targeted all over the world, including within the U.S.</p> <p>Israel's response to the Hamas attack is called, "Swords of Iron." As Chris described it, even with pressure from the international community, Israel's response in her defense is one where the nation can't give up. They can't do what Hamas, but also to Iran, that they will no longer put up with their "proxy" in Gaza.</p> <p>While rockets being fired from Hezbollah is a concern, Chris believes the biggest deterrent in the north is the U.S. in the Mediterranean. This sends a message to Iran and Lebanon, even though we're seeing attacks in the region. He believes Iran may actually be telling Hezbollah to "hold back" and not attack because he is waiting to see the outcome of the war between Israel and Hamas.</p> <p>Chris indicated that the ground assault shows success thus far as they've already encompassed Gaza City and northern city in the Gaza strip. So right now the largest difficulty is not getting into the area, but instead it's about how to get in which has their large tunnel network underneath the city and their recognized headquarters underneath the city.</p> <p>The details of this ongoing war are many and you'll hear Chris as he brings you up to date concerning the war. How do you count on the accuracy of casualty numbers? Are Israeli's standing behind Netanyahu, the government, and the military, causing a rise in anti-Semitism around the globe? On the national level, the one thing for the Supreme Court to say that it's OK to kill the pre-born, but when the people decide, then the culpability goes way up. But be forewarned, he also indicated that God allows things to rise prior to judgment. Brad has a phrase he uses. It's "spiritual death camp." He uses it to describe public schools that are so different from years ago as they're brain-washing youngsters, right down to the Kindergarten. The legal recourse parents have when girls have to deal with boys in locker rooms or competitive sports. Private Christian schools are not immune from attack. He gave the example of a private Christian school in California that was raided by police because a few of the children were not wearing their crosses. Howard Callahan	<p>The guest on this edition of Crosstalk has written a fascinating and captivating book with strong evidence and a wonderful and wise creator, as Scripture points to in Romans 1:20.</p> <p>E. Howard Callahan is a retired chemical engineer who spent years working in the fields of chemistry and development work revealed to him that God indeed made the world. He's done R&D work on a variety of things and many uses in humans, also R&D for an anticancer drug-delivery system. He also helped develop and manage a medical device for very large wounds. As a Christian, he's spent over 60 years studying the Bible and how it applies to the world and holds a master's degree in theology. He is author of the newly released, <i>Instincts by Design: Instincts in Humans & Animals in Creation</i>.</p> <p>In preparing to write his book, Callahan discovered that instincts are more complex than he thought. In fact, instincts are DNA (atheist scientists agree) with the information being like a computer program. When called upon, instincts are that's important for the life, growth or protection of the creature.</p> <p>As he looked at research from non-believers, he saw a critical error they'd make. Most of them believed that evolution was God, so evolution wouldn't fit with some of the words they were using. In their descriptions they would use words and phrases such as "miracle," "designed," "extraordinarily complex," "uniquely constructed" or they'd say "largely unknown."</p> <p>While proof of God's design should be obvious, we often don't see it. As Callahan said, "It's the elephant in the room and we just ignore it. It’s known as adverse possession. In this case, by your silence, you’re giving approval for them to take your land.</p> <p>This principle is also in our U.S. Constitution, Article 1, Section 7. Congress passes a bill. They send it to the president. He can veto the bill, sign it, or he can simply let it sit on his desk for 10 days. However if the president is silent, anything with it, it automatically becomes law as if he had signed it.</p> <p>William then reminded listeners about Acts 22. Paul recognized that when Stephen’s blood was shed, he was guilty. He threw a single stone, just standing by meant he was consenting to his death.</p> <p>So if a child wants to transition, should we just stand by and “love them” or just “accept them” as they say? The Bible, Scripture, part of love involves correction. William explained how we don’t simply let our children walk away from sin. 12/11	Islam's Goal: Worldwide Caliphate	Jim Schneider/ Shahram Hadian	<p>Since Hamas launched its barbaric attack against Israel on October 7th, more and more uprisings are appearing in the world. Those involved are saying with great boldness that Israel is the problem, they should be destroyed, they have no right to defend themselves.</p> <p>Why are they saying such things? The goal is a worldwide caliphate which includes the United States, where only Islam is accepted. All others would need to be killed because the Qur'an teaches that all Jews and Christians are infidels.</p> <p>Bringing more clarity to this subject was Shahram Hadian. Shahram is a former Muslim from Iran who converted to Christianity in 1978 and committed his life to Jesus Christ. Shahram started the Truth in Love Project and is the founder of the Love Ministry. He exposes the true goal of Islam and the threat of Sharia in America. He's served as a pastor and a former candidate for governor in Washington State.</p> <p>Fathi Hamad, a Palestinian politician and political leader of Hamas, declared on December 1st on Al-Aqsa TV that Palestinians are preparing to establish an Islamic caliphate with Jerusalem as its capital.</p> <p>What is a caliphate? Shahram explained how Islam has been working on establishing a worldwide caliphate for many years. They seek global domination where every nation on earth is governed by Islamic law. This means that Islam is both religious and political. The mosque is the state and the state is the mosque. This can take the form of force or the majority of the population becoming Islamic. This is something Christians in America don't understand because we live under the idea of a proper separation between church and state.</p> <p>The promotion of a caliphate is the mission of groups like the Muslim Brotherhood. In 1991 when they released their "Explanatory Memorandum" (which was discovered by the FBI in a raid in 2004) it noted that their goal was to turn this miserable house (America) by jihad in order to establish Islam. They also indicated they would do this through the hands of (Muslims) and unbelievers. In other words, they seek to use the hands of our own citizens so that America becomes Islamic. For about 15 years Shahram has been seeing this play out in places like Minneapolis, New York, and Texas.</p> <p>What about the cries that Israel is the occupier? Shahram explained how the Jews have been in that region for many years, far longer than any Arabs. We also know there was never a nation called "Palestine" nor a people called "Palestinians." This terminology was given as an insult to the Jews (derived from the name of Israel's neighbors, the Philistines) during the Roman occupation after the time of Christ.</p> <p>So to claim that Israel is an occupier is to refute history on this and one more level. It's the idea that the Jews were never offered a nation. After Britain took control of the Holy Land, in 1937 the Peel Commission, which was the UK, offered the Arabs a state. This land was two-thirds the size of what the Jews were offered. Arabs rejected it because they wanted it all plus Jerusalem.</p> <p>In 1947, the United Nations offered a 50-50 plan. That plan was also rejected by the Arabs once again, because they wanted the land plus Jerusalem.</p> <p>Then in 2005, when Israel pulled out of Gaza, the Palestinians were given autonomy. Who took control of Gaza? Hamas, a group that is supported by two-thirds of Palestinians.</p> <p>In the end a person can't claim Israel is an occupier when, at least in recent history, Arab Palestinians wanted a state and rejected it simply because they didn't want the Jews there. This makes the cries of "occupation" and "occupation propaganda" which is interesting because Islam has no claim on Jerusalem as this city isn't mentioned in the Quran as a way of that goal.</p> <p>This is the basis for a fact-filled broadcast that includes much more, including audio from Islamic leaders and listeners nationwide.</p>

Alex is an international freelance journalist, author, researcher, educator and consultant. On the “don’t” side of things, John pointed out that you can’t argue anyone into the kingdom of God. He was sharing with him whatever skills and abilities you have, the Lord can use them on the mission field. After the presentation, Alex realized the missionary what the greatest obstacle was in getting to the mission field. The missionary told him it was that he was the very week Alex and his wife had become financially debt free. There went that excuse!</p> <p>Eventually Alex and his wife found themselves as dorm parents at an academy in the Philippines. That's where kids were selling friendship bracelets that would allow them to provide for the basic needs for the children. To help listeners sort through this issue, Crosstalk welcomed Brad Dacus. Brad is president and founder of the Anti-Semitism Institute. Their mission is to defend, without charge, the religious freedoms, parental rights, and other civil liberties of individuals who cannot defend themselves. Brad previously served as Legislative Assistant to U.S. Senator Ted Cruz. He received his Juris Doctor from the University of Texas, School of Law.</p> <p>Earlier this month, the Anti-Defamation League reported that from October 7th to December 7th, a record number of anti-Semitic incidents took place. That’s up from 465 recorded incidents recorded in the same period in 2022, a 337% increase in a year.</p> <p>What’s going on here? Have people just suddenly become anti-Semitic? After all, Brad reminded listeners that the October 7th Hamas attack on Israel was the catalyst. He indicated that while a small amount of this might be looking for a cause, he believes that this is anti-Semitism coming to the surface that was there even before the attack. What should be very alarming.</p> <p>Brad also noted that these deep issues of anti-Semitism are coming from Muslim students who are here on visas, as well as a large percentage of first, second, third and fourth generation Muslims living here as well.
