

WPTV-TV Renewal Public Notice Certification


Station WPTV-TV inadvertently failed to timely start airing the required announcements about the filing of its renewal application as required by Section 73.3580 of the FCC's rules, and a subsequent misunderstanding by its sales department led to the December 16 announcement not airing as scheduled. Accordingly, in consultation with the Commission's staff, the station aired a number of announcements beyond the six required by the rule. The announcements aired on the following dates at the following times:


The text of the post-filing announcement was:

On October 24, 2014, Station WPTV-TV was granted a license by the Federal Communications Commission to serve the public interest as a public trustee until February 1, 2021. Our license will expire on February 1, 2021. We have filed an application for renewal with the FCC. A copy of this application is available for public inspection at www.fcc.gov. It contains information concerning this station's performance during the last six years. Individuals who wish to advise the FCC of facts relating to our renewal application and to whether this station has operated in the public interest should file comments and petitions with the FCC by January 1, 2021.
