EXPLANATION OF ISSUES

1. CHILDREN, YOUTH, FAMILY, AND COMMUNITY NEEDS: THE CAMAS PRAIRIE STRIVES TO BE KNOWN AS A GOOD PLACE TO RAISE YOUR CHILDREN. WE PROVIDE ADVICE AND ENCOURAGEMENT TO PARENTS WHO ARE TRYING TO MEET THEIR CHILDREN'S NEEDS AS WELL AS TRAIN THEIR CHILDREN TO BE RESPONSIBLE ADULTS. IN ADDITION WE PROVIDE INFORMATION FOR YOUTH, SINGLES, AND PROVIDE COMMUNITY NOTIFICATIONS.

- 2. MARRIAGE/DATING/MEN'S & WOMEN'S ISSUES: THE CAMAS PRAIRIE HAS ITS SHARE OF MARITAL PROBLEMS, AS WELL AS OTHER COMMON ISSUES THAT PLAGUE THE SINGLES OF OUR SOCIETY. IT IS OUR DESIRE TO GIVE MEN AND WOMEN COUNSEL AND SUPPORT REGARDING ALL ISSUES THAT CONFRONT AND CHALLENGE THEM ON A DAILY BASIS.
- 3. LOCAL & NATIONAL MORAL FIBER AND ECONOMY AND CAREERS: DRUG RELATED CRIMES, UNWANTED PREGNANCIES, SCHOOL SHOOTINGS AND FATHERLESS FAMILIES ARE ALL SYMPTOMS OF A DECLINING CULTURE. THIS IS PREVALENT IN NEARLY EVERY COMMUNITY THROUGHOUT OUR NATION AND THE CAMAS PRAIRIE IS NO EXCEPTION. WE AIR PROGRAMMING INTENDED TO DEAL WITH SUCH ISSUES BY ATTACKING THE PROBLEMS OF SOCIETY AT ITS SOURCE THE HUMAN HEART. IF YOU CHANGE THE HEART YOU CHANGE THE ACTIONS. IN ADDITION, THE CAMAS PRAIRIE HAS A HIGH LEVEL OF UNEMPLOYMENT AND SO KKRH WANTS TO GIVE OUR LISTENERS TOOLS IN FINDING PERMANENT EMPLOYMENT.
- 4. SOME OF THE HEALTH ISSUES WE STRUGGLE WITH TODAY ARE BEYOND OUR ABILITY TO CONTROL. OTHERS ISSUES, SUCH AS THE EFFECTS OF STRESS, ARE OFTEN WELL WITHIN OUR ABILITY TO OVERCOME. THROUGH EDUCATION, KKRH OFFERS HOPE AND ENCOURAGEMENT TO TROUBLED MINDS IN A DIFFICULT WORLD.

5. LOCAL, STATE, NATIONAL GOVERNMENT & EDUCATION: THE CAMAS PRAIRIE HAS A

NUMBER OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS. WE TRY TO KEEP THE PUBLIC INFORMED OF

DEVELOPMENTS IN THE FIELD OF EDUCATION, AND TO MAKE INFORMATION AVAILABLE

FROM MANY SOURCES THAT MAY BE BENEFICIAL TO PARENTS WHO ENDEAVOR TO GIVE
