KTHH-AM provides listeners with programming and public service announcements addressing issues of concern, as well as community events to Linn and Benton Counties, and surrounding areas. Among the issues determined to be of concern to our community during the calendar quarter were:

Investments: While the state, and the nation are mostly recovered from the unemployment caused by the Great Recession, the investment situation for those preparing for retirement has completely changed with low returns on formerly “safe” investments.

Veterans: Vets find themselves in the crosshairs after voters overwhelmingly voted to allocate extra funds for veteran’s programs in the state, with the Governor saying she wants to use those funds to hire state workers in the face of a 1.8-billion-dollar budget shortfall.

Counties vs. the State: Legislators at the state level, continue to force new spending on counties, while cutting off traditional revenue sources. A number of counties are now deciding to take the state to court.

Transportation: While the state faces a looming budget shortfall of 1.8-billion-dollars, Governor Brown and legislators want to increase spending dramatically on transportation projects statewide. The dichotomy is leaving many to ask, can the state, in particular the Oregon Department of Transportation be trusted with the money?

Issue: The Human Biome

Guest: Dr. Robin Chutkan, Physician, Researcher, Author of “Gut Bliss”

Show: A newer branch of medicine is beginning to acknowledge that each person is different beyond their DNA. While medicine for years has mostly demonized bacteria, each person has good bacteria living in their bodies. These bacteria not only help the body digest food, but balance the body's PH, and more. Chutkan discusses how antibiotics given for disease, and those given food animals cause imbalances in our personal biome that can affect people in fairly dramatic ways, causing disease and organ problems. Chutkan discusses a proper pro-biome diet, pre-biotics, and pro-biotics, and how modern medicine is beginning to acknowledge the importance of biome balance.

Guest: Dr. Daniel Bober, Former VA Physician, Member of the First Congressional Task Force to address problems with the VA, and military support activist.

Show: Over a year has gone by since the controversy surrounding unacceptable VA wait times for appointments. And now a new report shows little has changed in the last year. In the case of two Oregon VA hospitals in Portland, and Roseburg the situation has gotten worse over the last year. The two hospitals went from lower middle of the pack in terms of wait times to becoming two of the worst in the nation. Bober describes how the VA failed to address the issue by not adopting new technology, by continuing to employ directors of failed hospitals, and by focusing on hiring administrators instead of caregivers.

Guest: Gary Conley, President of Conley Capital Investors, Personal Wealth Advisor

Show: In past decades many people invested in a variety of lower risk, but interest gathering instruments to grow personal wealth, and put aside money for retirement. With CD's only earning .5% interest, and many bonds including treasuries earning even less, many people are stuck on where to invest. Many people are afraid of the stock market after 2008, and are sitting on cash wondering where to put their money to work. Conley discusses some investment strategies to maximize personal wealth. In particular, he discusses how someone with only a small amount of cash may invest their money. Conley also discusses paying down your personal debts, and how to teach yourself to be a smart investor. Conley also talks about the importance of having liquid assets to be able to invest in a timely manner when opportunity arises.

Issue: Preparing for Disaster, and the Fragile Grid

Guest: William Forstchen, Author of One Second After, Professor of History and Faculty Fellow at Montreat College, in Montreat, North Carolina.

Show: Forstchen first became interested in the fragility of the power grid after he was given a government report on the grid by then House Speaker, Newt Gingrich. The report painted a bleak picture of how the U.S. grid was susceptible to EMP events, and that an attack by an enemy nation could easily take down the grid causing, according to the government report, the death of 80% of the population within 12 to 24 months. Forstchen became the father of the “prepper” movement, and believes in preparing for the worst, while sincerely hoping it doesn’t happen. Forstchen talks about how nothing has been done since the bleak government report in the 90’s to shore up the grid, and how to prepare yourself for surviving a major disaster.

Issue: The State of Oregon versus Oregon Counties

Guest: Roger Nyquist, Chairman of the Linn County Board of Commissioners.

Show: For years counties have claimed that State Government acts in favor of special interests, while neglecting the state’s rural counties in terms of unfunded mandates, and economic development through natural resources. In 2016 Linn County’s Board of Commissioners decided to sue the state of Oregon on two different issues, and a number of other counties have joined those suits. The first suit is over lands that were set aside for logging in the 30’s under the O and C act, that have been shut down for nearly 25 years by environmental activists. According to Nyquist the Act was specific in how the lands were supposed to financially benefit the counties, and now Linn along with a handful of other counties are suing for nearly 50 billion dollars in money they say they are owed. The second suit deals with increases in the minimum wage for part-time employees which Linn Co. says is an unfunded mandate, and unconstitutional. Other counties not involved in the suits are watching Linn Co. to see if the county is successful in its suits, and may follow up with legal actions as well.

Issue: Unsolved Murders in Oregon

Guest: Thomas Hargrove, Statistician, former Investigative Journalist, creator of the Murder Accountability Project

Show: Oregon is one of the worst states in terms of unsolved murders with only 60% of murder cases being closed statewide. Hargrove created a computer software system that tracks murder cases nationwide and can accurately determine whether a serial killer is active within a region, and also track murder rate closures on a national, state, county and municipal level. His system is starting to be used by law enforcement around the country. Hargrove's system can also track murder trends over the course of decades. In terms of Oregon, he is able to show a direct link to disinvestment in Oregon State Police funding, and an increase over the last 20 years of unsolved murders within the state. He says that certain counties, like Linn, Benton, and Lane Counties have lower than average numbers for murders which he equates to higher than average support for county law enforcement monetary support.

Issue: Oregon Department of Transportation Accountability

Guest: Joe Cortright, Economist, Founder of Impresa Consulting

Show: Cortright was part of the consulting team that worked on the Columbia River Crossing Project to build a new bridge across the Willamette River to Washington in Portland. The project headed by ODOT spent nearly 500 million dollars, yet never broke ground, and was eventually abandoned by the state. Cortright, a proponent of the project, began to study the ODOT planning, and procurement process, and realized that ODOT lacks oversight, coherency, and may be the most wasteful department in state government based on continual egregious cost over-runs on its projects, and lack of adherence to timelines. ODOT is currently asking the Oregon legislature for nearly 2 billion dollars in the next biennium for statewide transportation projects. Cortright believes the legislature needs to audit the agency, overhaul its management structure, and follow state laws in terms of bidding and contract oversight.

Issue: Veteran's Funding

Guest: Daniel Crowe, Attorney and Veteran's Advocate

Show: Measure 96 was the most popular measure on the fall ballot, winning 84 percent to 16 percent. It sets aside 1.5 percent of Oregon Lottery funds for services such as education, housing, health care and helping veterans better access their benefits. That's expected to hit more than \$18 million over the next two years. However, facing a 1.8-billion-dollar budget deficit, Oregon Governor Kate Brown, wants to reallocate 80 percent of that money to hire more state workers. Veteran's groups are vowing to fight the governor. Crowe discusses the need for money, and the risk vets face in terms of health and mental in particular with estimates of 21 veteran suicides per day.
