**Tech Safety:** Hackers continue to compromise IT systems around the country, and in Oregon with Oregon Health Plan account information stolen. People continue to wonder how to protect their identities when others with our information don't.

**Foster Care:** Oregon continues to lead from behind in the protection of kids in foster care in the United States. The state is being sued for placing kids in juvenile detention, and even DHS offices because the state lacks the leadership to find foster homes, and protect the rights of foster children.

**Higher Ed. Costs Skyrocket:** Oregon State University, and the U of O announced dramatically increased tuition costs for the 2017-2018 academic year, this after 8 straight years of annual increases. With student debt at historic highs, many are wondering how much a college education is really worth.

**Sports in K-12 :** The incidence of concussions in school sports continues to be a concern, with football, and women's soccer leading the way in head injuries. Are we doing enough to protect our kids from repetitive concussions, and what are the risks?

Current estimates are that 4.5 million Americans have Hep C, but only about 40,000 have sought treatment. Show includes: how Hepatitis C is spread, it's symptoms, it's general threat level, and treatment.

Guest: Bill Dendy CPA/Money Manager

Show: Is College worth it? Or more appropriately what about college is worth the debt to get the degree? The average graduate at Oregon State University will graduate with a bachelor's degree and \$32,000 dollars of accrued debt from student loans. As tuition's at Oregon colleges and universities continue to increase that number will only climb higher. Dendy discusses how to evaluate if a degree is worth the cost, and how to find out what degrees translate into good paying jobs and which degrees will leave the grad struggling to pay off school debt. Dendy also discusses a funding idea passed by the legislature, now in the planning stages, that would offer "free tuition" for students attending Oregon schools who would then later pay 3 percent of their earnings for a period of 15 to 20 years after they graduate.

Rosenthal believes that all hardship can be used as a building block, to not only make us more emotionally resilient, but also to learn how to succeed.

Show: Most people believe that adoptable children are babies, or toddlers, but in reality in the Mid and Southern Willamette Valley there are over 300 children over the age of 8 that are adoptable. Many of these adoptable "older" children get shifted around from foster home to foster home. As a result many of these kids simply float in the system, only to be dumped out at the age of 18 with no home, no roots, and no sense of family. Rhodes discusses how people have preconceived, and incorrect opinions about older children, their ability to adjust to a "forever" family, and the need for a loving family for older children.

Show: Oregon is setting new records for people applying for, and receiving conceal carry permits. The question: when is deadly force allowed under Oregon law? How does a person's background, like being a former military member play into deciding the "threat" level of a potential assailant? Oregon's laws regarding endangerment and threat level are less than black and white. Beard discusses some misconceptions regarding Oregon law, like the perception that if you confront someone who has broken into your house, you are automatically in the right to use deadly force; that is an incorrect assumption.

Ms. Fischer led a study that found that bicyclist deaths have risen more than 12%, the largest percentage increase of all roadway user groups. She said the average age of those killed is 45, and most are male. She talked about the factors that cause bicycle/car collisions, and what bikers and drivers can do to reduce them.

Dr. Rogoff believes the United States should discontinue the use of \$50 and \$100 bills, because they are primarily used as vehicles for tax evasion, the drug trade, terrorism, human trafficking, and other criminal enterprises. He outlined his plan for it phasing out, and said he believes it could cut criminal activity by 5-10%.
