New Age Media of Tennessee License, LLC (“New Age”), licensee of WDSI-TV, Chattanooga, Tennessee (Facility ID No. 71353), hereby responds to your EEO Audit letter dated March 22, 2024.


New Age currently has fewer than five full-time employees at the WDSI-TV employment unit, which also includes commonly-owned Class A station WPDP-CD, Cleveland, Tennessee (Facility ID No. 52078), and therefore, is not required to have an EEO recruitment program. New Age’s current full-time employees at the employment unit are a Technical Operations Manager and an Internet Content Producer, each of whom is regularly scheduled to work 40 hours per week.

There have been no complaints filed during the station’s current license term alleging unlawful discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, or sex in the employment practices of the employment unit.

In accordance with Section 73.3527(e)(11) of the Commission’s Rules, a copy of the EEO audit letter and this response are being placed in the Public Inspection File for each Station.
