Thursday April 1, 2021**Issue:** Community Service**Program:** El Show de Alex El Genio Lucas**Description:**

The show talked about the City of Los Angeles Emergency Renters Assistance Program. It was created to assist residential renters who have been unable to pay their rent as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Friday April 2, 2021**Issue:** Health**Program:** El Show de Alex El Genio Lucas

Description: The show talked about the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) releasing an [eviction moratorium order](#). CDC determines that the evictions of tenants could be detrimental to public health control measures to slow the spread of SARS-Cov-2, the virus that causes COVID-19.

Monday April 5, 2021**Issue:** Government**Program:** El Show de Alex El Genio Lucas**Description:**

The show talked about FEMA is providing COVID-19 Funeral Assistance.

Tuesday April 6, 2021**Issue:** Government**Program:** El Show de Alex El Genio Lucas**Description:**

The show explained the California Housing Covid-19 relief program. Eligible renters can apply for landlords to be reimbursed for 80% of each eligible renter's unpaid rent between April 1, 2020, and March 31, 2021. The landlord must agree to waive the remaining 20% of unpaid rent for that specific time period.

The show mentioned how scammers are using a new trick to steal your money and personal information: a bogus COVID vaccine survey. People across the country are reporting getting emails and texts out of the blue, asking them to complete a limited-time survey about the Pfizer, Moderna, or AstraZeneca vaccine.

The show explained what harassment means. It is a form of employment discrimination that violates Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Age Discrimination in Employment Act of 1967, (ADEA), and the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, (ADA).

The show mentioned again about the funds available thru FEMA for COVID-19 Funeral Assistance.

The show talked about scams to grandparents. Scammers might even come to grandparents houses to collect money, supposedly for your grandchild in distress.

The show talked about the Third Economic Impact Payment. The IRS started issuing the third Economic Impact Payments to eligible individuals on March 12, 2021, with more payments sent by direct deposit and through the mail as a check or debit card in the weeks that follow.

The show talked about Attorneys general are a leading consumer protection force in the country, generally receiving their authority from state consumer protection laws giving the attorney general primary enforcement responsibility within their state or territory.

The show talked about how to file a Consumer Complaint against a Business/Company. Contact the Attorney General's Public Inquiry Unit to report a complaint about a business or if you have questions or comments.

The show talked about FTC continues to crack down on companies peddling fake COVID treatments and cures. The FTC has sent 30 warning letters to companies that claimed their products can prevent, treat, or cure COVID-19. These letters gave the sellers 48 hours to notify the FTC of the specific actions they have taken to address the agency's concerns.

The show mentioned the FEMA website where people who had been affected by COVID-19 pandemic can ask for help.

The federal Trade Commission reminds anyone who demands to be paid with a gift card is a scammer.

The show explained to the audience what The Emergency Broadband Benefit Program is. This is a [Federal Communications Commission \(FCC\) program](#) that provides a temporary discount on monthly broadband bills for qualifying low-income households.

The show informed about the important changes to the Child Tax Credit that will help many families receive advance payments starting this summer. The American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) of 2021 expands the Child Tax Credit (CTC) for tax year 2021 only.

The show explained how a complaint about a telecom billing or service issue could be done and how to resolve the issue with the company providing the service.

Also, they may be able to submit a complaint with your state regulator.
