


LOWCOUNTRY FOOD BANK...WORKING TO FEEL STUDENTS DURING  
SUMMER VACATION

AIR DATE: JULY 2, 2017

GUEST: PAT WALKER...CEO OF THE LOW COUNTRY FOOD BANK IN  
NORTH CHARLESTON

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE GENERAL WORK OF THE FOOD  
BANK...WHICH IS TO SUPPLY FOOD TO THOSE WHO NEED IT IN AS  
MANY AS 10 COUNTIES IN SOUTH CAROLINA.

AND THE FOOD BANK WAS ABLT TO HIT A MILESTONE THIS  
WEEK...SERVING ITS ONE MILLIONTH MEAL. WALKER SAYS ITS  
VERY REWARDING TO REACH THAT MARK. SHE SAYS IT IS ALSO A  
REMINDER THAT HUNGER NEVER STOPS AND THAT THE FOOD  
BANK'S WORK IS NON-STOP.

DESPITE THE UPTURN IN THE ECONOMY...AND THE LOW JOBLESS  
RATE IN THE LOW COUNTRY....MANY FAMILIES ARE STILL HUNGRY.  
SINGLE FAMILY HOMES MAY HAVE A WORKING PARENT...BUT THAT  
THE MONEY IS NOT ALWAYS ENOUGH TO COVER ALL THE  
NECESSARY BASES. THE MONEY GOES TO RENT...ELECTRICITY  
BILLS AND OTHER NEEDS...AND OFTEN TIMES THE FOOD BUDGET IS  
ALMOST NON-EXSISTANT. THE LOW COUNTRY FOOD BANK SWINGS  
INTO ACTION TO FILL THAT NEED.

DURING THE SUMMER MONTHS...THE FOOD BANK AND OTHER  
PANTRIES WORK WITH THE SCHOOL SYSTEMS TO MAKE SURE THAT  
STUDENTS WHO GET BREAKFAST AND LUNCH AT SCHOOL...ARE NOT  
DENIED MEALS DURING THE SUMMER RECESS.

SAVING LOW COUNTRY LIVES DAILY THRU THE SKILL OF CPR AND  
THE HEART SAVE PROGRAM

AIR DATE: JULY 9, 2017

GUEST: DR WILLIAM GROSSMAN...CARDIOLOGIST WITH ROPER ST FRANCIS AND FOUNDER OF THE HEART SAVE PROGRAM

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE HEART SAVE PROGRAM... WITH DR GROSSMAN STARTED BACK IN 2005. FIRST...IT WAS THE TEACHING THE PUBLIC THE SIMPLE PROCEDURE KNOWN AS C-P-R. ANYONE CAN LEARN IT QUICKLY. IT'S A PROCEDURE THAT CAN KEEP A HEART ATTACK VICTIM ALIVE UNTIL EMS ARRIVES.

THAT QUICKLY GREW INTO AN EFFORT TO HAVE DEVICES KNOWN AS A-E-D DEVICES AVAILABLE IN ANY VENUE WHERE PEOPLE GATHER. IT COULD BE A CHURCH...OR A SCHOOL...AN AIRPORT...ENTERTAINMENT VENUES...ANYWHERE PEOPLE GATHER.

A-E-D's CAN BRING AN AILING HEART BACK INTO A NORMAL BEATING PATTERN. C-P-R CAN KEEP A HEART BEATING UNTIL THE VICTIM CAN GET TO A HOSPITAL.

MONEY IS COLLECTED FOR THE PURCHASE OF A-E-D DEVICES. TRAINING ON THEM IS SIMPLE AND CAN SAVE LIVES.

THE DOCTOR SAYS KNOWING HOW TO PERFORM C-P-R OR HAVING ACCESS TO A-E-D DEVICES ARE A MUST....BECAUSE YOU NEVER KNOW WHEN YOU MAY FIND YOURSELF IN THE POSITION OF BEING A LIFE SAVER.

## CATCHING UP WITH THE ARK OF SOUTH CAROLINA

AIR DATE: JULY 16, 2017

GUESTS: MEGAN SEVERN...SPECIAL EVENTS CO-ORDINATOR FOR THE ARK....AND MICKIE STYSLINGER...CO-ORDINATOR OF THE NOAH PROJECT. THE ARK IS LOCATED IN SUMMERSVILLE.

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE UPCOMING RACE FOR THE ARK...ON AUGUST 26<sup>TH</sup>. THE RUN AND WALK HAPPENS IN SUMMERSVILLE...AND HELP FUNDS THE WORK OF THE ARK...WHICH IS TO PROVIDE SUPPORT TO CAREGIVERS WHO ARE CARING FOR FAMILY MEMBERS WITH ALZHEIMERS AND OTHER DEMENTIA RELATED DISEASES.

THE FUNDS HELP FUND THE WORK OF THE ARK. THE ARK HOLDS DEMENTIA SCREENINGS...AND OFFERS SUPPORT SESSIONS FOR CAREGIVERS...WHO ARE OFTEN EXHAUSTED CARING FOR AN ALZHEIMER-AFFECTED LOVED ONE.

THE SUPPORT GROUPS ALSO OFFER TO HELP THOSE CAREGIVERS WITH ACTIVITIES THAT LET THEM HAVE A LITTLE TIME FOR THEMSELVES...AS TAKING CARE OF SUCH A PATIENT TAKES UP A LOT OF TIME..AND EVEN MONEY.

THE NOAH PROJECT ENABLES THE ARK TO SERVE THE RURAL AREAS OF THE LOW COUNTRY. MANY TIMES CAREGIVERS IN THESE AREAS ARE ISOLATED AND HELP AND UNDERSTANDING CAN BE FAR AWAY.

THE ARK GOES INTO THESE AREAS TO OFFER ASSISTANCE AND GIVES THESE FOLKS A BREAK FROM THEIR GRUELING TASKS OF CARING FOR AN ALZHEIMERS VICTIM

BROTHER....CAN YOU SPARE A PINT? THE SUMMER EFFORT TO COLLECT BLOOD

AIR DATE: JULY 23, 2017

GUEST: LAURA ZAGBY...RECRUITMENT REPRESENTATIVE WITH THE LOW COUNTRY AMERICAN RED CROSS

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE SUMMER BEING ONE OF THE MOST CHALLENGING TIMES FOR THE RED CROSS. IT MUST KEEP THE HOSPITAL SHELVES FLUSH WITH BLOOD DONATIONS....THOUGH THE DONORS CAN BE FEW AND FAR BETWEEN DURING THE SUMMER MONTHS.

THE OTHER CHALLENGING TIME OF THE YEAR FOR BLOOD COLLECTION IS BETWEEN THANKSGIVING AND CHRISTMAS. THAT'S BECAUSE SUCH HOLIDAYS MEAN SCHOOLS ARE NOT IN SESSION...WORKPLACES HAVE EMPLOYEES WHO TAKE VACATIONS AND THE USUAL DONORS ARE NOT AS READILY AVAILABLE.

AS FAST AS BLOOD IS BROUGHT TO HOSPITALS...THAT'S HOW FAST IT IS USED. AND THE COLLECTION PROCESS STARTS ALL OVER AGAIN. IT REALLY NEVER STOPS.

ZAGBY SAYS THAT UNFORTUNATELY....OURS IS A STATE THAT OFTEN RELIES ON BLOOD FROM NEIGHBORING STATES. THE MIDWESTERN STATES HAVE MASTERED BLOOD DRIVES...OFTEN BRINGING COVERED DISHES AND MAKING DRIVES 'A PARTY'.

DONORS OF A PINT OF BLOOD HELP 3 PEOPLE IN NEED. PLATELET DONATIONS TAKE A LITTLE MORE TIME...BUT ARE ALSO VERY BENEFICIAL TO CANCER PATIENTS. MAKE TIME TO DONATE.

SPOTLIGHT ON TRIDENT LITERACY...AND TESTIMONY FROM A  
WOMAN WHO HAS BENEFITED FROM THE ORGANIZATION

AIR DATE: JULY 30, 2017

GUESTS: ELAINE CHEPINIK...EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF TRIDENT  
LITERACY...LUCILLE HEFKA...TRANSITION SPECIALIST...AND  
NICOLE COX...A YOUNG WOMAN WHO HAS BEEN HELPED BY THE  
SERVICES OF TRIDENT LITERACY.

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE ORGANIZATION'S MISSION...TO  
TEACH ADULTS HOW TO READ...ENGLISH AS A SECOND  
LANGUAGE...AND HELPS HIGH SCHOOL DROPOUTS EARN THEIR GED.

TOO MANY RESIDENTS IN THE LOW COUNTRY HAVE NEVER  
MASTERED THE SKILL OF READING. IT KEEPS THEM IN LOW INCOME  
JOBS AND IN A LIFE OF POVERTY. AND THE MISTEP IS NOT  
LEARNING TO READ CAN SEND A BAD MESSAGE TO KIDS.

NICOLE COX WAS A HIGH ACHEIVER IN SCHOOL. BUT DUE TO A BAD  
REACTION TO MEDICATION...SHE BECAME VERY ILL. IT HAS TAKEN  
THE 32 YEAR OLD MANY YEARS TO RECOVER AND RE-LEARN BASIC  
SKILLS. SHE BECAME SICK AND FAILED TO GRADUATE FROM HIGH  
SCHOOL. LITERACY ADVANCE HELPED HER GET HER G-E-D AND  
LEARN OTHER SKILLS. SHE IS NOW COLLEGE BOUND...AND ENJOYS  
READING TO HER CHILD.

THERE ARE MANY REASONS WHY SOME NEVER LEARN HOW TO  
READ OR TRY TO GET ALONG BEING 'FUNCTIONALLY ILLITERATE'.  
BUT LITERACY ADVANCE WORKS TO HELP RESIDENTS EARN THAT  
SKILL...AND GO ON TO BETTER THEIR LIVES.

THE COASTAL CONSERVATION ASSOCIATION OF SOUTH CAROLINA

AIR DATE: AUGUST 6, 2017

GUEST: SCOTT WHITAKER....EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE SOUTH CAROLINA CCA

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE WORK...AND THE PLAY...OF THE COASTAL CONSERVATION ASSOCIATION OF SOUTH CAROLINA. THE ASSOCIATION IS MADE UP OF ACTIVE FISHERMEN..AND WOMEN....BUT IT WORKS TO TAKE CARE OF SALT WATER FISHING AREAS.

THE CCA WORKS TO ADDRESS CONSERVATION ISSUES BOTH NATIONALLY AND WITHIN THE STATE. THE ORGANIZATION...FORMED IN TEXAS IN THE 1970s...WORKS TO KEEP NATURAL RESOURCES PRISTINE AND FAR FROM ANY DESTRUCTION. IT DOES THIS THRU LOBBYING FOR LEGISLATION AND EDUCATION.

THE REASONS FOR THESE ACTIVITIES ARE SOMEWHAT SELFISH...AS WHITAKER SAYS THOSE WHO LOVE TO FISH...WANT THE FISH TO THRIVE AND MULTIPLY...SO THERE IS SOMETHING TO CATCH AND ENJOY. WHITAKER CALLS IT BEING RESPONSIBLE.

ON THE FUN SIDE OF THE CCA OF SC....ITS BIG SUMMERTIME FISHING TOURNAMENT CONTINUES. IT STARTED MEMORIAL DAY WEEKEND. MEMBERS ARE FISHING TO CATCH ONE OF TWO SPECIAL TAGGED FISH. THE WINNER GETS A SEAHUNT FISHING BOAT...MOTOR AND TRAILER VALUED AT MORE THAN 40-THOUSAND DOLLARS. ANYONE CAN FISH...BUT YOU MUST BECOME A MEMBER OF THE CCA.

AT THE TIME OF THIS INTERVIEW...THERE HAD BEEN NO WINNERS. THE TOURNAMENT GOES THRU LABOR DAY WEEKEND.



MEETING THE NEW CHIEF AT THE HELM OF MY SISTER'S HOUSE

AIR DATE: AUGUST 13, 2017

GUEST: TOSHA CONNORS...THE NEW EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF MY SISTER'S HOUSE....A SHELTER FOR VICTIMS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AND THEIR CHILDREN.

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON TOSHA CONNORS...AND BEING THE NEW FACE OF THIS SHELTER WHICH HAS BEEN OPERATING IN THE LOW COUNTRY FOR ALMOST 40 YEARS.

CONNERS KNOWS THE STATS ARE NOT GOOD FOR SOUTH CAROLINA. WE TEND TO ALWAYS BE IN THE TOP 5 OF STATES WHEN IT COMES TO THE INCIDENCE OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE. IT IS A PROBLEM THAT TENDS TO BE LEARNED FROM PAST GENERATIONS. SOMEONE WHO GROWS UP IN THE VIOLENT HOME...TENDS TO CONTINUE THE CYCLE.

MY SISTER'S HOUSE OFFERS RESOURCES AND SUPPORT FOR THOSE WHO ESCAPE AN ABUSIVE HOME. AND...THE KIDS IN THE SHELTER ARE ALSO TAKEN CARE OF THROUGH SUPPORT GROUPS. THEY LEARN THE ABUSE IS NOT THEIR FAULT...AND ARE GIVEN WAYS TO COPE WITH BEING IN THE SHELTER.

CONNERS ALSO NOTES THAT SOME WOMEN LEAVE THEIR BATTERER SEVERAL TIMES...BEFORE THEY LEAVE FOR GOOD. THE SHELTER CANNOT FORCE OR COERCE THEM TO STAY. AND IN MOST CASES...THESE WOMEN DO RETURN.

MY SISTER'S HOUSE CAN ALWAYS USE VOLUNTEERS AND HOUSEHOLD ITEMS FOR THE SHELTER. IT ALSO RAISES FUNDS TO STAY 'IN BUSINESS'.

GETTING PREPARED FOR THE AUGUST 21<sup>ST</sup> SOLAR ECLIPSE

AIR DATE: AUGUST 20, 2017

GUESTS: JAMES ROSS....A NASA SME ...AND YEVETTE JOHNSON....BOTH MEMBERS OF THE LOWCOUNTRY STARGAZERS GROUP. IT'S A NON-PROFIT PROMOTING THE WONDERS OF STAR GAZING.

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON MONDAY'S TOTAL SOLAR ECLIPSE EVENT. CHARLESTON IS IN THE PATH OF TOTALITY...AND IT WILL BE THE LAST LOCATION IN THE U-S TO VIEW THE EVENT.

LOW COUNTRY STARGAZERS ARE EXCITED ABOUT THIS. ROSS AND JOHNSON SAYS THEIR ORGANIZATION KNEW ABOUT THE ECLIPSE MORE THAN 2 YEARS AGO AND HAVE BEEN PREPARING FOR IT.

THE GROUP WILL SPLIT UP AND WILL BE IN TWO DIFFERENT COUNTY PARKS. THEY WILL HAVE THEIR TELESCOPES AND CERTIFIED SAFETY GLASSES. THEY INVITE THE LOW COUNTRY TO WATCH THE ECLIPSE WITH THE STARGAZERS ORGANIZATION...AND LEARN WHAT ELSE TO WATCH FOR DURING THE EVENT.

AMONG THOSE SMALLER EVENTS...AS THE MOON MOVES INTO BLACK TO BLOCK THE SUN....SOMETHING CALLED BAILEY'S BEAMS...WHERE THE CRATERS AND PEAKS OF THE MOON ARE IN THE SHADOWS OF THE SUN. LIGHT BEAMS WILL BE SEEN ON THE GROUND WHEN THAT HAPPENS. AND THEN THERE IS THE DIAMOND EFFECT...WHEN THE MOON IS ALMOST TOTALLY BLOCKING THE SUN.

IT WILL BE A SPECTACULAR NATURAL EVENT IN THE HEAVENS. 60 NASA SCIENTISTS WILL EVEN BE IN CHARLESTON TO LAUNCH TESTS INTO THE ATMOSPHERE MONDAY AFTERNOON.

THE LOW COUNTRY IS WATCHING FOR THOUSANDS TO FILL THE CITY FOR THE WEEKEND AND FOR THE MONDAY EVENT.

## DOLING OUT JOY TO THE STUDENTS AT POVERTY SCHOOLS

AIR DATE: AUGUST 27, 2017

GUEST: KATIE BLOMQUIST...FORMER SCHOOL TEACHER NOW HEAD OF THE NON-PROFIT GOING PLACES...A CHARITY THAT COLLECTS MONEY TO GIVE NEW BIKES TO ELEMENTARY SCHOOL STUDENTS AT OR BELOW THE POVERTY LINE.

DISCUSSION DEALT WITH BLOMQUIST'S EFFORT TO GIVE YOUNG KIDS THE JOY OF HAVING A BICYCLE.

WHEN BLOMQUIST WAS A TEACHER AT PEPPERHILL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL IN NORTH CHARLESTON...A TITLE-1 SCHOOL....SHE WARMED UP TO A 6 YEAR OLD STUDENT WHO SHE SAYS DID NOT SEEM TO HAVE HAD THE EXPERIENCES OTHER KIDS HIS AGE HAVE HAD. HE DID NOT HAVE A BIKE...AND THERE WAS LIKELY NO CHANCE HE WOULD HAVE A BICYCLE. SHE COLLECTED MONTH...AND SURPRISED HIM WITH A BIKE. THEN...SHE REALIZED OTHER YOUNG CLASS MATES ALSO HAD NO REAL HOPE OF HAVING A BIKE. SO SHE STARTED A GO FUND ME PAGE...AND COLLECTED ENOUGH MONEY TO BUY 650 BICYCLES FOR EVERY STUDENT AT PEPPERHILL ELEMENTARY. THE KIDS WERE FLOORED.

SHE HAS NOW STARTED A NON-PROFIT THAT IS CONSTANTLY COLLECTING MONEY FOR THESE BICYCLES.

SHE HAS SELECTED THE NEXT SCHOOL TO GET SUCH A SURPRISE...THIS TIME IN A RURAL AREA OF THE LOW COUNTRY.

KATIE IS ALSO EXPANDING THE EFFORT TO INCLUDE OTHER THINGS DESERVING KIDS LIVING AT THE POVERTY LEVEL BOTH NEED AND WANT.

LOW COUNTRY ORPHAN RELIEF...WORKING TO HELP ABUSED AND  
NEGLECTED KIDS

AIR DATE: SEPTEMBER 3, 2017

GUEST: MARISSA NASH...DIRECTOR OF DEVELOPMENT WITH LOW  
COUNTRY ORPHAN RELIEF

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON WHAT THE ORGANIZATION DOES TO  
HELP KIDS...AGES ZERO TO 18...WHO'VE BEEN PLACED IN FOSTER  
CARE DUE TO BAD HOME SITUATIONS.

THESE KIDS ARE TAKEN OUT OF THEIR HOMES...DUE TO  
ABUSE...NEGLECT...OR OTHER HARSH SITUATIONS THAT PUT THEM  
AT RISK. THE IDEAL PLAN IS TO HELP THE PARENTS OF THESE KIDS  
SO THE FAMILY CAN BE REUNITED AND BE MADE WHOLE.

UNFORTUNATELY...IT DOES NOT ALWAYS WORK THAT WAY. MANY  
OF THESE KIDS GROW UP IN FOSTER CARE. AT THE AGE OF  
18...UNLESS IT'S A SPECIAL CASE...THE KIDS ARE CUT FREE. WHEN  
ASKED WHAT HAPPENS TO THEM AFTER THAT...NASH SAID OFTEN  
TIMES (IF THEY DON'T JOIN THE MILITARY) THEY MUST RELY ON  
WELFARE BECAUSE OF PERSONAL PROBLEMS IN COPING WITH WHAT  
THEY'VE BEEN THROUGH.

ON THE BRIGHTER SIDE...LOW COUNTRY ORPHAN RELIEF ALSO SAYS

THE LIST OF KIDS NEEDING FOSTER CARE FAR OUTPACES FOSTER  
HOMES.

HABITAT FOR HUMANITY CONTINUES ITS MISSION IN THE LOW COUNTRY.

LEE STRESSES THAT A HABITAT HOME IS NOT A FREEBIE. THOSE WHO PUT IN THE 600 HOURS OF 'SWEAT EQUITY' AND WHO MEET CERTAIN FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY TRAINING REQUIREMENTS...END UP IN HABITAT HOMES.

MANY TIMES THESE HOMES GO TO FEMALE HEADS OF HOUSEHOLD AND THERE ARE USUALLY 2 TO 4 KIDS INVOLVED.

THEY MAKE ABOUT 24-THOUSAND DOLLARS A YEAR...AND HOME OWNERSHIP IS USUALLY OUT OF THE QUESTION FOR THAT FAMILY.

BUT HABITAT HAS BEEN ABLE TO BUILD HOMES FOR THESE DESERVING FAMILIES. AND MORE SUCH HOMES COULD BE BUILT IN THE MATERIALS WERE MADE AVAILABLE.

THE ORGANIZATION DEPENDS ON DONATIONS TO BUY SOME OF THE MATERIALS FOR A HOME....BUT MUCH OF THE BUILDING MATERIALS COME FROM GENEROUS BUSINESSES THAT DONATE MATERIALS AND MANPOWER. ELECTRICIANS....PLUMBERS....AND OTHERS OFFER UP THEIR SERVICES FOR FREE IN BUILDING THESE HOMES.

LOW COUNTRY GIVING DAY HAPPENS TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 19<sup>TH</sup>. IT IS HOPED THAT FOLKS WILL TAKE TIME TO MAKE A DONATION TO HABITAT SO MORE HOMES CAN BE BUILT FOR FAMILIES TRYING TO MAKE THEIR WAY OUT OF POVERTY

THERE IS A WAITING LIST...BUT MANY HAVE TO WAIT FOR A CLIENT  
DEATH BEFORE THEY CAN GET ON THE MEAL DELIVERY LIST. ONLY  
ONE MEAL IS DELIVERED PER DAY MOSTLY BY VOLUNTEERS. MORE  
MONEY WOULD MEAN MORE MEALS PER DAY AND MORE RESIDENTS  
SERVED.

WALDMAN SPOKE OF THE BEAUTY OF 'LOW COUNTRY GIVING DAY'  
WITH HAPPENS SEPTEMBER 19<sup>TH</sup>...ALL DAY LONG.

GIVING DAY INVITES LOW COUNTRY RESIDENTS TO GIVE TO NON-  
PROFITS SO THOSE ORGANIZATIONS CAN CONTINUE THEIR WORK IN  
THE LOW COUNTRY.

BY THE WAY...THE MONEY RAISED ON GIVING DAY...STAYS IN THE  
LOW COUNTRY.
